TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express go for a series victory over the El Paso Chihuahuas in Tuesday night's finale. Express LHP Wes Benjamin is set to get the start against Chihuahuas LHP Daniel Camarena. First pitch at Dell Diamond is slated for 7:05 p.m.

LET'S RECAP

The Round Rock Express fell in a 4-2 final to the El Paso Chihuahuas on Monday night. Round Rock scored the contest's first run in the first inning when 3B Eli White singled then scored from first on an RBI single from C John Hicks. El Paso took a 3-1 lead in the top of the second as RF Patrick Kivlehan hit a leadoff single before C Luis Campusano drew a walk and 2B Gosuke Katoh singled to load the bases. SS Pedro Florimón followed with a single, sending both Kivlehan and Campusano home. Katoh then scored on a Michael Cantu single. The Chihuahuas added another run in the fifth as CF John Andreoli crossed home plate on a sacrifice fly from 1B Nick Tanielu. Round Rock cut El Paso's lead to 4-2 with a run in the eighth as LF Delino DeShields was hit by a pitch then White and 1B Curtis Terry both drew walks, loading the bases. 2B Andy Ibáñez drew another walk to score DeShields. However, El Paso RHP James Norwood enticed Round Rock C Yohel Pozo into an inning-ending fielder's choice to eliminate the threat.

BENJAMIN IS BACK IN BUSINESS

Express LHP Wes Benjamin is scheduled to get the start on Tuesday night after being optioned from the Rangers on June 4. The righty recorded two additional appearances with Texas during his latest stint with the team. In two starts for Round Rock, Benjamin holds a 1-1 record and 6.14 ERA (5 ER/7.1 IP) while totaling 11 strikeouts.

CLOSE IT OUT

The Round Rock Express get their second crack at a series victory over the El Paso Chihuahuas on Tuesday night. The first five contests in the six-game set have been nail-biters, with every game decided by three runs or fewer. The Express have out-scored the Chihuahuas 28-25 in the razor-thin series thus far.

THIS GUY LOOKS FAMILIAR

The Express are set to face Chihuahuas LHP Daniel Camarena for the second time in the six-game series. The lefty started game one, allowing three runs on three hits while striking out five in 6.0 innings of a 6-3 El Paso victory. Tonight marks the first time that Round Rock has faced the same starting pitcher twice in the same series under the new six-game series scheduling format.

BGP DOES AAA

Round Rock Express C Blake Grant-Parks is set to make his Triple-A debut in Tuesday night's series finale. The backstop, who has primarily been serving as the E-Train's bullpen catcher, is set to bat eighth as the designated hitter. Grant-Parks was originally drafted by the Tampa Bay Rays in the 28th round of the 2011 June Draft. After three years of rookie ball in the Rays organization, the 27-year-old has spent the last four seasons catching in independent leagues.

FINISHING STRONG

The Express have posted a 3-1 record in series finales so far in 2021. In fact, Round Rock has been victorious in three of the four series that the team has played this season, including both sets against East Division foes in the Triple-A West League.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

The Texas Rangers recalled Round Rock Express OF Eli White as part of a series of transactions on Tuesday afternoon. In addition, LHP Wes Benjamin was added to Round Rock's active roster in advance of his start tonight against El Paso. Finally, RHP Tyson Miller has joined the E-Train roster after being claimed on waivers from the Chicago Cubs organization on June 4.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Twelve members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021, RHP Jason Bahr, OF Carl Chester, RHP Demarcus Evans, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, RHP Ryder Ryan, INF Anderson Tejada, INF Curtis Terry, OF Leody Taveras and RHP Collin Wiles. C Blake Grant-Parks is also seeking his Triple-A debut with the Express. Interestingly enough, Evans, Tejada and Taveras all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels in 2021 before making his Triple-A debut with Round Rock in May.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 13 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Nevada, New York, North Carolina, Texas, Utah and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 22 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, INF Andy Ibáñez was born in Cuba, INF Anderson Tejada and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
