LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn captured a series victory with a 7-1 win vs. Wilmington on Sunday afternoon...LF Jefrey De Los Santos posted his best game of the season for Brooklyn, collecting 4 RBI with a 2-run home run to right in the 4th and adding a 2-run single to center in the 6th...DH Jacob Reimer recorded another multi-hit game, tallying a double and an RBI in the 1st...RHP Noah Hall tossed a career-high-tying 5.0 innings of 2-hit shutout ball, striking out 6, to earn his 2nd win of the year...RHPS Dylan Ross (0.2 IP). Eduardo Herrera (1.1), Jace Beck (1.0), and Brian Metoyer (1.0) combined to allow 1 unearned run on 2 hits over 4.0 frames in relief, sealing the victory.

WE THE BEST: The Cyclones swept the South Atlantic League Player and Pitcher of the Month awards that were handed out on Monday...INF Jacob Reimer was recognized as the SAL Player of the Month and LHP Zach Thornton, now at Double-A Binghamton, was named as the SAL Pitcher of the Month...In 21 games during April, Reimer hit, 318/,383/,659/1.042 with 18 runs scored, 8 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 21 RBI, 9 walks, and a stolen base...The 21-year-old paced the SAL in doubles (a) extra-base hits (16), triples (3), slugging percentage (.659), and total bases (56)...Reimer also was 2nd in OPS (1.042), tied for 2nd in RBI (21) and hits (27), 4th in batting average (.318), tied for 4th in home runs (5), tied for 6th in runs scored (18)...The Yucaipa, Calif. native was also 5th in Minor League Baseball in slugging percentage (.659), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (16), and tied for 8th in total bases (56)...Thornton accrued a perfect 3-0 record with a 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP), 12 hits, 2 walks, and 5s trikeouts in 4 starts...Among SAL arms with 20.0-plus innings pitched in April, Thornton led the league in strikeouts own with teammate RHP Joel Diaz for the league leaf in ERA (0.44) and WHIP (0.68)...He also tied for first in wins (3) and sat 7rd in batting average against (162)...Additionally, IF/OF A.J. Ewing took home Florida State League Player of the Month honors in April...With Single-A St. Lucie, the 20-year-old hit, 400/.506/.615/1.121 with 15 runs scored, 3 doubles, 4 triples, a home run, 20 RBI, and RBI (20), 3 rd in slugging paced the FSL in steals (14), batting average 400, and OPS (1121), and was tied for first in triples (4)...The Springboro, Ohio, native also ranked 2nd in on-base percentage (.506) and RBI (20), 3 rd in slugging percentage (.615) and hits (26), and tied for 5th in batting average (.500), and OPS (1121), and was tied for 2nd in MilB in triples (4), tied for 5th in steals (16). 6th in batting average (.500), and St

WEEKLY HONORS: INF Jacob Reimer earned New York Mets' Minor League Player of the Week for the 2nd time this season on Monday...Last week vs. Wilmington, the 21-year-old went 10-for-25 (.400) at the plate with 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 7 RBI, 3 walks, and a stolen base...Last Wednes-day, Reimer became the first Cyclone since 2005 to register a 3-home run game...He Yucaipa, Calif. native was the first to do it since Caleb Stewart on July 29, 2005, at Hudson Valley...Reimer was the first to do it since Caleb Stewart on July 29, 2005, at Hudson Valley...Reimer was the first to do it at home since Noel Devarez on July 1, 2001, vs. New Jersey...On the season, he leads the Mets' farm system in hits (33), extra-base hits (18), total bases (64), and runs scored (22), in addition to being tied for first in RBI (23).

ROCKIN' RONNY: C/1B Ronald Hernández has been an integral piece of the puzzle for the Cyclones all season...The switch-hitter enters Tuesday on an 8-game on-base streak dating back to April 23 at Jersey Shore...During the stretch, Hernández is hitting .464 (13-28) with 9 runs scored, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 3 walks, and 4 stolen bases...During the streak, the 21-year-old has raised his batting average by 140 points from .125 to .265...Hernández has already swiped a career-high-tying 8 bags in .2025, matching his career-best from .2024 in 88 fewer games (108 to 20)...The Venezuel anative was named to MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" on Monday after an 8-for-18 (.444) week at the plate with 4 runs scored, 2 home runs, 5 RBI, 2 walks, and 2 steals...Last Wednesday, Hernández and liNF Jacob Reimer (3) became the first pair of Brooklyn teammates to hit multiple home runs in the same game since INFs Edgardo Fermín and Ronny Mauricio each powered a pair on July 21, 2021, at Jersey Shore.

