SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

NEARING THE RECORD BOOKS: INF Tyler Black extended his on-base streak to 25 games with a first inning single on Wednesday... Black's on-base streak is the longest active streak in the Southern League, and tied with INF Cam Devanney and INF/OF Garrett Cooper for the second-longest in Shuckers history... The longest on-base streak in franchise history is set at 27 by OF Cooper Hummell in 2019... Over that span, which dates back to April 29, Black has a .418 OBP with seven extra-base hits... He also has 18 stolen bases over that span... In 2023, Black has reached base in 41 of the 42 games he's played in.

SO MUCH FOR LOW BLOOD PRESSURE: With Wednesday night's one-run affair between the Shuckers and Blue Wahoos, the two teams have had five of their first eight games in the season series decided by two runs or less... This series, both games have been decided by one run, with the tying run on base in the final inning in both games... This year, the Shuckers have played in 22 games decided by two runs or less... In those 22 games, the Shuckers are 8-14 (.364).

RECAPPING THE MONTH: Today marks the first game in June for Biloxi after the Shuckers went 12-14 in the month of May... The Shuckers ranked sixth in Double-A during the month by drawing 128 walks... On the mound, the Shuckers struck out 293 batters, second-most in Double-A... In May, the Shuckers pitching staff set a new single-game record with 19 strikeouts on May 3, 2023 against the Montgomery Biscuits... C Jefferson Quero launched himself into the Southern League leaders, tying the league lead in the month with seven home runs... INF Wes Clarke's .876 OPS during May was the seventh-highest in the league.

THE YOUNG AND RESTLESS: Entering today's game, the Shuckers lineup is the youngest in Double-A... Per *Baseball-Reference*, which uses playing time to weight and measure the average age, the average Shuckers hitter is 22 years and six months old... For comparison, the oldest lineup in Double-A is the San Antonio Missions (SDP) with an average age of 26 years and four months old... The Shuckers roster has five players who enter today at 22 years old or younger.

MOVING TOWARDS HISTORY: Shuckers manager Mike Guerrero enters today needing five more wins to reach 1,400 in his managerial career... Guerrero is in his 25th season in Minor League Baseball in 2023 and his 24th with the Brewers organization... Over his seven-year managerial career in Biloxi, Guerrero has earned a two trips to the Southern League Championship Series, in 2018 and 2019... Guerrero also led the Shuckers to a franchise-best 82 wins during the 2019 season, a year after he led the Shuckers to a then-record 81 wins.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS (2-3, 5.45): After tying a career-high with six inning last time out, RHP Christian Mejias is set to make his eighth start of the year... Mejias' nine strikeouts over six shutout innings against Montgomery set a new season high and marked his fifth appearance of the year with at least eight strikeouts... In his only start against Pensacola in 2023, Mejias struck out eight over five shutout innings... Right-handed batters are hitting .155 (11-71) against Mejias in 2023.
