Lansing Reunion in Oakland: 2022 Lugnuts southpaw Hogan Harris tossed six three-hit scoreless innings in an A's 2-1 walk-off victory against the Toronto Blue Jays last night at The Coliseum. Toronto's lineup included former Lugnuts Davis Schneider, Vladimir Guerrero Jr., Bo Bichette and Alejandro Kirk, while former Nuts Tyler Soderstrom and Max Schuemann were in the lineup for Oakland and Mason Miller pitched a perfect ninth, receiving his first career MLB victory when JJ Bleday swatted a game-winning homer in the bottom of the ninth.

A'round the A's System: 2024 Opening Day starter James Gonzalez was brilliant yesterday for Double-A Midland, tossing six scoreless one-hit innings with eight strikeouts, though the RockHounds fell to San Antonio, 3-1. Ryan Lasko homered for the Single-A Stockton Ports and Nelson Beltran went 3-for-5, helping the Ports edge San Jose, 3-2. And teenage switch-hitter German Ortiz went 3-for-5, but the Arizona Complex League Athletics lost to the Diamondbacks, 8-5.

Team Effort: The Nuts are 2nd in the league in batting average (.255), 3rd in runs scored (288), tied for 2nd in hits (464), 2nd in total bases (720), 3rd in doubles (94), 1st in triples (24), 3rd in RBIs (261), 2nd in walks (249), 2nd in OBP (.350), tied for 2nd in slugging (.395) and 2nd in team OPS (.745).

Individual Efforts: Henry Bolte is 1st in runs scored (47), 1st in doubles (15), 2nd in extra-base hits (26), 2nd in total bases (101), tied for 4th in steals (21), 6th in slugging (.502), tied for 6th in OPS (.903), tied for 8th in hits (56) and 8th in walks (33). Brayan Buelvas is tied for 1st in triples (5), 3rd in extra-base hits (24), 4th in runs scored (38), 4th in doubles (13), tied for 6th in total bases (93), 7th in walks (34), tied for 9th in steals (15) and 10th in RBIs (35). Euribiel Ángeles is tied for 2nd in RBIs (41), tied for 3rd in triples (4) and 5th in base hits (58).

Welcome to the Show: Southpaw Brady Basso, who pitched for the Nuts in 2021, underwent Tommy John, and returned successfully last season, became the third former Lugnut this season to reach the Majors on May 31 (joining Max Schuemann and Brett Harris) and the 187th Major League Lugnut in franchise history.

2016: The Lake County Captains committed six errors but also collected 20 hits, beating the Lugnuts 14-12 at Classic Park. Seven of the Lugnuts' 12 runs were unearned, with a four-run 1st inning and a five-run 3rd inning helped out by two-out errors from Lake County third baseman Sam Haggerty.

González was promoted on May 8, so Myers made the next four starts without a piggybacker... joined a tandem with Chen Zhang-Ao Zhuang beginning June 2... notable splits:



Respect: Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Monkey Ball...* he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016 and spent 2022 with the Cincinnati Reds.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.

In a Nutshell: After not pitching in 2023, dominated in Stockton to open the season, earning promotion to Lansing May 29 and making his Lugnuts debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on June 2, becoming the 942nd all-time Lugnut and the 13th different starting pitcher this season... name is pronounced "Chen Jong-Ow Jwahng"... works with interpreter Yen Po "Rambo" Wang... nicknamed "Z."

First Start: Struggled in the first inning vs. Peoria, allowing three runs on two walks and three hits, including a two-out, two-run triple by Michael Curialle... set down the final ten batters faced, with five strikeouts, in a 5-3 Lugnuts seven-inning victory.

Hometown Heroes: Giants pitcher Kai-Wei Teng is the only 2024 Major Leaguer from Taiwan, though Teng is currently with the Sacramento River Cats... there have been 17 Major Leaguers all-time from Taiwan, the first being Chin-Feng Chen of the Dodgers, who played from 2002-2005... the Yankees' Chien-Ming Wang (2005-09, 2011-13, 2016) has the most career wins (68), the Orioles/Marlins' Wei-Yin Chen (2012-19) has the most career innings pitched (1,064 2/3), and Cleveland's Yu Chang (2019-23) has the most offensive records, from games played (235) to runs (72) to hits (121) to homers (20).

Record-Setters: In Lugnuts franchise history, the first Taiwanese players were Po-Hsuan Keng, who pitched primarily out of the bullpen for the Nuts from 2005-2007, and Chi-Hung Chen, who a starting pitcher in 2005-06 and 2008... last year, Brock Whittlesey broke Keng's franchise record of most career appearances... Whittlesey pitched in 103 games from 2021-23, while Keng appeared in 94... Cheng owns the Lugnuts' franchise record for most career innings pitched (374), with Keng ranking second (202); Cheng also ranks first in games started (67), career wins (23), losses (20), starts (67), strikeouts (367), runs (188), hits (360), and walks (189).