EW CAN'T STOP HIM: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, the 20-year-old is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in triples (4), 6th in batting average (.365), and tied for 8th in stolen bases (16)...Ewing has reached base safely in all 5 games he's played with the Cyclones and has reached in 12-straight games since April 18 vs. Tampa with Single-A St. Lucie...In that time, Ewing is hitting is hitting .318/.455/.432/.887 with 7 runs scored, a double, 2 triples, 9 runs batted in, 11 walks, and 9 stolen bases.

MARCO POLO: IF Marco Vargas has not stopped hitting since joining the Cyclones at the start of last week...The 19-year-old has reached safely in all 5 games played with Brooklyn and in all 18 contests he has appeared in this year between the Cyclones and Single-A St. Lucie...During the 18-game on-base streak, Vargas is hitting 338/.443/.462/.905 with 16 runs scored, 3 doubles, a triple, a home run, 11 RBI, 12 walks, and 4 stolen bases...He has also accrued at least 1 RBI in 4 of 5 games played with Brooklyn.

NOTHING AGAINST NUNEZ: RHP Anthony Nunez collected a 5-out save last Friday to continue his marvelous start to the new year...The Miami Springs, Fla. native has yet to allow an earned run through his first 8 appearances of the season...Nunez did not surrender a mere base hit until his 7th appearance of the year...Among players in the South Atlantic with at least 12.0 IP, Nunez is tied for the league lead in ERA (0.00)...He is 1 of 3 players to not allow an earned run (Aberdeen's RHP Braxton Bragg & Hub City's LHP Larson Kindreich)...Nunez's 0.41 WHIP leads the league amongst those with 12.0 IP, and is tops in all of High-A...Nunez's 0.41 WHIP is also the 2nd-lowest in Minor League Baseball among arms with 12.0 or more innings...Only Boston's High-A Greenville's LHP Brandon Clarke (0.35) and Baltimore's Double-A Chesapeake's RHP Keagan Gillies (0.39) have lower marks...Nunez's .029 batting average against (1-35) is the 2nd-lowest mark in MiLB behind Cincinnati's Single-A Daytona's RHP Irvin Machuca (.027).

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 5 alumni have already accomplished the feat in 2025...RHP Blade Tidwell (2023) became the 5th to debut this year, suffering the loss in a start for the New York Mets in Game 1 of Sunday's doubleheader at St. Louis...Tidwell punched out C Pedro Pagés swinging for his first MLB strikeout in Fand...OF Rhylan Thomas (2023) went 1-for-4 with a double and 2 RBI in his debut Friday night for the Seattle Mariners at Texas...C Hayden Senger (18, 21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston... Three days later, on March 30, OF Jake Mangum (19, 21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP Mike Vasil debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 18 Ty France for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is 9 in 2015 and 2017.

REIM TIME: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season..The former 4th-round pick recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer is 5th in Minor League Baseball in extra-base hits (18), 8th in slugging percentage (.634), and tied for 9th in total bases (.64)...He leads the South Atlantic League in total bases (.64), extra-base hits (18), hits (33), and doubles (10), and is tied for the lead in triples (3)...Reimer also ranks 2nd in slugging percentage (.634) and OPS (10.27), tied for 2nd in runs scored (22), tied for 3rd in RBI (23), tied for 4th in home runs (5), and 5th in batting average (.327)...Reimer enters Tuesday riding a 9-game hitting streak since April 24 at Jersey Shore...In that span, he is hitting .342 (13-38) with 9 runs scored, 4 doubles, 3 home runs, 10 RBI, 5 walks, and a steal.

vs. ASHEVILLE: After a 4-2 homestand vs. Wilmington, Brooklyn hits the road for a 6-game series with the Tourists...Asheville enters the series after taking 4-of-7 on the road against Greenville...This is the Cyclones' first trip to McCormick Field since winning 4-of-6 from August 22-27, 2023...Asheville is 5-6 at home this season...The Tourists boast 7 of the Astros' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: C Walker Janek (4), RHP Anderson Brito (6), OF Joseph Sullivan (12), INF Chase Jaworsky (13), OF Kenni Gómez (18), RHP Juan Bello (24), and RHP Bryce Mayer (29)...In 17 meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 10-7 (588). Brooklyn is 6-5 (545) in 11 games in Ashovilla (.588)...Brooklyn is 6-5 (.545) in 11 games in Asheville.

DIALED IN DÍAZ: RHP **Joel Díaz** has been outstanding to start the 2025 season...The 21-year-old's scoreless inning streak to start the year ended at 17.1 IP after allowing a run against Wilmington on April 30... The righty sports a 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 17.1 IP), which is tied with former teammate LHP **Zach Thornton** for the South Atlantic League lead...Díaz is also tied with Thornton for the circuit's best WHIP (0.68) and ranks 4th in batting average against (.164).

