CARDS FALL IN 11 AT NATURALS ON SATURDAY NIGHT: River Town hit a bloop double down the left field line in the bottom of the 11th inning to break a 5-5 tie and send the Cardinals to their second walk-off loss of the series 6-5 on Saturday night at Arvest Ballpark. **Mike Antico** had two hits including a leadoff home run in the top of the first inning for Springfield. **RJ Yeager** also had two hits, while **Ryan Shreve** (3.0 IP) and **Andre Granillo** (2.0 IP) combined to give the Cardinals five innings of scoreless relief. Springfield is now 6-4 through their first 10 games of their two-city road trip.



DPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander **Noah Cameron** makes his sixth start of the season for the Naturals... Got the win in the series opener on Tuesday morning allowing just 1 R on 2 H over 5.0 IP with 5 K while walking 4...Has won his last two starts allowing 4 ER over 10.0 IP...Best start of the season came on April 11 when he fired 5.0 shutout innings allowing just 4 H with 0 BB and 6 K...Has surrendered 3 HR in his last 3 starts...Made 17 starts with the Naturals last season, going 3-10 with a 6.10 ERA, allowing 14 HR in 72.1 IP...Made 4 starts against the Cardinals last season and went 1-2 with a 10.13 ERA, surrendering 18 ER on 29 H in 16.0 IP (.392 BAA)...Began last season at High-A Quad Cities, going 202 with a 3.60 ERA in 7 starts....Split the 2022 season between Quad Cities and Low-A Columbia,...Selected by the Royals in the 7th round of the 2021 draft out of Central Arkansas...Missed the 2021 season after Tommy John surgery in August 2020...Freshman All-American and All-Southland Conference in 2019...From St. Joseph, MO and called Royals "hometown team"...24 years old

CARDS, NATURALS CLASH FOR FIRST TIME IN 2024: The Springfield Cardinals conclude their 12game, two-city road trip in Srpingdale, AR with a six-game series against the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (Double-A, Kansas City Royals). It is the first meeting of the season between the two North Divsion rivals. The Naturals finished 64-74 in 2023, the worst record in the Texas League by a half-game.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

TWD-DUT MAGIC: Of the 26 runs the Cardinals have scored in their last 4 games, 20 (76.9%) have come with two outs. Despite a .214 average over that time, the Cards have notched 19 RBIs. All 13 Springfield runs in the first four games of their series against the Naturals have been scored with two outs.

BIRDS BOAST BEST DOUBLE-A OFFENSE: Through 31 games the Cardinals lead the three Double-A leagues with a .262 batting average; the Portland Sea Dogs are next at .259. The Cards are tied for the level lead in RBIs (161) and are top five in runs (3rd; 172), OBP (t3rd; .357), hits (t3rd; 267) and have also been particularly prodcutive hitting situationally with 16 sacrifice flies this season, most in Double-A.

The Cards' bats, however, have cooled off since April 24, batting .234 over their last 15 games which ranks 7th in the Texas League during that time. Through their first five games this week in Springdale the Cards are batting .223.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cardinals have struck out just 232 times in 31 games, the 2nd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. The Cardinals trail only the Spokane Indians (215 K's) for fewest whiffs in the minor leagues. The Indians, however, have played four fewer games than the Cardinals (27). The Birds are averaging just 7.5 K's per game.

DON'T CALL IT A BOUNCEBACK: With a 6.12 team ERA over their previous 17 games coming into the series, the Cardinals' talented pitching staff was looking to right the ship coming to Arvest Ballpark this week. Through the first five games of the series agains the Naturals, Springfield's staff has righted the ship with a 3.54 ERA since Tuesday. Over the last four games, the Cards have allowed just 7 ER over 32.2 IP (1.93 ERA) with 44 K's, a stretch that includes the Birds' first shutout of the season on Friday night.

The Springfield pitching staff alone features 6 of the top 30 prospects in the Cardinals' system led by numbers one and two in right-handers Tink Hence and Tekoah Roby.

TABLE SETTERS: The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis, Bryan Torres and Nathan Church, have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined. Torres and Church are batting .320 (70-for-219) with 38 R, 12 2B, 20 SB, 4 CS and have struck out a combined 32 times compared to 28 walks. Five of those strikeouts came in one game on Friday. One of their names can be found 8 times among the top 10 in 6 different categories on the Texas League offensive leaderboard.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .288 which ranks 3rd in the Texas League, and .308 out of the 2-hole, good for 2nd.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Cardinals outfielder Nathan Church ranks in the top-10 among qualified hitters in the following categories: batting average (t6th; .317), RBIs (t3rd; 22), hits (3rd; 39), total bases (t4th; 56), and runs (t7th; 20). Church has hit safely in 26 of his 29 games played and despite 6 K's over his last three games, has struck out just 14 times in 136 plate appearances (10.3%). The UC Irvine product has already set a career high with 4 HR. He hit just 3 longballs at High-A Peoria last season in 119 games.

On Monday, Church was named Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month for April when he slashed .349/.402/.512 with 3 HR and 18 RBIs. He led all Cardinals minor leaguers in OPS (.914), hits (30), total bases (44), and runs (17). He hit safely in 19 of 20 games for the month.

TORRES STREAK SNAPPED: Springfield leadoff man Bryan Torres had his season-opening 23 game on-base streak snapped in game two of the Cardinals doubleheader on Thursday night with an 0-for-3 outing. Torres ranks among the leaders in the Texas League in 4 offensive categories: batting average (5th; .323), OBP (5th; .417), hits (t10th; 31) and leads the league with 13 stolen bases while being caught just twice.

REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs . His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.
