LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped Saturday's slugfest at Jersey Shore, 10-8...The Blue-Claws took the lead for good in a 5-run the bottom of the 6th...3B Carson DeMartini delivered the game-tying 2-run triple before RF Eduardo López powered a go-ahead 2-run home run to right-center...The Cyclones brought the tying run to the plate in the 9th after a 2-run single by C Chris Suero...3B Boston Baro lined out to left to end the 9ame..1B Estarling Mercado popped a 3-run home run for Brooklyn in the 4th...Suero and Baro each tallied 2 hits...SS Jesús Báez reached base 3 times with 2 singles and a walk...PH-1B Ronald Hernandez came off the bench and tallied a pair of knocks and RBI... RHP Frankie Montas took a no-decision in his first Major League rehab start...He allowed 2 runs on 2 hits, walking 2 and striking out 1, in 1.1 innings.

DOUBLE THE FUN: The Cyclones and BlueClaws will play their 2nd doubleheader in 3 days on Sunday afternoon...On Friday, Brooklyn swept a twinbill from Jersey Shore, capturing the opener, 10-1, and the nightcap, 9-3...The 'Clones outscored Jersey Shore, 19-4, and outhit them, 23-9, in the double-dip...Brooklyn split its first doubleheader in 2025, losing Game 1 vs. Hudson Valley on April 12, 2-0, and winning Game 2, 2-1...Brooklyn is now 1-0-1 in doubleheaders in 2025, holding a 3-1 overall mark...In 2024, the Cyclones were 2-1-3 in doubleheaders, having a 7-5 record overall...Friday marked Brooklyn's first doubleheader sweep since August 11, 2024, vs. Hudson Valley...The Cyclones won the opener, 4-2, and the finale, 3-1.

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly returned to form...The 20-year-old has reached base safely in 14-of-18 plate appearances in the series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in Friday's doubleheadre with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI...Báez has reached safely in 16-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .375/.493/.589/1.082 with 12 runs scored, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 15 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and 12 walks to 7 strikeouts... Báez also enters Sunday with an 8-game hitting streak since May 15 vs. Winston-Salem, going 13-for-25 (.520) at the plate with 8 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 9 RBI and 7 walks...On Tuesday, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF Ryan Clifford on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore...During May, Báez is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in on-base percentage (.474), tied for 2nd in RBI (18), 37d in OPS (1.058), 4th in batting average (.359), tied for 5th in hits (23), and 6th in slugging percentage (.594).

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025... The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn continued to wreak havoc on the bases in a May 17 win over Winston-Salem, during which the Cyclones stole 6 bases courtesy of 3 players...Brooklyn enters play on Sunday with 96 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (115)...The 96 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 43 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 26 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 70 steals through 43 games...The Cyclones' single-season franchise record is 181 steals set in 2024.

HOW SWEEP IT IS: With last Sunday's 7-6 walk-off victory vs. Winston-Salem in 10 innings, the Cyclones completed their first 6-game sweep since 2022 and their first at home since 2021...Brooklyn had not completed a 6-game sweep since taking all 6 contests at Jersey Shore from August 23-28, 2022...The Cyclones outscored the BlueClaws, 53-18, in that series...It was Brooklyn's first 6-game sweep on Coney Island since July 20-25, 2021, vs. Wilmington...The 'Clones outscored the 'Rocks, 41-22, in that set...Brooklyn's 6-game winning streak was snapped Tuesday at Jersey Shore...It was the first time the team had won 6-straight games since September 3-9, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem...The Cyclones clinched the Second Half South Atlantic League North Division crown during that win streak...Additionally, the Cyclones' 29-14 record through 43 games is the franchise's 2nd best record through 43 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...Brooklyn opened the 2010 season with a 30-13 mark through 43 contests.

CAN EW BELIEVE IT?: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season and was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week on Monday...In 5 games vs. Winston-Salem, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He is the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Mick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024...Entering play on Sunday, the Springboro, Ohio native is 2nd in Minor League Baseball in batting average (.374), 3rd in stolen bases (31), tied for 3rd in triples (6), 8th in on-base percentage (.466), and tied for 9th in OPS (1.017)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (17)...He is also 2nd in hits (29), 4th in batting average (.354), tied for 4th in triples (21), 6th in runs scored (18), 8th in on-base percentage (.430), and 10th in total bases (41)...The 2023 4th-round pick enters Sunday riding a 27-game on-base streak since April 18....During the on-base streak, Ewing has hit .358/.456/.509/.965 with 23 runs scored, 5 doubles, 4 triples, a home run, 14 RBI, 19 walks, and 24 stolen bases.

