


Leading Off

Today, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series on the road at the Somerset Patriots. It's the fourth of 18 matchups between the teams this season. Reading returns to Somerset from July 4-9 and the Patriots come to Reading from August 15-20. In 2022, Reading went 7-11 vs Somerset, going 5-5 at home and 2-7 on the road.

Put it in the Rearview Mirror

R-Phils.

Last night, the Fightin Phils fell 10-3 after Somerset put up nine-unanswered runs from innings one to four. Reading struck first with two in the top of the first, but it was all Patriots from there. Tyler Phillips struggled, allowing nine runs on nine hits in four innings of work. Ethan Wilson homered for Reading, his sixth of the season and first since May 5 at Hartford. The bullpen allowed just one run on two hits over four innings.

Shutout Streak

Through 35 games this season, Reading has yet to be shut out. The Fightin Phils are one-of-four teams in double-A and one-of-18 in all of Minor League Baseball who have yet to be blanked. Altoona joins Reading as the only Eastern League teams to not be shutout. Reading and Altoona are also the only teams in Double-A to not throw a shutout this season. The Fightins and Curve are the only double-A teams to have both marks.

Oliver Getting It Dunn

Oliver Dunn continues to put up big numbers, this time against his former team Somerset. Dunn is on a four-game hit streak and has reached base in a season-high 12-straight games. He also has three home runs in a span of six games, after only hitting one in his first 24.

McCarthy Mashes

McCarthy Tatum is another Fightin Phil who is bouncing back strong after a recent dry spell. Tatum has hits in his last four games and is hitting .400 over that span with a home run and seven RBI. In seven games prior, from April 21-May 11, Tatum was just 1/27 (.037) and was hitless in six of those seven games.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies had a day off yesterday after being swept at the Giants. Philadelphia opens a three-game series tonight against the Cubs. Lehigh Valley's late-comeback effort fell short in a 10-9 loss at Worcester, to drop to 20-21 on the season. Jersey Shore got back to .500 at 16-16 with a 7-4 home win over Wilmington. Clearwater won 10-3 over Bradenton to improve to a Florida State League and Minor League best 27-9. The Threshers have won three straight and 19 of their last 22 games. Clearwater has also won 15-straight games at home.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 19, 1967: At Pawtucket, Robin Roberts' scoreless streak ends after 22 innings, but the Phillies still hold off the Indians for a 4-3 win. Jim Campbell's 3-run homer capped a 4-run 3rd that gave Roberts just enough cushion to go the distance for his third straight victory.

'Sup Somerset

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Somerset. The Patriots sit second in the Northeast Division with a 22-13 record. Last week at Portland, Somerset split the six-game series, with the teams alternating wins in the series between the top-two teams in the division. Next up, the Patriots hit the road for a six-game series at Erie next week before welcoming Portland to Jersey the week after.

The Patriot Pitcher

Righty Clayton Beeter gets the start tonight for Somerset. This season, he is 2-2 with a 3.14 ERA over six starts. Over 28.2 innings, Beeter has 38 strikeouts and 15 walks. At Portland last Friday, he went two innings, allowing six hits and six runs. Beeter split 2022 between Tulane and Somerset, going 0-3 with a 4.56 ERA over 25 games (23 starts). Beeter was sent to the Yankees from Dodgers in the Joey Gallo trade last season.

Entering his 2020 senior season Abel was named a preseason All-American by MaxPreps and Baseball America and was considered to be a top prospect for the upcoming draft. He was also ranked the fourth best collegiate prospect in the nation and committed to play at Oregon State University after his freshman year of high school. PERSONAL: Abel grew up in Cedar Mill, Oregon, and helped lead the Cedar Mill Little League team win a state title as a youth.
