LAST TIME OUT

Moosic, PA (July 20) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders dropped a back-and-forth battle 10-8 to the Worcester Red Sox. The score changed hands nine times with eleven runs in total coming in the eighth or later. The RailRiders had two homers in the loss including one from Major League rehabber Jake Bauers.

Everson Pereira led off the scoring with a solo shot, his second in Triple-A.

Worcester got on the board in the fourth inning. Cedonne Rafaela doubled to reach and Bobby Dalbec singled him home to tie things up at one.

The WooSox took the lead in the fifth. Narcisco Crook tripled and scored on a wild pitch. David Hamilton knocked in another run for a 3-1 advantage.

In the bottom half, the RailRiders tied things up at three apiece. Bauers, in Major League rehab, smashed two-run homer 417 feet into dead center field. Bauers continued the offense with a deep double to begin the seventh. He stole a bag and raced home on Andres Chaparro's RBI single for a 4-3 lead.

Worcester battled back in the next frame. Ronaldo Hernandez had a solo shot and Stephen Scott torched a three-run blast for a four-run frame and a 7-4 lead.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was right there for control once again in the home half. Jamie Westbrook drew a walk, Jesus Bastidas singled, Brandon Lockridge walked to load the bases. A sacrifice fly from Michael Herмосillo plated one run and a balk drove in another. Pereira laced a base knock to bring in Lockridge tying things up at seven. Chaparro followed it up with a double to center field driving in the go-ahead run.

In the top of the ninth, the WooSox got another three-run homer from Scott to take the game once and for all 10-8.

Randy Vasquez got the start throwing four innings of work. He allowed three runs on five hits with four strikeouts. Zach Greene and Aaron McGarity had clean outings. Matt Bowman gave up four runs on two homers in his inning and a third. Greg Weissert let up three runs in the ninth.

Dinelson Lamet got the start going four and a third allowing three runs on four hits. Chase Shugart took the win, while AJ Politi got his ninth save of the season.

NEWS & NOTES

HOMER HEAVEN The RailRiders are the first team in Minor League Baseball to hit 150 home runs on the season and have 152 this season. Worcester has totaled 137 as a team. The New York Yankees have amassed 134, and the Atlanta Braves have the most with 182. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. The team homered 20 times in a week against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial leads the team with twenty-one, while six players are in double digits.

BAUERS BOMB: Last night on a Major League rehab assignment, Jake Bauers hit a game-tying home run for his 10th with the RailRiders. He also doubled and stole a base. The lefty played seven innings in center field. Before being placed on the Injured List, Bauers played 49 games with New York with 30 hits including seven homers.

SCORING SUCCESS: The best offensive innings for the RailRiders are the fifth and eighth frames where they have scored 72 runs in each. In the second half the team has a plus 33 run differential and have scored 49 more runs than their counterparts in total. Opponents have plated the most offense against them in the second inning with 63 runs.

AUSTIN ARRIVES: Yankees #2 prospect Austin Wells received the call up to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre today. After beginning the season on the injured list with a rib fracture, he played five games of rehab in Tampa before reporting to Somerset. In Double-A, he played in 58 games for a .237 average with 54 hits. The lefty has 14 doubles and 11 homers with a team-high 50 runs batted in.

SEVENTH MONTH STRONG: Andres Chaparro is off to a stellar start in the month of July. He has played a team-high thirteen games with a .346 batting average. The righty has totaled 18 hits, including five doubles and three home runs. He has batted in 18 runs and scored ten of his own. Chaparro is looking to build back up after a tough month of June where he batted .193 in 24 games.

PEREIRA'S POWER: Everson Pereira has really impressed as the Yankees #4 prospect in Triple-A with at least one hit in all ten games he has played in. He has also had four of multi-hit and five multi-RBI. Pereira has batted in 11 runs and scored 11 on 16 hits. The righty has played all three outfield positions. In Somerset, Pereira was batting .291 in 46 total games. There Pereira had 10 doubles and 10 homers.

LEADING THE CHARGE - The RailRiders have had nine different first basemen this season, with Jake Lamb making his debut last night. Andres Chaparro leads the way with Billy McKinney following shortly thereafter. Catchers Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez have turned into regulars in the corner. Mickey Gasper, Jake Bauers, Franchy Cordero and Max Burt have defended there as well.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospects, catcher, Austin Wells (#2 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) and outfielder Everson Periera (#4) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#7), Randy Vasquez (#12), and Clayton Beeter (#13) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre this summer.

Will's two-strike execution has been much improved from last year. That's showing in the amount of strikeouts that he's been able to get so far. I think he's definitely knocking on the door (for Triple-A). We're going to focus on what we can control in the process here and he's doing a good job of that. I think he's going to control the success that he has based off of his execution. He's walked some batters, but a lot of that was early just trying to strike more people out instead of maybe just pitching to contact like he's done in the early part of his career. I think you have to learn how to miss bats and we're seeing progress."

For his efforts, he was named an AFL Rising Star. He was recognized by Baseball America for having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" of any Yankees minor leaguer in 2021.
- Wells was originally selected by the Yankees in the 35th round of the 2018 MLB Draft. After electing to play college ball at Arizona...Then selected by the Yankees in the 1st round of the 2020 MLB Draft, making him the fourth Yankees catcher chosen first round of the MLB First-Year Player Draft since its inception in 1965, joining Anthony Seigler (2018), David Parrish (2000) and Thurman Munson (1968).
