Jersey Shore BlueClaws (13-15/38-53) vs Wilmington Blue Rocks (13-16/43-51)

ShoreTown Ballpark – Lakewood, NJ (opened 2001) RHP Braydon Tucker (1-3, 4.01) vs RHP Joel Tejeda, Jr. (--) Series: Game 6 of 6 (Wilmington leads season series 9-8 of 24)

Last Game Recap...The BlueClaws and Blue Rocks split a double-header on Saturday...lersey Shore took game one 3-1 behind five innings from Mavis Graves (1 R/O ER)...Eduardo Tait had an RBI double...Wilmington won game two 2-0, scoring twice of Casey Steward (1 ER)...Alex Clemmey gave up one hit over five scoreless innings to earn the win.

State of the Teams...The BlueClaws (5-2 this homestand) swept a two game series from Hudson Valley over the weekend (Sunday's game was postponed)...They are now 11-8 in their last 19 games after a 2-7 start to the second half...Wilmington lost two of three to Aberdeen in Delaware over the weekend and split six games at Brooklyn the week leading into the All-Star break...They are 8-9 in their last 17 games.

Run Run Rincon...Bryan Rincon has 31 stolen bases on the season, a career-best (27 in 2023)...Rincon's 31 are the second most by a BlueClaw since they became a High-A affiliate in 2021, after Johan Rojas' 33 from 2022...Emaarion Boyd and Justin Crawford each stole 27 Dasses last year.

Aloha Means Goodbye. Devin Saltiban homered on both Wednesday and Thursday, his first two since returning...He had been on the IL since May 8", was activated on July 18" (4-22, 2B, 2 HBs, 3 RBis since return)...He hit 17 home runs with Clearwater ist year...Saltiban was 8-17 with a home run in his first four May games before his injury...He has played centerfield since returning, the position he played most in high school but hadn't played as a professional until his rehab assignment with the FCL Phillies...The 20 year old from Hillo, Hawaii was the Phillies 3" orund pick in 2023.

Going, Going...Devin Saltiban homered twice this week including a leadoff home run on Wednesday, his second lead-off blast (4/27 vs Brooklyn)...He is the first BlueClaw with two leadoff home runs in a season since Nate Fassnacht in 2021 and his was the first leadoff home run by the BlueClaws since Aidan Miller's on July 4th vs Wilmington last year...The BlueClaws have 11 home runs since the start of the second half on June 20th (only Rome, 7, has fewer in High-A)...Zach Arnold has three and Bryan Rincon and Devin Saltiban have two since the start of the second half.

Tait Joins the Claws...Catcher Eduardo Tait (3-17, RBI double, SAC fly) drove in the winning run on Thursday with a SAC fly scoring Aroon Escobar in the 8th inning...He singled to left on Wednesday for his first BlueClaws hit...The Phillies #4 prospect and the #60 overall prospect in baseball per MLB Pipeline Joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater on July 22th...At the time of his promotion, he led the Florida State League in home runs (tied with 11), RBIs (51), and extra-base hits (31) while third in doubles (19). He also played in the MLB Futures Game in July as one of just three players from a Single-A team to participate in the mid-summer showcase...<u>Tait is the first 18 year old to play for the BlueClaws since they became a High-A affiliate in 2021</u> (he will turn 19 on August 27th).

Not Missing a Beat...Aroon Escobar (12-48, 6 RBIs) tripled in the 8th on Thursday and scored the game winning run...He drove in three runs in the win on July 18th against Hudson Valley...Escobar is the 8f prospect in the Phillies system per MLB Pipeline, and joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater on July 8th...Escobar was hitting. 285 with 11 home runs, 42 RBIs, and 10 stolen bases with the Threshers...At the time of his promotion, Escobar was 6th in the FSL in average, T1st (with teammate Eduardo Tait) in home runs, 5th in RBIs, 1st in hits (78), and 1st in runs (52). Hit .360 with five home runs and a 1.088 OPS in April, winning Phillies Minor League Player of the Month.

AOA on a ROLL...Avery Owusu-Asiedu is now 16-55 with two doubles and a home run in July...Owusu-Asiedu already has six multi-hit games with Jersey Shore...He hit his first BlueClaws home run (16[®] of his career) on July 3rd in Lakewood...49th round pick in 2023 from Southern Illinois, Owusu-Asiedu began the year with Clearwater where he was hitting .268 with five home runs and 16 stolen bases...He hit nine home runs with the Threshers last year.

