Akron took a 1-0 lead in the fourth with an RBI double by Aaron Bracho. It was the only run allowed by Richmond starter **John Michael Bertrand** over his six innings. In the top of the fifth, **Jimmy Glowenke** tied the game with an RBI double and **Alerick Soularie** moved the Flying Squirrels ahead with a double. **Turner Hill** singled in two runs in the seventh to open a 4-1 lead. Richmond scored five runs in the top of the ninth to extend the lead to 9-1. Soularie brought in a run with a sacrifice fly, **Carter Howell** hit a two-run double and **Jairo Pomares** brought in two runs with a ground-rule double. Glowenke and Pomares each finished the game with three hits.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, in the second of a three-game series. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond in the Flying Squirrels' first home series of the season from April 9-14. From April 30-May 5, Richmond dropped five-of-six in Akron, part of a 1-11 road trip. The RubberDucks return to Richmond for a six-game series at The Diamond from September 3-8.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS lost the final three games of last week's series against the Senators at The Diamond after winning their previous four games. They went 3-3 the previous week against the Baysox. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .225 and averaging 3.71 runs per game (167 runs/45 games) at home compared to a .237 batting average and 4.91 runs per game on the road (211 runs/43 games). The Flying Squirrels are 11-4 in their last 15 road games since June 12.

THE RUBBERDUCKS are in first place in the Southwest Division second-half standings. They opened the second half winning 13-of-15 games before dropping the final two games of last week's series at Reading and the first game of this series. They also lead the Eastern League with 50 wins this season. Akron's pitching staff leads the Eastern League in ERA (3.29), shutouts (11) and innings pitched (772.0). Akron's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including 18/OF C.J. Kayfus (No. 10), LHP Parker Messick (No. 17), OF Petey Halpin (No. 19), SS Gabriel Rodriguez (No. 20) and 3B Dayan Frias (No. 24). Halpin is also rated as the best defensive outfielder in the organization. MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes four Akron players, including Halpin (No. 15), Messick (No. 21), Kayfus (No. 27) and Frias (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Will Bednar makes his third Double-A start and his sixth appearance at Double-A. He last pitched on Sunday against Harrisburg and threw two scoreless innings, striking out two. It was his second straight two-inning, scoreless outing. Bednar began the season with Low-A San Jose and made five appearances, going 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA. In his six games for High-A Eugene, going 0-2 with a 3.18 ERA. Bednar was selected with the 14th overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of Mississippi State, where he helped lead the Bulldogs to a national title that year. He was named the College World Series Most Outstanding Pitcher after throwing six hitless innings in Mississippi State's Game 3 clincher that year against Vanderbilt. FOR AKRON: Left-hander Parker Messick makes his fifth Double-A start. In his last outing on July 11 at Reading, he tied a season high with six innings pitched and allowed two runs in a win. He was promoted to Akron on June 22 and combined for 9.2 scoreless innings in his first two Double-A starts before surrendering five runs over 2.2 innings in a loss at Erie on July 4. Messick began the season with High-A Lake County and went 5-5 with a 3.57 ERA in 13 starts. He split his professional debut season last year between Low-A Lynchburg and High-A Lake County, going 5-6 with a 3.77 ERA in 26 appearances. Messick was selected by the Guardians in the second round (54th overall) in the 2022 MLB Draft out of Florida State, where he was a First-Team All-American that year and the ACC Pitcher of the Year in 2021. Messick is rated by Baseball America as the No. 17 Guardians prospect and No. 21 by MLB.com.

BLANK SPACE: Last Wednesday, the Flying Squirrels pitched their 10th shutout of the season, beating the Senators, 5-0. The 10 shutouts are tied for the second-most in the Eastern League, even with Harrisburg and trailing only 11 by Akron. Erie has nine. It is also the most shutouts in a season for the Flying Squirrels since they had 12 in 2016.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels turned three double plays on Friday night. It was the third time this season the Richmond defense has recorded three double plays. On the season, Richmond leads the Eastern League with 62 double plays turned. On the year, the Flying Squirrels have turned 13 double plays with **John Michael Bertrand** pitching, which is the most in the league. The three double plays induced by Bertrand on Friday were tied for the most by a pitcher in a game this season in the Eastern League.

GLOW SHOW: Since June 29, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .348 (16-for-46) with two homers, six doubles and nine RBIs over 14 games. In that span, he has picked up three hits three times, including Friday's series opener at Akron. Last season, Glowenke hit .155 (11-for-71) in his first 21 Double-A games from May 31-June 30 before batting .290 (51-for-176) in his final 54 regular-season games from July 1-September 17.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 30 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .331 (42-for-127) with three homers, eight doubles, seven walks and 16 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 21 games. In his last 41 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .315 (50-for-159) with six homers, nine doubles, 13 walks and 25 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 11-of-23 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .337 (31-for-92) in that stretch. He went hitless in the two games on Saturday's doubleheader, ending his 10-game hitting streak, which was the second-longest by a Richmond player this year, trailing his own 11-game streak earlier this season.

SCORELESS WORK FROM SILVA: Reliever Eric Silva has thrown seven consecutive appearances dating back to June 19 without allowing a run, spanning 9.2 innings. He has 13 strikeouts in that time frame. That span has lowered his season ERA from 6.41 to 4.71. Since throwing an immaculate inning on June 9 against the Curve, Silva has gone 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA (2 ER/13.1 IP) with 18 strikeouts and four walks. Earlier this season, Silva threw six consecutive scoreless outings from May 1-21, spanning 9.2 innings with 10 strikeouts. Over his next six outings prior to his current scoreless streak, he posted a 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) from May 26-June 14. On Thursday night against the Senators, he closed his second save of the year, striking out the side in order in the ninth.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked eighth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,725), outpacing the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Trevor McDonald (No. 18), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23) and RHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Brown (No. 15), OF Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history, Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023) and Hayden Birdsong (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.
