FRIDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats lost both games of their doubleheader on Friday night to the Portland Sea Dogs, dropping game one 6-2 and game two 7-3 from Delta Dental Stadium. In the first game, Portland scored six runs but only one was earned. An error by Orelvis Martinez on a potential double-play grounder led to a three-run fourth inning against New Hampshire starting pitcher Jimmy Robbins. The Fisher Cats chipped away in the bottom of the fourth as Rainer Nunez smacked his second Double-A home run off the batter's eye and Steward Berroa collected an RBI double down the right field line to make it a 3-2 game. With Portland leading 4-2 in the seventh, a Nunez error on a dropped throw from third base led to a pair of Sea Dog insurance runs off right-handed reliever T.J. Brock, making the score 6-2 and putting the game out of reach. In the second game, PK Morris belted a go-ahead homer in the fifth to give the Fisher Cats a 2-1 lead but New Hampshire could not hold this lead in the seventh as a wild pitch brought home Phillip Sikes to force extra innings. After Portland went ahead in the eighth on a RBI base hit by Elih Marrero, Trevor Schwecke scored on a wild pitch with New Hampshire down to its final strike in the home half to tie it up 3-3 and send the game into the ninth. With Adrian Hernandez on the mound, the Sea Dogs scored four unearned runs on one hit and two errors to give Portland a 7-3 win and the doubleheader sweep.

TOUGH STRETCH: New Hampshire scored 90 runs (3.6 runs/gm) in the month of June, which was the fewest in the Eastern League. The offense has now scored four or less runs in 12 of their last 14 games and in 13 of their last 15. After hitting 38 home runs in the month of May, tied for the league lead, the Fisher Cats hit just 20 in the month of June, which was the second fewest in the circuit ahead of Akron.

HE ISN'T A VIRGO BUT A LEO: In 23 games this month of June, Leo Jimenez led the team with 12 extra base hits and 16 RBIs. The Blue Jays No. 19 prospect posted a .282 average to go along with nine doubles and three home runs. Before being activated off the injured list on May 23, the Blue Jays No. 19 prospect had just one extra base hit all season.

CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR: Portland has won 11 of 15 games so far in the season series as both teams face off for the third series this year but many of the games have come down to just one play or pitch, resulting in a close victory for either side. 11 of the 15 games have been decided by two runs or less with the Fisher Cats 3-8 in those games.

FUTURES GAME BOUND: On Monday, right-handed pitcher Sem Robberse was named to the American League roster for the 2023 All-Star Futures Game to be held in Seattle at T-Mobile Park on July 8. He and former Fisher Cat Yosver Zulueta will represent the Blue Jays for the seven-inning game. Robberse, the Blue Jays No. 7 prospect, ranked fifth in the Eastern League in innings pitched (67.1) and 11th in strikeouts (66) at the end of the first half. The 21-year-old Netherlands native is the 15th Fisher Cat to be selected for the Futures Game in team history.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (July 1, 2022) - In one of his final games with the Fisher Cats before being promoted, Spencer Horwitz went 5-for-6 with a homer, five RBI, and five runs scored in New Hampshire's 16-0 win at Hadlock. Luis De Los Santos drove in four runs and Trevor Schwecke went 4-for-5 with 3 RBI. The Fisher Cats outhit Portland 19-2 for the game.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (45-38) looks to bounce back after a 5-0 loss to the Red Sox on Friday night. James Paxton went 7.2 scoreless for Boston with seven strikeouts to earn the win. The Jays only had three singles in the game, one by Santiago Espinal...Luis De Los Santos hit a pinch-hit, walk-off grand slam as Buffalo (35-43) stunned Worcester in ten innings, 10-8. The Bisons scored two in the ninth to make it 5-5, only to have the Sox go ahead with three in the top of the tenth...Vancouver (43-29) won the Friday matinee with Spokane 4-3 in 11 innings. Cade Doughty delivered the walk-off with a single. Braden Scott earned the win in relief...Dunedin (35-37) lost at St. Lucie 4-3 on Friday night.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue the home stand this weekend against Portland – which will feature a Mega Blast Atlas Fireworks Weekend, including July 3.

LAST TIME OUT: Started the first-half finale at Somerset last Sunday. Allowed three runs (one earned) in four innings in a game New Hampshire went on to win 8-7. Retired eight in-a-row at the end of the outing.

v. PORTLAND: Makes his fourth career start vs. Sea Dogs (0-2, 3.68 ERA) and third this season. Was the losing pitcher at Hadlock Field on May 25 despite a quality start (6.0 IP, 3 ER).

2023: Opening Day starter for the Fisher Cats in Altoona. Struck out eight over 4.2 innings in New Hampshire's 8-2 win...also struck out eight Sea Dogs on 4/12. Allowed just one hit in six scoreless innings in win over Harrisburg on May 6.