REIM TIME: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...The former 4th-round pick recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer launched his 7th home run of the season in May 15's win vs. Winston-Salem...Entering play on Saturday, Reimer is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in extra-base hits (26), tied for 5th in doubles (16), 8th in slugging percentage (.609) and OPS (1.020), and tied for 8th in total bases (92)...The former 4th-round pick leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (37), slugging percentage (.609), OPS (1.020), extra-base hits (26), and doubles (16), and is tied for 1st in hits (49)... Reimer is also 2nd in batting average (.325) and total bases (92), 3rd in RBI (32), tied for 4th in triples (3), 7th in on-base percentage (.411), and tied for 7th in home runs (7).

ALL ABOUT THE BENGE-AMINS: OF Carson Benge has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The 2024 first-round pick enters Sunday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also tied for 2nd in runs scored (33) and doubles (11), 3rd in OPS (.971), 4th in extra-base hits (19) and slugging percentage (.536), 5th in on-base percentage (.435) and total bases (74), tied for 5th in walks (29), and 6th in batting average (.312) and hits (43)...The 22-year-old is riding had an 11-game hitting streak since May 8 at Asheville snapped on Friday, but has reached base safely in 17-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .339/.494/.695/1.189 with 17 runs scored, 6 doubles, 3 triples, 3 home runs, 17 RBI, 17 walks to 13 strikeouts, and 6 stolen bases.

vs. JERSEY SHORE: After sweeping a 6-game homestand vs. Winston-Salem, Brooklyn hits the road for a 7-game series with the BlueClaws...Jersey Shore enters the series after dropping 4-of-6 at Wilmington...The BlueClaws are 8-10 at home this season and dropped 3-of-5 to Brooklyn in Lakewood from April 22-27...Jersey Shore boasts 8 of the Phillies' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF Devin Saltiban (9), INF Bryan Rincon (14), INF Carson DeMartini (15), OF John Spikerman (16), LHP Mavis Graves (17), RHP Alex McFarlane (18), RHP Micah Ottenbreit (28), and OF Dylan Campbell (30)...Saltiban and Spikerman are currently on the injured list...In 120 meetings since 2022, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 62-58 (.517)... Brooklyn is 34-32 (.515) in 66 games at ShoreTown Ballpark.

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones need to win one of Sunday's two matchups to remain perfect in series through the first 45 games of the 2025 season...Through Brooklyn's first 7 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 5-0-2 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 3-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 7-0-2 in a series of any length.

SUPER SUERO: C Chris Suero has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On April 15, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory... Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Sunday, Suero is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in hit-by-pitches (12)...He is also tied for 7th in home runs (7), tied for 9th in stolen bases (15), and 10th in on-base percentage (.392) and slugging percentage (.466)

MARCO POLO: IF Marco Vargas has not stopped hitting since joining the Cyclones at the end of April...The 19-year-old has reached safely in all 19 games played with Brooklyn, and in all 32 contests he has appeared in this year between the Cyclones and Single-A St. Lucie...During the 32-game on-base streak, Vargas is hitting. 296/,407/.374/.781 with 25 runs scored, 4 doubles, a triple, a home run, 17 RBI, 22 walks, and 10 stolen bases.

HOMER HAPPY: Brooklyn's offense erupted in the 2nd inning on May 9 at Asheville...RF Eil Serrano III, DH A.J. Ewing, and CF Carson Benge clubbed back-to-back-to-back home runs with 1 out in the frame off Asheville's RHP Yeriel Santos...lt marked just the 2nd time Brooklyn had hit 3-straight home runs in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...2B Luke Ritter, 1B Joe Genord, and C José Mena first accomplished the feat with back-to-back-to-back shots in the 6th inning on June 20, 2021, at Wilmington...SS Jesús Báez added a 4th home run in the frame, marking the first time in MiLB's Digital Era that the Cyclones powered 4 long balls in a single inning...The feat has been accomplished just 2 other times in MiLB this season...Miami's Double-A Pensacola accomplished the feat with 4 homers in the 3rd inning on April 16 vs. St. Paul...Brooklyn enters Sunday ranked 3rd in the South Atlantic League in home runs (40)...Since 2005, only the 2021 team (45) has hit home runs through the team's first 43 games.

