Augusta GreenJackets (26-23) at Charleston RiverDogs (19-30)

RHP Didier Fuentes (0-3, 6.95) vs. RHP Yoniel Curet (2-1, 5.08)

Today's Game: The Charleston RiverDogs (affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays) welcome the Augusta GreenJackets (affiliate of the Atlanta Braves) to the Holy City for the first time this season. Tonight's game is the fifth of six between the teams this week. The RiverDogs have dropped eight of their last 10 games. **RiverDogs-GreenJackets Season Series in 2023: Overall:** GreenJackets 6, RiverDogs 4. **At The Joe:** GreenJackets 3, RiverDogs 1.

Last Time Out: The RiverDogs rode the bats of two of their top prospects to a 6-4 win on Friday night, their first of the series. The game got off to an inauspicious start as Augusta's first four hitters all reached base safely to take a 3-0 lead. Ethan Workinger and Justin Janas collected back-to-back singles to start the inning and Bryson Worrell put Augusta on the board with an RBI double. E.J. Exposito added a two-run single in the next at-bat to make the lead 3-0. The RiverDogs reached the scoreboard in the bottom of the second, as Oneill Manzueta began the frame with a triple off the center field wall. Jhon Diaz followed immediately with a sacrifice fly. Workinger extended the lead back to three with a solo home run in the top of the third. The first two batters in the RiverDogs half of the frame reached base against Owen Murphy, allowing Xavier Isaac to tie the game with a towering fly ball to right field that cleared the right field wall for a three-run home run. Carlos Colmenarez gave the RiverDogs the lead with an RBI double in the fourth and added the final run of the day with a solo home run in the seventh.

Marcus' Master Class: Starting pitcher Marcus Johnson went 7.0 strong innings on Thursday night, allowing just a pair of solo home runs while striking out five. He needed only 81 pitches to reach that point in the game, throwing 64 of them for strikes. Johnson is the first pitcher to work 7.0 innings since the RiverDogs became a Rays affiliate in 2021. The last pitcher to throw that many innings in a game was Jhony Brito in 2019.

Illegal Activities: Prior to the start of the 2023 season, Major League Baseball announced intentions to properly enforce the balk rule. That focus has been evident through the first two months of the campaign. RiverDogs pitchers have been called for 18 balks this season through the first 49 games. The last time the RiverDogs were called for that many balks in an entire season was 1998 when they committed 19 balks. The franchise record for balks in a single season is 39, set by the 1991 Charleston Rainbows. 213 balks have been called in the Carolina League this season. In 2022, there were 191 called throughout the full season.

Down But Not Out: The RiverDogs have dropped eight of the last 10 games but continue to have opportunities to win each night. During the 10-game stretch, the RiverDogs pitching staff has limited their opponent to just 31 runs (just over three per game) but managed to score only 25 of their own. The seven losses have come by a total of 11 runs with six of the last seven losses featuring a one-run margin.

Stealing Their Hearts: Outfielder Chandler Simpson is one of the fastest players in baseball. He has put that speed on display early in the 2023 season. Simpson is reaching base at a .346 clip and stealing a base nearly every time he reaches. His 31 stolen bases are second in the Carolina League and fifth in MiLB, six behind Dairon Blanco of Omaha. The outfielder has also played the most games of any player in the Carolina League without committing an error.

Bowling Green Bound: On Saturday, the RiverDogs sent third baseman Kamren James and pitcher Cade Halemnu to High-A Bowling Green. In total, the team has sent five players to the Hot Rods this season. James and Halemnu join Gionti Turner, Jalen Battles, Nate Dahle, Sean Harney and Duncan Davitt with the Rays High-A affiliate.

Double the Fun: The RiverDogs ended a nearly 100-year title drought in the city of Charleston by claiming the Low-A East championship in 2021. The 2022 team followed by winning the Carolina League title with an undefeated run through the postseason. The last MiLB franchise to three-peat was the Midland Rockhounds from 2014-17, when the Oakland affiliate won four straight Texas League titles. The Salem Pirates were the most recent Carolina League team to accomplish the feat, doing so from 1972-74.

Prized Pups: The RiverDogs roster contains seven members of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Rays prospects. The highest ranked of that group is 19-year-old first baseman Xavier Isaac, who begins the season at #10. Another 19-year-old shortstop Carlos Colmenarez is next on the list at #14. Outfielders Chandler Simpson (#18) and Ryan Cermak (#23) figure to bring speed and power to the lineup. Rounding out a highly regarded group of infielders is #24 prospect Cooper Kinney, the 34th overall pick in the Rays 2021 draft. Catcher Dominic Keegan, a star at Vanderbilt, slots in at #25 and the list is rounded out by RHP Marcus Johnson at #29.

RIVERDOGS FIELD STAFF

Manager: Sean Smedley

Smedley's coaching career began when he was the video coordinator for the rookie-level Princeton Rays in 2016. In 2017, he returned to Princeton, this time as the bench coach. For the next two seasons, Smedley was part of Blake Butera's staff as the bench coach for the Hudson Valley Renegades. The native of Colorado was announced as the manager in Princeton for the 2020 season, but COVID-19 canceled the season and when play resumed he joined Butera in Charleston. During his playing days as a catcher, Smedley was a prep standout at Desert Vista High School in Phoenix, Arizona. He played one year of junior college ball at Yavapai College before transferring to Division II Texas A&M International. He went undrafted at the end of his college career but was signed as a free agent by the Rays shortly after the draft's conclusion. In three professional seasons, he appeared in 24 games total between the Gulf Coast League Rays and Single-A Bowling Green. Smedley was named the RiverDogs manager for the 2023 season.

Pitching Coach: Levi Romero

Romero takes over as the pitching coach at a full-season affiliate for the first time after serving in the same role for the Florida Complex League affiliate in 2021. That squad held opponents to a league-low .204 batting average and finished with a 3.32 earned run average and 514 strikeouts in 460.2 innings. Romero was the pitching coach for one of the Rays two entries in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. His professional career began in 2003 when he was signed out of Venezuela by the Houston Astros. In all, he pitched for five years in Minor League Baseball with the Astros and Texas Rangers before embarking on a seven-year international career that included stops in Venezuela and Japan and ended in 2015.

Hitting Coach: Perry Roth

This season will be Roth's second with both the Rays and RiverDogs after coaching at the college level since 1996. Under his tutelage in 2022, the RiverDogs led the Carolina League in batting average, home runs, hits, triples and slugging percentage. Before joining the Rays, he spent the previous 15 years with UAB's baseball program, also serving as recruiting coordinator, hitting coach and assistant head coach.

Coach: Ronnie Richardson

Richardson is embarking on his third season with the Rays, and first with a full-season affiliate, following two years in the Florida Complex League. He helped guide the FCL Rays to a 39-16 record in the regular season and an appearance in the league's championship series. Richardson previously coached in the Miami Marlins organization, with Hillsborough Community College and in the Northwoods League with the Madison Mallards and Wisconsin Woodchucks. He was selected out of Central Florida University in the 16th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the San Diego Padres. He played three seasons in their farm system, posting a .262 career batting average.

Athletic Trainer: Halee Williams

Williams begins her fourth year with the Rays and first with a full-season affiliate. She served in the same role with the Florida Complex League Rays in 2022.
