TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque needs a win today to salvage a series split after Oklahoma City claimed a 2-1 triumph Saturday Evan Justice is expected to take the hill for the Isotopes while Clavton Kershaw is slated to start for the Comets.

TOVAR TIME: In his first rehab game with the Isotopes yesterday, Ezequiel Tovar went 0-for-4 at the plate and played seven innings at shortstop

MR. FREEMAN: Tyler Freeman, also playing in his first rehab game with Albuquerque Saturday, went 1-for-3 with a double and walk while playing seven innings at second base. He was pinchrun for in the top of the eighth inning after his two-bagger.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk compiled one hit in three at-bats during his first rehab contest with the Isotopes yesterday. He played seven innings at third base.

ON THE ROAD: The Isotopes need a win today to avoid losing their first four road series of 2025.

ONE-RUN GAMES: Albuquerque is 5-8 in one run games and 2-6 on the road. It's the first time the Isotopes have played in four-straight one-run games since September 24, 2023-March 31, 2024, the final game of the 2023 season and first three contests to open the 2024 slate (one vs. OKC and three vs. ELP, 2-2).

7.0: Oklahoma City's Justin Wrobleski tossed 7.0 innings of onerun ball Saturday while fanning five. It's the longest outing by an opposing starter since Reno's Humberto Castellanos also spun 7.0 innings of one-run ball August 28, 2024, at Reno.

QS: It was the fifth quality start against the Isotopes this year and the seventh time an opposing starter has completed at least 6.0 frames, all since April 22 (17 games).

ONE RUN SCORED: The Isotopes were held to one run or fewer for the sixth time this season Saturday (last: April 26 at Reno). Five of the six occurrences have come on the road (lone occurrence at Isotopes Park: April 1 vs. Salt Lake).

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Sam Hilliard has 231 RBI with Albuquerque, second all-time in Isotopes history ... Jason Wood (2003-06, 08) holds the record with 328 RBI.

BEHIND THE DISH: Albuquerque catchers (Braxton Fulford, Austin Nola and Ronaiker Palma) have combined to slash .377/.431/.608 with 49 hits, 12 doubles, six homers and 23 RBI on the year, leading the PCL in hits, doubles, average, OBP and

JC: Julio Carreras singled Friday to extend his hit streak to 13 games, tied for the longest active hit streak in the PCL and tied for longest active streak in Triple-A. Is slashing .447/.491/.553 with three doubles, one triple and six RBI during stretch ... His longest since a 15-gamer with High-A Spokane (June 28-July 15, 2022).

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard singled yesterday and has reached base in 27 of 28 games played on the year ... Has doubles in back-to-back games for the second time this year (also: May 3-6) ... Five of his nine doubles have come in his last nine contests.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson has recorded back-to-back games with multiple hits for the first time since August 9-11, 2024, with Double-A Hartford where he registered four-straight such games (doubleheader on August 10). It was his fifth game of the season with a multi-hit performance.

BRAX: Braxton Fulford has an RBI in three-straight contests for the second time this year (also: April 4-8) ... 11 of Fulford's 21 hits with Albuquerque this season have gone for extra bases ... Has a hit in 13 of his last 14 contests, including four-straight.

KESTDADDY: Keston Hiura's six-game hit streak came to an end yesterday, a season-high. Slashed .375/.400/.708 with one triple, two homers and four RBI.

VEEN: Since being sent back down to Albuquerque April 24 (11 games), Zac Veen is 13-for-46 with four doubles, one triple, one homer and five RBI.

COOLIN' OFF?: From April 10-30 (15 games), Warming Bernabel slashed .362/.403/.621 with nine doubles, two homers and 17 RBI ... Over his last eight games, is just 3-for-27

PCL LEADERBOARD: Warming Bernabel is T-8th in doubles (10) ... Ryan Ritter is 4th in walks (26) and 8th in runs (24) ... Yanquiel Fernandez is T-7th in homers (7) ... Sam Hilliard is 1st in triples (4), T-5th in XBH (17), 8th in slugging (.541) and 10th in OPS (.898).

RISP: The club went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position Saturday, the eighth time this year failing to record a hit with a runner in scoring position (last: April 27 at Reno).

TWO OR FEWER: Albuquerque limited their opponent to two runs or fewer for the eighth time in 2025 yesterday, second time this series (also: May 6) and third time in May.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