HALL PASS: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP Noah Hall has returned to form in 2025... Entering Sunday, Hall is tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League in innings pitched (44.0), 7th in ERA (2.86), tied for 8th in double plays induced (3), and 10th in batting average against (.210)...Hall's 40.6% infield fly ball rate leads the circuit, and his 53.0% groundball rate is 3rd...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

SIR SERRANO: OF Eli Serrano III put together his best game as a professional in April 24's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano was the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3+ runs, 3+ extra-base hits, a home run, and 3+ RBI in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...28 Luke Ritter also accomplished the feat with 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019...Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...LF Alex Ramfrex was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley...Entering Sunday, Serrano is tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (10), tied for 7th in RBI (27), and tied for 8th in extra-base hits (16).

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On this date in 2021, New York Mets' No. 1 prospect C Francisco Alvarez made his Cyclones' debut, going 1-for-4, in an 8-1 loss vs. Aberdeen... Alvarez's debut marked the 1st time in franchise history that Brooklyn was home to the current top prospect in the Mets' farm system...In 2024, LHP Felipe De La Cruz came 1 strikeout shy of matching the Cyclones' single-game franchise record, whiffing 13 over 6.0 innings in a 7-3 win vs. Hudson Valley...CF Stanley Consuegra clubbed a leadoff home run and RF Karell Paz added a 3-run shot in the victory.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 11 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Nate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), and OF A.J. Ewing (27)...O' those 11, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), Dohm (23), Ewing (24), and RHP Raimon Gómez (26)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his first appearance and start with the Cyclones in 2,077 days last Sunday vs. Winston-Salem on SNY...Yielded 2 unearned runs without allowing a hit over 0.2 frames...Walked 2 and struck out 1...Charged with a wild pitch...Threw 33 pitches and 17 strikes (51.52%)...Relieved by RHP Alfred Vega with runners at 1st and 2nd and 2 out in the top of the 1st and Brooklyn behind 2-0...Both bequeathed runners did not score...The Cyclones would rally from down 2-0 and 5-4 to force extra innings...Brooklyn walked it off in the bottom of the 10th on a game-winning fielder's choice from DH Ronald Hernandez.

2025: Broke camp with Single-A St. Lucie...Tossed 2.2 innings and struck out a season-high 5 in his first start and appearance in an official contest in 2,035 days on 4/6 vs. JUP (2.2 IP, 2 H, BB, 5 K)...Hurled a season-long 3.2 innings of shutout ball in a no-decision on 4/12 @LAK (3.2 IP, 2 H, 3 K)...Posted a pair of shutout innings in a start on 4/30 @PMB (2.0 IP, 2 H, BB, 3 K)...Twirled 2.0 shutout innings in a no-decision on 5/6 vs. CLR (2.0 IP, H, 2 BB, 2 K)...Transferred to Brooklyn on 5/12...Took a no-decision in his first start with the Cyclones in 2,077 days on 5/18 vWS (0.2 IP, 2 R, 2 BB, K).

LONG TIME COMING: Prior to the 2025 season, Allan last pitched in an official contest on September 10, 2019, for the Brooklyn Cyclones in the decisive Game 3 of the New York-Penn League Championship Series against the Lowell Spinners...Posted 3.0 shutout and no-hit innings, striking out 2...Cyclones would win the game, and the title, with a 4-3 win...Contest was the final game in NYPL history...Allan was scheduled to break camp with the Cyclones in their inaugural High-A season in 2021, but instead underwent Tommy John surgery in May...Missed the entire 2022 season due to ulnar transposition surgery in January...Did not pitch in 2023 after undergoing UCL revision surgery in January...Missed all of 2024, too, recovering from the injury...Allan officially returned to the mound after 2,035 days on 4/6/25 vs. Jupiter...Last Sunday was his first start on Coney Island and with the Cyclones in 2,077 days.

PROSPECT RADAR: Allan entered the 2023 season ranked as the New York Mets' No. 15 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 23 by MLB Pipeline...BA deemed him New York's No. 5 farmhand in 2022, No. 3 in 2021, and No. 4 in 2020...MLB Pipeline listed Allan as the Mets' No. 5 prospect in 2022, No. 3 in 2021, and No. 4 in 2020...Alan was also deemed the No. 75 prospect in all of baseball entering 2021 by MLB Pipeline, No. 79 by Baseball Prospectus, and No. 98 by *Baseball America*.
