**FOR STARTERS:** The Rocket City Trash Pandas continue their penultimate homestand of the 2025 season on Wednesday night, game two of a six-game series with the Atlanta Braves' affiliate, Columbus Clingstones. It's the third and final matchup between the clubs this year. Rocket City took 2 of 3 at Toyota Field in mid-July but dropped 5 of 6 on the road in Columbus earlier this month. The Trash Panda's are coming off of a 2-4 trip to Birmingham.

FARRIS FANS 13 AS TRASH PANDAS BLANK CLINGSTONES 2-0: The Trash Pandas opened their series with a 2-0 shutout win over Columbus behind a dominant performance from Mitch Farris, who set a career high with 13 strikeouts across 6.2 scoreless innings. Korey Holland powered the offense with a solo homer and a three-hit night, while **Ryan Nicholson** added an RBI single. The bullpen duo of **Kenyon** Yovan and Camden Minacci closed the door to complete the eight-hit shutout.

ROCKET CITY PITCHING ON POINT: Over their last seven games, the Trash Pandas' pitching staff holds a 2.34 ERA, which includes 56 strikeouts over 57.2 innings. That ERA ranks them 2nd in the Southern League and 3rd in all of Double-A baseball.

FARRIS KEEPS PUTTING UP BIG STRIKEOUT NUMBERS: LHP Mitch Farris leads the Southern League, and ranks 2nd in Double-A with 142 strikeouts over 23 outings in 2025. Farris is currently 2nd in team history in single-season strikeouts, trailing only franchise record-holder Caden Dana, who struck out 147 batters in 2024. His 13-strikeout game on August 26 vs. Columbus was the third-most in team history behind **Reid Detmer's** 16 on June 26, 2021 at Chattanooga, and **Brett Kerry's** 14 on August 29 vs. Tennessee. Farris ranks among the league leaders in starts (T-5th, 22), innings pitched (2nd, 116.0), and strikeouts (1st 142)

KOREY IS KRUSHING: OF Korey Holland is currently on a 5-game hitting streak, and has reached base safely in 12 of his last 13 games. He's batting .421 over the five-game stretch with a home run, and 1.082

GOBBEL'ING UP HITS IN AUGUST: INF Ben Gobbel has been one of the Southern League's most consistent bats in August, ranking 6th with 23 hits while batting .277 across 22 games. He's also T-3rd with six dou-bles, adding two homers, seven RBIs, six walks, 12 runs, and a .778 OPS. Gobbel has reached base safely in 19 of 22 games this month

NATERA EARNS PROMOTION TO TRIPLE-A: Trash Pandas reliever Samy Natera Jr. was promoted to Triple-A Salt Lake on Tuesday after emerging as one of the hottest arms in Double-A. The left-hander has allowed just one run over his last nine outings, going 1-0 with a 0.93 ERA, 17 strikeouts, and only two walks in 9.2 innings while holding opponents to a .176 average and a 0.83 WHIP. Overall, Natera has been a workhorse for Rocket City, tied for the Southern League lead with 41 appearances and tied for eighth with eight saves. He leaves the Pandas with a 4-1 record, 2.64 ERA, and 68 strikeouts across 47.2 innings, limiting opponents to a .183 average.

WALKIN' IN AUGUST: OF David Mershon leads the Southern League in August with 19 walks. He's turned that into nine stolen bases, which ranks 3rd in the league.

OSCAR PUTTING THE 'COLOSSAL' IN COLÁS: OF Oscar Colás' has reached base in 14 of his last 16 games, belting five home runs during the stretch — highlighted by a two-homer performance on August 14 and a grand slam on August 8 in Columbus, the Trash Pandas' second of the season and 11th in franchise history. Since May 30, Colás leads the Southern League with 13 homers in that span. Overall, he sits 6th in the league with 14 long balls this year between Birmingham (1) and Rocket City (13)

BLASTING OFF IN THE ROCKET CITY: Since July 1, the Trash Pandas lead the Southern League, and rank 9th in Double-A with 36 home runs in 45 games. **Oscar Colás** (11), and **Ben Gobbel** (6) have combined for 16 of those homers. The Pandas matched a club record with five long balls on July 3 vs. Knoxville and had four on August 14 vs. Knoxville. Overall, Rocket City ranks 3rd in the league with 85 long balls.

SAM'S ROLLING THROUGH STARTS LIKE FRESH PASTA DOUGH: LHP Sam Aldegheri has five quality starts in his last eight outings since July 2. The Verona, Italy native is T-1st with five wins (5-2) over that stretch with a 2.31 ERA (12 ER/46.2 IP), 19 walks, and 37 strikeouts. His 2.31 ERA ranks 4th in the Southern League. Aldegheri ranks among the league leaders in starts (T-6th, 21), innings pitched (2nd, 113.1), strikeouts (11th, 98), and ERA (9th, 4.05).