Ware 'em Out...Bryson Ware hit his 8th home run of the season on July 11th...Since May 9th, Bryson Ware is 43-147 (.296) with seven of his eight home runs and 11 doubles...Between Opening Day and May 8th, he was hitting .107 with one extra base hit, a triple...Ware has started games this year at 18, 28, 38, SS, LF, and RF...He was an 8th round pick from Auburn in 2023.

Getting Biddy With It...IF Nick Biddison had a two run double on July 18th and is 13-57 (.228) with the BlueClaws since arriving on June 28th...He hit his first BlueClaws home run on July 3th...He was acquired from the Dodgers and most recently with AA Tulsa...Biddington was originally a 4th round pick in 2022 from IVriginia Tech...He is spent last year with Great Lakes in the Midwest League, hitting. 220 with seven home runs and 21 stolen bases...He missed the first month of this season with an injury and was with Tulsa at the time of the trade to Philadelphia...Biddison was originally a 4th round pick of the Dodgers from Virginia Tech in 2022...He was a teammate of 2025 BlueClaws OF Dylan Campbell last year with Great Lakes and with 2025 BlueClaws IF Carson DeMarthin in 2022 at Virginia Tech.

Lights Out...Saul Teran (1.1 scoreless innings to earn the win on Thursday) is back with the BlueClaws after spending the July 4th weekend with Double-A Somerset...He has allowed three runs in 1.2. innings with Jersey Shore, adding 12 strikeouts and his five saves lead the team...He gave up two earned runs in 18 innings, adding 31 strikeouts and three walks with Clearwater before originally joining the BlueClaws on June 2th...Teran, 23, signed with the Phillies in 2021.

The Return of Raylin...Raylin Heredia had an RBI single on Tuesday against Wilmington, and has two, two-hit games since returning from the IL on July 4th (9-39 since returning)...Heredia got off to a hot start, going 16-48 with two HRs and 13 RBIs in 16 games through May 2th before breaking a pinky finger diving for a fly ball in centerfield...The 21 year old spent last year with Cleanwater, birthing 28 withing 18 with high before year.

Extra, Extra innings? No problem! The BlueClaws are 6-0 in extra innings this season after their win on July 4th at Wilmington...They are one of only two teams in Minor League Baseball without a loss in extra innings this year – Fort Wayne (1-0) is the other.. Durham was 7-0 but lost in 10 on 7/5 at Norfolk...Albuquerque was 4-0 and lost on 7/11 at Round Rock.

Save Index...Andrew Baker got his fourth save of the year and fifth professional save (August of 2023 with Reading was the other) Saturday against Wilmington after earning a save on Tuesday as well...Saul Teran earned his fifth save in game one of the double-header on July 2rd...Teran's five lead the team and he is halfway to becoming the first BlueClaw since Zach Warren and Addison Russ in 2018 to reach double-digits...Paxton Thompson earned the save June 25rd at Brooklyn, his third of the season and first since May 25rd...Jaydenn Estanistata (promoted to Reading) picked up his fourth save, and eighth of his career, with a scoreless inning in game one on June 7rd at Bowling Green...Tommy McCollum (promoted to Reading on 5/1) has three

Balk This Way...The BlueClaws balked (Erubiel Armenta) on July 26th, their MiLB-leading 37th of the year (one more than Asheville)...They are in balking distance of the 48 set by Lynchburg in 2023, the most in minors since at least 2005...Jersey Shore has balked in nine runs this year, tied with Asheville for the most in the minors... The BlueClaws had a club record five balks on 5/9 vs Aberdeen, and four each on 6/27 and 6/29 at Brooklyn...This year, only three teams have issued at least four balks in a game, the BlueClaws three times, and Aberdeen on 5/1 at Brooklyn (4)...The BlueClaws single-season record was 20 (last year).

Big Innings...The BlueClaws have allowed four-plus runs in an inning 30 times this season, the last time on July 23rd vs Wilmington (Asheville has allowed 32 such innings), in 27 different games over which they are 2-26...Their second win was on 6/7 at Bowling Green (allowed four runs in the seventh and won in 10)...Their other win in a game in which they allowed four runs in an inning was game two of the 4/12 double-header against Aberdeen, an 8-7 come-from-behind win (Eduardo Lopez go-ahead home run in the 5th of the seventh and was leaded multiple walks.

From the Draft...OF Joel Dragoo, (7th round, 2024 from Presbyterian) joined the BlueClaws on June 24th and became the only member of the 2024 draft class on the team...Carson DeMartini (4th round, Virginia Tech) was with jersey Shore from Opening Day through June 9th...As anot Combis was an 8th round pick last year by the White Sox and traded to the Phillies (for LIP Tyler Gilbert) on New Year's Day...DeMartini was the only 2024 draft class member to open the season with Jersey Shore, marking the third straight season the BlueClaws have only had one member of the preceding year's draft class on the Opening Day roster (Troy Schreffer, 12th round in 2022) at 2023, Zach Arnold, 13th round in 2023 in 2024).

