LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped a back-and-forth affair with the Harrisburg Senators by a 6-5 final on Thursday night. Bowie struck first via a two-out, two-run double by Tim Susnara to take a 2-0 lead. Harrisburg inched back to tie the game, with a run in the third on an RBI groundout from JT Arruda and a run in the fourth on an RBI groundout from Brady Lindsly, against Bowie's right-handed starter Houston Roth, who went four innings on the night. The Baysox took the lead back in the bottom half of the inning after John Rhodes led off the frame with a walk, reaching third on a Donta' Williams double, and coming home on a Billy Cook sacrifice fly RBI to restore Bowie's lead to 3-2. Right-hander Carlos Tavera entered in the fifth for the Baysox. Despite matching a career high with 10 strikeouts through his four innings, Tavera allowed a career-high three home runs - a two-run shot by Frankie Tostado and a solo homer by Jose Sanchez in the sixth, before James Wood hit a solo shot in the seventh, giving Harrisburg a 6-3 edge. Bowie would get two runs back in the bottom of the seventh on RBI singles from Coby Mayo and Cesar Prieto, but ultimately left the tying runs in scoring position in both the seventh and eighth frames. The Baysox were unable to charge all the way back in what ended as their second-straight defeat.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Senators enter tonight with a record of 24-23 - good for third place in the Southwest division and two-and-a-half games out of first. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg split a six-game series in Reading last week, losing each of the last three contests. The Senators won five of six in Harrisburg against the Baysox back in the second week of May. Harrisburg has the fewest home runs (34) and road home runs (17) hit in the Eastern League, and the second fewest in Double-A, while the Bowie staff has allowed the second-most home runs at home (38) in the league. The Senators' roster is highlighted by the Nationals' top two prospects, according to MLB Pipeline - James Wood (No. 1 WSH/No. 7 overall) and Robert Hassell III (No. 2 WSH/No. 44 overall) patrolling the outfield. RHPs Jackson Rutledge (No. 11 WSH) and Gerrardo Carrillo (No. 27 WSH) alongside LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 23 WSH) feature on the Harrisburg pitching staff.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Mitchell Parker is tonight's projected starter for Harrisburg. Parker is the No. 23 prospect in the Nationals' system, per MLB Pipeline, and is coming off five efficient innings against Reading last Saturday, where he allowed just two earned runs and struck out four. Parker has struggled to consistently pitch into the middle innings this season, with just 37 innings across nine starts - partially due to the 35 hits and 27 walks he's surrendered. Parker did have one of his best starts of the season against Bowie on 5/10, when he went a season-high six frames, allowing a single run on three hits, walking three and striking out six. A fifth-round pick of the Nationals in 2020 out of San Jacinto Junior College - the same school as last night's starter for Harrisburg, Jackson Rutledge. Parker features a low-90s fastball, low-80s curveball, along with a changeup and splitter.

ONE CLUTCH CONDIMENT

Coby Mayo has been an RBI machine for the Baysox on their recent hot stretch. Mayo has a team-high 24 RBI on the season, including 11 in his last 10 games. In that span, Mayo has three-multi RBI games, and has produced four game-winning runs for the Baysox. Mayo has also provided serious pop as of late, with an extra-base hit (six doubles, three home runs) in nine of his last 11 games. Mayo is tied for the Double-A lead with 16 doubles and his 24 extra-base hits are tied for second-most at the level. He also has an active 17-game on-base streak - third longest by a member of the Baysox this season.

SLIPPING UP

After committing three errors for the sixth time this season in last night's contest, the Baysox are the first team to 50 errors at the Double-A level. Last year, Bowie had a lauded infield defense, and committed only 100 errors in a full 138-game season, and an average number in the Eastern League. At this point in the season. Bowie is on pace for 150 total errors in 2023.

STRUGGLES WITH THE SENS

The Baysox have outhit the Senators in eight of the nine contests between the teams this season, and by a 74-58 total. However, Bowie is just 2-7 against Harrisburg in 2023. Part of that is due to the Baysox struggle to string together hits. Bowie is hitting .227 this season with runners in scoring position, but just .179 in such situations against Harrisburg. In total this season, the Baysox are 14-13 in games where they outhit their opponent.

DONTA' DAZZLES

OF Donta' Williams has hits in four straight, and six of his past seven games for the first time in his Double-A career. After a 4-for-51 stretch (.078) in the beginning of May, Williams is 9 for his last 19 (.474) with a pair of home runs and four doubles. Williams has also shown improved plate discipline, with six walks in his last seven games, helping his on-base percentage jump 61 points during the stretch. Williams reached base four times last night for the first time in Double-A, and the sixth time overall, in his career.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron. Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Fitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Herrmann also worked with current Orioles left-hander John Means at 73 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll
