OFFENSES ONLY COOLED BY RAIN IN LOSS TO AMARILLO:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell 11-10 in a wild, rain-shortened game to the Amarillo Sod Poodles from HODGETOWN on Thursday night. Two pitches after an RBI single from Corbin Carroll gave the Sod Poodles the lead in the bottom of the fifth with one out, the game went into delay and it was announced as a final contest after a 1 hour, 44-minute delay. The RoughRiders (28-26) struck first on the offensive side in the first inning when **Justin Foscue** blasted a 448-foot home run to left field to make it 1-0. After **Dustin Harris** was hit by a pitch and stole second base, he came into score on a **Sandro Fabian** RBI double and the Riders extended their lead to 2-0. Amarillo (26-28) struck back in the bottom of the first with an RBI groundout from Eduard Diaz and a Leandro Cedenio two-run homer to jump the Riders 3-2. Frisco charged back in the second when Foscue ripped a two-run single to left, scoring **Kellen Strahm** and **Jax Biggers**, to put the Riders up 4-3. A pair of RBI hits, a double from Elvis Peralta and an RBI single by Jorge Barrosa, allowed Amarillo to take the lead right back at 5-4 in the bottom of the second. The third inning brought more runs for the Riders. **Blaine Crim** smashed a solo homer to right, his 11th of the season, before **Trey Hair** lashed his third home run of the series, a two-run blast, to put Frisco up 7-5. Amarillo then tied the game at 7-7 with a pair of runs in the third, both scoring on an infield single from Roby Enriquez. In the fourth, Harris started the scoring with an RBI double before Crim lifted a sacrifice fly to left and Fabian capped a 3-for-3 night with an RBI single to put Frisco out in front 10-7. Carroll hammered a two-run home run in the fourth and then - after the Riders were held off of the board in the top of the fifth - Peralta tied the game with an RBI single and Carroll had the go-ahead single in the home half of the fifth before the delay. **Tai Tiedemann** (1-3) was handed the loss in relief for Frisco while Josh Green (1-1) took home the win for the Sod Poodles.

GOT IT BY MORE THAN JUST A HAIR:

Trey Hair has been crushing the baseball in June. He has homered in three-straight games in Amarillo, one away from the franchise record of four-straight games with a home run. It's been done four times, most recently by **J.T. Wise** from August 28-31, 2014. Right now, Hair is on a seven-game hitting streak, batting .346 (9-for-26) with two doubles, four home runs and eight RBIs.

SENDIN' IN BRENNAN:

Riders reliever **Tim Brennan** has been lights out since coming to the RoughRiders from Extended Spring Training. After joining the team in mid May, Brennan is 1-0 with a 0.79 ERA over 11.1 innings. In his five outings, Brennan has allowed just one run on six hits with 12 strikeouts. Opponents are hitting just .158 against him while a ridiculously high 70.4 percent of balls put in play against him have been on the ground, leading to a .222 BABIP.

BEST IN THE BACK END:

The RoughRiders have been dynamite in the bullpen this season, owning the best bullpen ERA in the Texas League at 4.07 (tied with Wichita). Frisco also has the best bullpen WHIP in the league at 1.34 while ceding the third-fewest homers in the circuit (25 in 54 games).

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** started off slowly, but he has started to turn his offensive game around. Over his last 11 games, Strahm is hitting .452 (14-for-31)/.553/.548 with three doubles, seven walks, six runs, three RBIs and just three strikeouts. In that stretch, Strahm has raised his average from .148 to .232 and his OPS from .528 to .683. In his last 17 games, he is batting .340/.444/.396/.840. Among those with at least 140 PA in the Texas League, Strahm is fourth in walk rate (17.1 percent).

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 2-16 when scoring three runs or fewer and 15-2 when allowing three runs or fewer.

ALL ABOARD THE COLE TRAIN:

RoughRiders starter **Cole Ragans** has been the best arm for Frisco all season long. Ragans poured in the longest start of his minor league career on June 8th in Amarillo, throwing 6.1 shutout innings, allowing just three infield singles while walking one and tying a season-high nine strikeouts. This season, Ragans is third the Texas League in ERA (2.81), fourth in strikeouts (65), 11th in innings (51.1), seventh in opponent batting average (.219) and fourth in WHIP (1.17). Among qualifiers, his 2.81 ERA is the best in the Rangers organization as well. Listed as the No. 29 prospect in the Rangers system, Ragans is sure to climb the list upon the reranking during the middle of the season.

NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 54 games, Frisco has hit 74 long balls (1.4 per game) which is third in the Texas League and tied for 13th in Minor League Baseball. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 189 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (beating 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). In May, the RoughRiders hit 44 home runs in 26 games, the second-best total in Minor League Baseball (and averaging 1.7 per game). Out of their 54 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 38 games, which means that when they hit a home run, they are averaging 2.0 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 16 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 7-9. **Blaine Crim** is tied for sixth in the league with 11 home runs while **Dustin Harris** has 10 home runs, 10th in the league.

CRIM CRUSH:

Blaine Crim has heated up as the season has shifted into early June. Over his last 33 games, Crim is hitting .309 (38-for-123)/.382/.618 with eight doubles, 10 home runs and 28 RBIs. Crim led the Rangers organization in 2021 with 29 home runs and he is atop the org again this season with 11 so far in 2022. His eight homers in May were tied for the most in the Texas League. Overall, Crim was sixth in the league with a 1.096 May OPS.

ABOUT AVERY

-Went to Coconino High School in Flagstaff.

-Attended Yavapai College in 2016 and 2017, going 6-4 with a 2.89 ERA over 18 outings while whiffing 87 over 65.1 innings his sophomore year.

-Transferred to University of Arizona for final two years of college, going 6-8 with a 6.46 ERA over 53 games with 17 starts.

-Selected by the White Sox in the sixth round of the 2019 draft. Even though his numbers were not the most impressive in college, the Sox saw positive analytics and pitch data from him. The scout that drafted Weems, John Kazanas, had seen him since high school and had faith in Weems despite the poor numbers.

-Weems was traded to Rangers from Chicago White Sox in December 8th, 2020 along with RHP Dane Dunning in exchange for RHP Lance Lynn.

2022 SEASON

-Made relief appearance in first series before starting his first game in San Antonio on April 13th. In that start, only threw two innings, allowing four runs (all earned) on four hits, including a three-run home run in the first inning to San Antonio's Jorge Ona.

-Earned first win with the Riders in 10-5 victory over Midland on April 27th. Needing to get through the fifth to qualify for the win, he threw a six-pitch fifth inning before not coming back out for the sixth.

2021 SEASON

-Ended the season as the No. 28 pitching prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Led High-A East with 124 strikeouts over his 20 games (19 starts). His 13.08 K/9 ranked 15th in the minors (min. 80.0 IP).

2020 SEASON
