YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were shut out by the Senators, 4-0. Harrisburg took a 3-0 lead in the first on a three-run double by Israel Pineda. Paul Witt led off the bottom of the second with a solo homer, which was the last Harrisburg hit in the game. Matt Frisbee started and struck out seven batters over 3.2 innings. Tanner Kiest issued one walk over 2.1 innings with three strikeouts. Nick Garcia threw two scoreless innings. The Flying Squirrels outhit the Senators, 7-3, but went 1-for-10 with runners in scoring position. Victor Bericoto and Will Wilson each had two hits.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This is the first of three series between the two teams this season. The Senators come to Richmond for a six-game series from July 9--14. The Flying Squirrels return to Harrisburg for a six-game set from August 13-18. In 2023, the Flying Squirrels went 13-8 against the Senators, including a 3-6 mark at FNB Field and a 10-2 record at The Diamond.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS reached the postseason for the second consecutive season in 2022 and the fourth time in franchise history, winning the Southwest Division Second-Half title. They were eliminated by the Erie SeaWolves in the Southwest Division Series. The team went 74-64 overall, the second-best record in the Southwest Division. In the first half, the Flying Squirrels jumped out of the gate in first place for most of the first month of the season, but slid down the stretch and finished 33-36, fourth in the Southwest. In the second half, the Flying Squirrels surged to a 41-28 record, finishing three games ahead of Erie in first place. The Flying Squirrels spent 57 percent (79 games) of the season in first place in the division. Richmond's 74 wins this year were the third-most in franchise history and their. 536 winning percentage was the second-best, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556). After starting this year 1-4, the Flying Squirrels are 4-4 in their last eight games.

THE SENATORS went 59-77 last year and finished in last place in the Southwest Division for the third consecutive season. This year, they started the season 1-5 but have won their last two games. They went 2-3 in last week's road series at Altoona. Among the Eastern League leaders, Dylan Crews is tied for second in RBIs (9) and Brady House is tied for fourth in hits (11). The Harrisburg roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF Dylan Crews (No. 1), 3B Brady House (No. 3), 3B Yohandy Morales (No. 4), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 8), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 17), RHP Cole Henry (No. 24) and C Israel Pineda (No. 25). Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes seven Harrisburg players, including Crews (No. 1), House (No. 3), Morales (No. 5), Hassell (No. 7), Pinckney (No. 19), Henry (No. 22) and LHP Andrew Alvarez (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Hayden Birdsong** makes his third start of the season. He made two starts against the RubberDucks at The Diamond last week. On April 9, he started the Flying Squirrels' home opener and allowed two runs over four innings in a loss. He last took the mound on Sunday and struck out eight over four innings, striking out eight. Birdsong leads all Eastern League pitchers (min. 6.0 IP) in K/9 (15.75). He has made one previous start against the Senators on August 17, 2023 and threw two scoreless innings with four strikeouts before the game was delayed by rain. Last year, he climbed three levels in the Giants' system en route to being named a 2023 MiLB.com Organization All-Star in his first full professional season. For the season, he posted the second-highest K/9 (13.32) and strikeout percentage (34.9) in the minors (min. 100 IP). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and posted a 2.16 ERA in 12 outings (10 starts). He was leading the California League in strikeouts (70) when he got promoted to High-A Eugene in June. After going 2-2 with a 3.25 ERA in eight games (seven starts) for the Emeralds, he was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 5 for the remainder of the season. Birdsong was selected by the Giants out of Eastern Illinois University in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com entering the 2024 season. *For more on Birdsong, see page two.*

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Brad Lord makes his second Double-A start and his home debut at FNB Field. He began the season with High-A Wilmington and made one start on April 6 against the Brooklyn Cyclones and threw four hitless innings but walked six, surrendering two unearned runs. In his Double-A debut on Sunday at Altoona, he struck out seven over 4.2 innings and allowed two runs on eight hits with no walks. Lord was selected with the Nationals in the 18th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Nationals out of the University of South Florida. In his professional debut season last year, Lord pitched 27 games (17 starts) between Low-A Fredericksburg and High-A Wilmington, going 4-6 with a 4.04 ERA.

GLOW SHOW ON THE ROAD: Jimmy Glowenke is batting .333 (7-for-21) in his five road games this season compared to .105 (2-for-19) at The Diamond. Last season with Richmond, Glowenke hit .323 (42-for-130, 7 HR, 28 RBI, .963 OPS) in his Double-A road games compared to .171 (20-for-117, 0 HR, 2 RBI, .501 OPS) in his 37 home games at The Diamond.

PAY YOUR DUES: In his seven games for the Flying Squirrels this year, **Damon Dues** is batting .400 (6-for-15), which is the second-highest in the Eastern League (min. 20 PA) behind only Reading's Carson Taylor. He has also walked six times and has a .571 on-base percentage, which is tops in the league (min. 20 PA). On Thursday, Dues reached base four times, going 3-for-4 with a walk. Dues signed with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent in 2021 out of Wright State University.

GRAND LARCENY: The Flying Squirrels are the only team in the Eastern League perfect in its stolen base attempts this season, going 13-for-13. The 12 stolen bases are tied for sixth in the league overall. **Brett Auerbach** is 4-for-4 in steal attempts and his four steals are tied for fifth in the league. In 2023, the Flying Squirrels were 124-for-153 (81.1 percent) in stolen base attempts, the highest percentage in franchise history, surpassing the previous record of 77.6 percent in 2021.

STRONG ARMS: The Richmond pitching staff has combined for 134 strikeouts this season, third-most in the Eastern League. Flying Squirrels starters have combined for a 3.55 ERA (20 ER/50.2 IP) this year, which is third-best in the league behind Akron (2.03) and Erie (2.82).

CLOSE CALLS: This season, the Flying Squirrels have played six games decided by one run, going 2-4 in those games. Their six one-run games are the most in the Eastern League this season. The Flying Squirrels began the season with a 5-4 loss at Somerset on April 5, lost 2-1 to Akron last Tuesday, won 2-1 on a walk-off error last Thursday against the RubberDucks, picked up a 3-2 win over Akron on Friday. Richmond lost 3-2 against Harrisburg to open this week' series before falling 5-4 on Wednesday night. Of the Flying Squirrels' seven losses this year, they have dropped four by one run, one by two runs and one by three runs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Among qualified Eastern League pitchers, Wil Jensen is fifth in ERA (1.64) and tied for eighth in WHIP (1.00). Ryan Murphy is ninth in ERA (2.25). John Michael Bertrand is 10th in ERA (2.40) and fifth in innings pitched (15.0). Carson Ragsdale is tied for fifth in strikeouts (17) and fourth in BAA (1.43). Harrisburg's Dylan Crews is tied for third in RBIs (11), Brady House is tied for sixth in hits (14) and Tyler Schoff is first in games pitched (6).

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Reggie Crawford** (No. 9), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20) and Sugastey (No. 24).