FEELING CALABREEZY IN THE ROCKET CITY: OF David Calabrese is back for his fourth stint in Rocket City since 2023, and is now 4th on the all-time list in games played for the Trash Pandas with 220. He sits behind **Orlando Martinez** (296), **Tucker Flint** (244), and **Bryce Teodosio** (230). In 10 games since returning from High-A Tri-City, Calabrese is batting .278.

MURPHY MAKES HIS MARK: RHP Luke Murphy, back for his second stint in Rocket City in 2025, and holds the franchise-record with 115 appearances from 2022-2025. The Vanderbilt product also ranks 3rd in team history with 10 wins, is tied for first with 21 holds, and sits 3rd in team history with 164 strikeouts.

TRASH PANDAS BASEBALL HITTING THE WEST COAST: This Thursday's game (Aug. 28 vs. Columbus) will be televised live on FanDuel Sports Network West, the first of two remaining Trash Pandas broadcasts this season. The final telecast will air Sept. 10 against Chattanooga. Produced in-house and featuring veteran voices Josh Caray and Chris Harris, the broadcasts give fans in the Angels' local TV market an exclusive look at Toyota Field through the FanDuel app and network.

THE ELEPHANT IN THE ROOM: The Trash Pandas are 41-79, and their 79 losses are the most in Minor League Baseball this season. Corpus Christi (AA-HOU) follows with 78.

ADDITIONAL NOTES (CONT)

- DENZER GUZMAN NAMED SL PLAYER OF THE MONTH: On Wednesday, MiLB named Denzer Guzman the Southern League Player of the Month for July, becoming just the sixth player in Trash Pandas history to earn the honor—and the first since Gustavo Campero in July 2024. Guzman was one of the league's most consistent and productive hitters throughout the month. He ded the Southern League in OPS (1.020), slugging percentage (.580), extra-base hits (13), and total bases (47). He also finished second in batting average (.333), on-base percentage (.440), and doubles (9), while his 27 hits tied for fifth. Guzman was promoted to Triple-A Salt Lake on August 2.
- KLASSEN AND ALDEGHERI DEALT IN JULY: LHP Sam Aldegheri and RHP George Klassen were two of the Southern League's best starters in July. Aldegheri led the league with a 0.78 ERA. In four starts, the lefthander went 3-0, allowing just four earned runs over 23.0 innings while recording 19 strikeouts and 10 walks. Klassen finished T-1st in the league with 26 strikeouts over four starts, finishing with a 3.32 ERA, striking out 26 and walking seven across 21.2 innings.
- PITCHING STAFF PACKED A PUNCH IN JULY: The Rocket City pitching staff racked up 213 strikeouts over 24 games in July—an average of 8.9 strikeouts per game—ranking 3rd in the Southern League and 9th across all of Double-A.
- SAM BROWN TRADED TO NATS: On Wednesday, the Angels traded Trash Pandas first baseman Sam Brown to the Washington Nationals as part of a four-player deal. A 2023 12th-round pick out of Washington State, Brown hit. 244 with 12 doubles, five homers, and 40 RBI in 92 games for Rocket City this season. He was named Southern League Player of the Week in mid-July and ranked fourth in batting average in May. In return, the Angels received LHP Andrew Chafin and RHP Luis García, while LHP Jake Eder also goes to Washington. José Quijada was designated for assignment.
- ROCKET CITY LIVED UP TO ITS NAME IN JULY. In July, the Trash Pandas launched 19 home runs over 24 games, 3rd in the Southern League and ranking T-10th in all of Double-A baseball. That stretch included a five-homer outburst on July 3 against Knoxville at Toyota Field, tying a franchise record. The surge was fueled by Oscar Colás and Ben Gobbel, who combined for 10 of the 19 homers. Colás led the league in that span with six, while Gobbel was T-4th.
- SOUND THE BLANKENHORN: OF Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 32 of 41 games since returning from the Injured List on June 13. The veteran outfielder is tied for the league with eight home runs, and ranks 9th in the Southern League with an .752 OPS with six doubles, a triple, eight home runs, 20 RBIs, and 19 walks over that span.
- COLÁS BROUGHT THE BOOM IN JULY: Rocket City outfielder Oscar Colás finished July, 4th in all of Double-A with six home runs, plus he has three doubles, 15 RBIs, and 11 runs scored. On July 3 vs. Knoxville, Colás recorded his first career three-homer game, hitting solo home runs to lead off the third, fourth, and sixth innings. That marked only the second three-homer game in franchise history, the first being Orlando Martinez's performance on May 7, 2021, at Chattanooga.
- RADA REPORT: CF Nelson Rada, moved to Triple-A on August 2 after being the youngest player in the Southern League the past two seasons, He ranked 3rd in the league and 5th in all of Double-A with 34 stolen bases at the time of his promotion on August 2—19 of which came in a blistering month of May. His 34 steals ranked 3rd in Trash Pandas single-season history, trailing only his own mark of 35 from last year and Kyren Parris' franchise record of 44 set in 2023. Rada ranked among the league leaders at the time of his promotion in stolen bases (3rd, 34), OBP (5th, 380), batting average (12th, .277), and hits (T-9th, 91). Rada had a team-best 26 multi-hit games, including five three-hit games.
- GUZMAN BLAZED THROUGH JULY. The San Pedro de Macorís native, also moved to Triple-A on August 2, was named the Trash Pandas Player of the Month, and was one of the hottest hitters in Double-A last month, leading the Southern League—and was 5th in all of Double-A—with a 1.020 OPS, 47 total bases, and 13 extra-base hits. He ranked 2nd in the league with a .333 batting average and is also was tops in slugging (.580) and 2nd in on-base percentage (.440). His nine doubles rank 2nd in the league, and his 27 hits were T-5th. On July 13 in Chattanooga, he recorded the second five-hit game in Trash Pandas history, going 5-for-5 with three doubles, a home run, and four RBIs. He ranked among the league leaders at the time of his promotion in several categories, including doubles (2nd, 23), extra-base hits (T-1st, 35), RBIs (6th, 53), total bases (T-6th, 139), home runs (T-7th, 11), and slugging (7th, .415), and OPS (12th, .749). Buzman led the team with 16 multi-RBI games.
- GUZMAN AND BROWN GO BACK-TO-BACK FOR LEAGUE POW: INF Denzer Guzman was named Southern

