ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Hudson Valley scored six first-inning run, knocking Brooklyn starter RHP **Junior Santos** out of the game after 2/3 of an inning en route to a 10-2 victory Tuesday night. The Renegades were led by OF **Grant Richardson** and OF **Pat DeMarco** who combined to go 5-for-8 with four RBIs. Brooklyn C **Jose Mena** and INF **Jose Peroza** each drove in runs. RHP **Justin Courtney** shined over the middle of the game, tossing 3 1/3 innings of scoreless ball.

SUBWAY SERIES: Tonight continues a six-game series between Brooklyn and Hudson Valley -- the New York Mets affiliate against the New York Yankees affiliate -- while the parent clubs also do battle in a two-game series at Citi Field. The Cyclones enter tonight's game 1 1/2-games behind the Renegades.

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

PALMER POUNDING HV: OF **Jaylen Palmer** leads the team with seven home runs. Four of those seven homers have come against Hudson Valley this season. Despite a .839 OPS against the Yankees affiliate, Palmer has a 47% strikeout rate in 16 games (27 strikeouts in 58 plate appearances).

RA-RA FOR RAMIREZ: OF **Alex Ramirez** destroyed Jersey Shore pitching in the weekend series. The 19-year-old No. 4 Mets prospect, according to *MLB Pipeline*, had a double, two home runs, and 10 RBIs, going 8-for-13.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The New York Yankees High-A farm club and the Cyclones have played 19 of 30 in the 2022 series. So far, the Renegades are 11-8. No. 3 prospect, and the No. 39 prospect in baseball, OF Jasson Dominguez has recently joined the team. The current Renegades roster hosts seven of the Yankees Top 30s, including No. 6 SS Trey Sweeney, No. 8 RHP Yoendrys Gomez, No. 19 LHP T.J. Sikkema, and No. 24 2B Cooper Bowman.

CON SWAGGER: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has had a dominant start to his Brooklyn career, collecting eight doubles, one triple, and two home runs in 16 games with 10 RBIs.

NIC KNOWS: C **Nic Gaddis** has enjoyed a power play stretch at the plate, homering four times in his past 17 games. Since June 21, Gaddis has a .436 OBP, .493 slugging percentage and a .929 OPS, reaching in 22 of his past 24 games.

PEROZA POP: INF **Jose Peroza** has collected 36 total bases in his past 20 games with five doubles, one triple, and three home runs. Peroza has also played second base (28), shortstop (4), and third base (41) this season.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 46 home runs in the past 57 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

MLB DRAFT: This past week the Mets selected 22 new players in the 2022 MLB Draft, including five picks in the Top 90. The Mets selected No. 11 C **Kevin Parada** from Georgia Tech and No. 14 SS **Jett Williams** from Rockwall-Heath High School in Texas.

MORE! Luis Moreno makes his seventh start at High-A and seventh South Atlantic League appearance, pitching against Hudson Valley for the second time.

MORE-K-NO: Moreno struck out a career-high nine batters at Hudson Valley on July 2 in his first appearance against the Yankees affiliate.

WELCOME: Moreno earned the promotion on June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

BIG YEAR: The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as "quality starts."

2022: With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

ELIMINATING HOMERS: Moreno's 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

JUMP IN: Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
