LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped its fifth-straight contest in a 6-5 loss at Bowling Green on Friday night...T The Cyclones grabbed the lead with two runs in the top of the ninth on a RF Omar De Los Santos sacrifice fly and a 1 B Karell Paz triple...However, the Hot Rods walked it off on a bases-loaded hit-by-pitch and two walks...C Chris Suero collected a pair of knocks, including a go-anead two-run home run in the seventh...CF Staniey Consuegra als five innings of work, allowing one run and striking out six in a no-decision

MORABITO FUEL: OF Nick Morabito has reached safely all nine games since making his High-A and Cyclones debut on May 7 at Rome and enters play on Saturday riding a 20 -game on-base streak dating back to his time in the Florida State League...Since the streak began on April 20, the third-year pro is hitting $.441 / .537 / .500 / 1.037$ with 14 runs scored, four doubles, four RBI, and 16 stolen bases...The now 21-year-old is second in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.504), trailing only INF Trent Farquhar (.509) of Philadelphia's Single-A Clearwater.... He is also third in batting average (.384), fifth in wOBA (.483), tied for seventh in stolen bases (20), and eighth in wRC+ (192)... The Mclean, Va. native's three stolen bases on Wednesday tied nine others collect three swipes in a single match since LF Alex Ramírez accomplished the feat on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley.

ORELLANA'S OVERWHELMING START: RHP Douglas Orellana set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome and continued his impressive start to 2024 on Friday night...Orellana is tied for fifth among South Atlantic League pitchers with 41 strikeouts...Additionally,
among arms with $29.0+$ innings of work, Orellana leads the league in ERA (1.23) and ranks third in and sixth in WHP (099) Orellana's 123 ERA (4 ER in 291 P ) is the fift.-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 29.0+ innings of work...The 22-year-old whiffed 10 in his start against the Emperors, the second dou-ble-digit strikeout game of his career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the to strike out $10+$ hitters in a single game since RHP Robert Colina punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fourth loss of the season last Sunday afternoon at Rome...Surrendered four runs on four hits over a season-low 2.2 innings...Walked two and struck out four... Permitted a solo home run to SS E.J. Exposito in the bottom of the second...Relieved by RHP Dakota Hawkins with a man at third, two out, in the bottom of the third and Brooklyn trailing 4-0...The Cyclones ultimately dropped the series finale to the Emperors, 8-2.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by Baseball America.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA ( 5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP José Butto accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Single-A....Over his final eight appearances (seven starts), De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)... Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP Danny Wilkinson (49) who was second....De La Cruz went $1-2$ with a 4.33 ERA ( 17 ER in 35.1 IP) with 18 walks (11.4 BB\%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1\%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22 -year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate ( $28.7 \%$ )...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5\%), while ranking 2 nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances ( 19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA ( 47 ER in 90.1 IP ), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