OFF AND RUNNING: The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on Tuesday saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 different players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...On a night where 8 of Brooklyn's 9 starters were Top 30 prospects in the Mets organization per MLB Pipeline, C **Chris Suero** and DH **Jesús Báez** each swiped 2 bags, while 5 other players finished with a steal.

HANG ESTAR ON THAT BABY: INF Estarling Mercado has been red hot with the bat to start 2025...The 22-year-old tallied his 3rd 3-hit game of the season last Friday night, clubbing a 2-run home run in the 3rd inning...Entering play on Tuesday, Mercado is hitting .360 (18-50) with 7 runs scored, 5 extra-base hits, a home run, and 10 RBI...Since April 10, the left-handed swinger has reached base safely in 10 of 12 games, posting a .385 average (15-39) with 5 runs scored, 3 extra-base knocks, a home run, and 9 batted in...Among South Atlantic League players with 60 or more plate appearances, Mercado ranks tied for 2nd in batting average (.360), 5th in OPS (.970), and 8th in slugging percentage (.520) and on-base percentage (.450).

HALL OF A START: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP Noah Hall has returned to form in 2025...Over his first 6 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 2-2 with a 1.88 ERA (6 ER in 28.2 IP), 35 strikeouts and only 20 hits allowed...Entering Tuesday, Hall is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in strikeouts (35) with Hudson Valley's RHP Elmer Rodríguez-Cruz...He is also 6th in innings pitched (28.2) and 8th in ERA (1.88)...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

START ME UP: Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite over the season's first 24 games...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 2.88 ERA (34 ER in 106.1 IP)...Under the leadership of first-year pitching coach Jordan Kraus, the starters hold an impressive 130-to-33 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 2.88 ERA is the lowest among starting pitching staffs in the South Atlantic League...Aberdeen is 2nd (312)...It is also 3rd among all High-A franchises...Kansas City's Quad Cities (2.09) has the lowest mark at the level...Overall, Brooklyn's pitching staff has a 313 ERA (79 ER in 227.0 IP), which is good for the 3rd-lowest at High-A and 5th-lowest in Minor League Baseball...Quad Cities (2.49) holds the lowest mark at High-A and in Mil.B.

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, Cyclones relievers have a 10-3 record with a 3.36 ERA (45 ER in 120.2 IP), 5 saves, 61 walks, and an eye-popping 168 strikeouts...Brooklyn's 1.09 WHIP from relief arms is tied for the lowest at the High-A level with Hudson Valley and 4th-lowest in Minor League Baseball...Detroit's Double-A Fize is 1st (0.97)...Brooklyn's 12.53 strikeouts-per-nine-innings ratio is 3rd-best in Mil.B...San Diego's Double-A San Antonio (13.32) holds the top spot...The Cyclones have also held opponents to a .171 batting average, which is 2nd-lowest in the minors behind Miami's Double-A Pensacola (.156)...On the year, Brooklyn relievers have a 34.15% strikeout rate.

SUPER SUERO: C Chris Suero has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On April 15, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his sole shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Tuesday, Suero is 4th in the South Atlantic League in hit-by-pitches (6) and OPS (941), ited for 4th in home runs (5), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (11), 6th in slugging percentage (.543), and tied for 8th in RBI (18).

ELI'S ELITE NIGHT: OF Eli Serrano III put together his best game as a professional April 24's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano was the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3 runs, 3+ runs, 3+ runs, 4 retara-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBl in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...2B Luke Ritter also accomplished the feat 9th 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBl in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...IF Alex Ramirez was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley....Entering Tuesday, Serrano is tied for 7th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (10).

BORN TO RUNS: The Cyclones tallied 15 runs and 16 hits en route to a 15-1 win v. Wilmington last Wednesday...lt marked the 3rd time this season in which Brooklyn collected 12 or more runs and 16 or more hits in a single game, and the 2nd time they ve hit the 15-run plateau...The Cyclones also accrued 15 runs and 20 hits in a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 5...April 24th's 12-5 win over Jersey Shore marked the 6th time Brooklyn had tallied 12-plus runs and 17-plus hits in a single game since moving to the High-A level before the 2021 season...It was also the first time since 2021 that the Cyclones have had multiple games with 12+ runs and 17+ hits in the same season.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 10 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), INF Jacob Reimer (20), c Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), and INF A.J. Ewing (27)... Of those 10, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 8 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), and Ewing (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 9 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), and Hernández (26).