New to the Phillies...The BlueClaws roster includes three players that were acquired by the Phillies in the off-season: RHP Gabriel Barbosa (Minor League Rule-5 Draft from the Yankees), RHP Aaron Combs (from the White Sox for LHP Tyler Gilbert), RHP Josh Hejka (from the Mets in February for cash considerations)...C Luis Caicuto was a Minor League Rule-5 pick from the Diamondbacks in December of 2023...The Phillies were the only team to use six picks in the 2024 Minor League Rule-5 Draft (three of which have been released with Jersey Shore - OF Elio Prado, RHP Augusto Calderon, OF Eduardo Lopez).

Comebacks...The BlueClaws erased a 4-0 deficit on May 10th to come back and top Aberdeen 9-8, matching their largest comeback win of the season...Their win on 4/17 at Greensboro was their first of the season in which they trailed after the 8th inning - they had five such wins last year (last one was 7/21/24 at Brooklyn when they tied the game in the 9^{th} inning on an RBI double from Felix Reyes and scored three times in the 10th)...Meanwhile, the BlueClaws lost a 7-0 lead on 4/18 at Greensboro, their largest blown lead since also losing a 7-0 at Greensboro, on 5/31/15, and the fourth time since 2011 (4/19/12 at Hagerstown and 4/22/11 at Asheville) they have lost a seven run lead...The BlueClaws gave up two in the ninth to fall on 5/3 at Hudson Valley, a game they led in the ninth after a Jordan Viars tie-breaking home run put them up 4-3 earlier in the inning.

Power Index...Devin Saltiban led all current BlueClaws with 18 home runs in 2024 (17 with Clearwater)...Jordan Viars had 14 last year, 12 with Clearwater and two (both in the final series of the season) with Jersey Shore...Dylan Campbell (since promoted) hit 10 with Great Lakes in the Dodgers system.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have one walk-off win this year – a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 –July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen.

Snapped at Four...The BlueClaws entered 2025 with four straight winning halves (a streak that has been snapped), both halves in 2023 and 2024, all four halves managed by Greg Brodzinski...The BlueClaws had 10 straight winning halves from 2006 through 2010, all 10 halves in that five year stretch, a streak snapped when they went 33-35 in the first half of the 2011 season

New to ShoreTown...Of the 31 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 13 are making their BlueClaws debuts this season...Of the remaining 18, 14 were with the BlueClaws at the end of the 2024 season (the remaining four were with Reading: RHP Andrew Baker, RHP Tommy McCollum, C Jordan Dissin, IF Zach Arnold)...Baker, McCollum, and Dissin have all been promoted to Reading, though Baker has since returned.

Just Grand... Bryan Rincon's grand slam on 5/20 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...127 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show...Otto Kemp made his Phillies debut on 6/7 and Mick Abel made his Phillies debut on 5/18, the first two to debut this year...Two debuted last year (Ben Brown debuted with the Cubs and Sam Aldegheri debuted with the Angels)...Aldegheri, who was with the BlueClaws from Opening Day 2024 through July 6th, joins Orion Kerkering (2023) as the only players to ever play for the BlueClaws and in the big leagues in the same year (non-rehab).

Just Win Baby...The BlueClaws are the only team in the South Atlantic League and High-A to win more than 70 games in both 2023 (73-58) and 2024 (74-58).

Bull Back for a Third...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2025 after leading the BlueClaws to a 73-58 mark in 2023 (and a postseason berth) and a 74-58 mark in

2024...He is the first manager to lead the BlueClaws in three seasons (PJ Forbes in 2004-05, Steve Roadcap in 2007-08, Mickey Morandini in 2012-13, Shawn Williams in 2015-16 and Marty Malloy in 2017-18 are the five managers to manage the BlueClaws for two seasons)...Brodzinski was a coach

with Lehigh Valley in 2022 and on the Phillies staff in 2020 and 2021...He is a graduate of Bishop Eustace Prep in Pennsauken, New Jersey.

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter joins the BlueClaws as the pitching coach after spending the last two seasons with Lehigh Valley...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Matt Snyder is the hitting coach in his first year in the organization – he was the Assistant Hitting Coordinator for the Marlins last year and in their organization as a coach since 2020...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws as the Bench Coach...2021-22 BlueClaws C Herbert Iser makes his coaching debut as the Development Coach...Iser played in the Phillies system from 2019 through 2023 and played collegiately at Dallas Baptist.