  League Player of the Week for July 1-6 after leading the league with a 1.316 OPS and seven extra-base hits, along
  with six RBIs and six walks during a six-game series against Knoxville. One week later, INF Sam Brown earned the
  honor for July 8-13, posting a league-best .444 batting average (8-for-18) over five games in Rocket City's road series
  at Chattanooga. Brown added four extra-base hits, six RBIs, five walks, four runs scored, and a 1.398 OPS—also the
  highest in the league that week. Guzman and Brown became the 13th and 14th players in Trash Pandas history to win
  the award, and for the second consecutive season, Rocket City produced back-to-back weekly honorees, following
  Tucker Flint (Aug. 12-18) and Christian Moore (Aug. 5-11) in 2023.
- BACK FROM THE FUTURES GAME: RHP George Klassen made a brief but electric appearance for the American League squad at the Futures Game on July 19, throwing 11 pitches in the bottom of the third inning. He fired two 99 mph heaters—striking out Chicago's Owen Caissie. The No. 3 prospect for the Angels was the only representative for the Angels and became the sixth Rocket City player to earn a Futures Game selection, joining RHP Caden Dana (24), OF Kyren Paris (23), C Edgar Quero (23), RHP Ky Bush (22), and LHP Reid Detmers (21).
- KEEPIN' IT QUALITY: Starter Joel Hurtado, has not made a start since June 20, but still ranks third in the Southern League with seven quality starts, and ranks fifth in the Southern League with a 3.10 ERA.
- ANOTHER ONE LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: INF Jeremiah Jackson became the 44th Rocket City Trash Pandas alumnus to reach the Major Leagues, and eighth this season, when he made his MLB debut on August 1, with the Baltimore Orioles. Over his time in Madison, Jackson appeared in 169 games between 2022 and 2023, earning recognition for his power and versatility before being traded to the Mets and later landing with Baltimore. He joins former Pandas Chad Stevens (debuted o July 3), Robinson Piña (debuted on June 20), Christian Moore (debuted on June 13), Alan Rangel (June 6), José Fermin (April 26), Edgar Quero (April 16), and Michael Darrell-Hicks (April 11), who all debuted this year.
- THE STREAK IS OVER!!!: The Trash Pandas dropped a Southern League record 16 straight games from June 14 to July 2. The streak was the longest in Minor League Baseball this season. The streak surpassed the previous Southern League mark set by the Columbus (GA) Astros in 1971, dropping 15-straight games from May 17-June 1, 1971. That season, the Southern League and Texas League played an interlocking schedule and referred to the agreement as the "Divis Association".
- **DELAYING THE LAUNCH:** From June 12-29, the Trash Pandas endured 9 hours and 20 minutes of weather delays, and during the last homestand, June 10-25, they faced delays that totaled 6 hours and 20 minutes. This season, Rocket City has had 14 home games impacted by rain delays or postponements, adding up to 9 hours and 2 minutes of total delay time. According to wunderground.com, rain has been recorded on 22 out of 37 home game days.
