**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn overcame a pair of deficits to snatch a 3-2, 11-inning victory over Wilmington on Saturday... LF **Alex Ramírez** provided the walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 11th... 1B **Joe Suozzi** collected a pair of game-tying singles in the 8th and 10th... RHP **Jordan Geber** hurled the 'Clones first quality start of the year, tallying 6.0 innings of 1-run ball... RHP **Wilkin Ramos** and RHP **Manny Rodríguez** did not allow an earned run (1 total) and punched out 8 in 5.0 combined innings in relief.

**IT'S A WALK OFF:** Brooklyn garnered their 2nd walk-off victory of 2023 on Saturday afternoon... The Cyclones erased a pair of deficits to win it on LF **Alex Ramírez's** RBI single in the 11th... Brooklyn also won in walk-off fashion on Opening Day (April 7) on a bases-loaded RBI walk by 1B **Chase Estep**... Last season, Brooklyn had 4 walk-off victories at Maimonides Park.

**THUNDERBOLT:** The Cyclones have been active on the base paths to start the 2023 season... Coming to Sunday, Brooklyn poses 2 of the South Atlantic League leaders in stolen bags... OF **Omar De Los Santos** is tied with Hudson Valley's **Caleb Durbin** for the league-lead with 9... IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is currently tied for 3rd with 8... More importantly, both are a combined 17-for-17 on attempts... While the 'Clones are only 8th in the league with 25 team stolen bases, the squad is 2nd in success rate (.893)... Only Hudson Valley (.917) has been more successful.

**A-RAM A-HERO:** OF **Alex Ramírez** extended his team season-long hitting streak to 9 with a walk-off RBI single in the 11th on Saturday... The stretch is also good for the second-longest active streak in the SAL... The 20-year-old is 13-for-his-last-38 (.342) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 9 RBI, 3 walks, and 2 stolen bases... Since the start of last season, Ramírez leads all Mets' minor leaguers in batting average (.281) and triples (7)... He is also tied with former Cyclone INF **Ronny Mauricio** for the most doubles (33)... Ramírez is 2nd in on-base percentage (.343) and hits (156), 3rd in OPS (.774), slugging (.431) and total bases (239), and tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (52).

**GO DJ:** LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023... In his first 5 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 1-0 record with 1 save... He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and a walk, striking out 11... In 10 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 10.1 innings... The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 18-straight appearances dating back to last year... Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach... Since then, he is 3-0 with 8 hits allowed, 10 walks, and 26 strikeouts in 20.2 innings.

**BER-BEST-I:** INF **César Berbesi** has bounced back from an injury-plagued 2022 in style... The 23-year-old has reached base in each of his first 8 games in 2023... Berbesi is 10-for-26 (.385) at the plate with 10 runs scored, a double, a triple, and 4 RBI... If he had enough plate appearances to qualify, Berbesi would enter Sunday's game tops in the SAL in on-base percentage (.568)... He would also be tied for 4th in batting average (.385) and 8th in OPS (1.068)... Berbesi has walked 76 times compared to only 84 strikeouts in 104 career games.

**vs. WILMINGTON:** Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game set against the Nationals' High-A affiliate. The Dash boast 5 of the Nats' top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*... OF **James Wood** (1), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (8), OF **T.J. White** (10), RHP **Andry Lara** (15), and INF **Trey Lipscomb** (24)... The Cyclones went 13-14 in 27 matchups against the Blue Rocks in 2022... Brooklyn and Wilmington split 10 games at Maimonides Park last season... The Cyclones are 16-10 all-time at home vs. Wilmington.

**SUPER STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** — who tripled on Friday — was named South Atlantic League Player of the Week (April 10-16) on Monday... During last week's series in Winston-Salem, Consuegra was 9-for-24 (.375) with 2 doubles, 3 home runs, and 10 RBI... The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 4 hits and fell one RBI short of matching his career-best with 4 RBI last Thursday... Consuegra enters Sunday's series finale on a 9-game on-base streak dated back to April 12... Since then, the right-handed swinger is slashing .343/.425/.743 with a stellar 1.168 OPS... Consuegra has 7 extra-base hits, 3 home runs, and 10 RBI in that span.

**FLASHING 'SIGNS':** Brooklyn pitching racked up strikeouts in bunches last Friday night... Cyclones pitchers combined to whiff a season-high 17 Winston-Salem hitters in an 8-3 victory... RHP **Raimon Gómez** punched out a career-high 7 over 3.0 frames to start... LHP **Daniel Juárez** (5), RHP **Manny Rodríguez** (3), and RHP **Jace Beck** (2) united to retire 10 in relief... The 17 K's are the most for Brooklyn pitching since they reached that number in an 18-1 win at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022.

**ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL:** Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball... The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)... Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

**2022 IN REVIEW:** The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62... Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26... The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

**MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022... Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19... The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)... Including 2023, holds a career record of 108-100 (.519).

**PROSPECTS:** Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*... They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramirez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)... OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision last Sunday at Winston-Salem...Did not allow a run on 1 hit over 2.0 innings...Struck out 4 without permitting a walk...Tossed 28 pitches (21 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Jordan Geber** to start the bottom of the 3rd with Brooklyn leading, 1-0...Winston-Salem scored 3 in the 7th and 4 in the 8th and defeated the Cyclones, 10-4.

**TOP PROSPECT:** Tidwell enters the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' top pitching prospect per MLB Pipeline...Comes at No. 7 overall on the Top 30 list... The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 9 overall farmhand by *Baseball America*...Only RHP **Kodai Senga** is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list... Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

**2022:** Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27... Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16... Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts...Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League play-offs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

**VOLUNTEER SERVICE:** Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game.

**LORETTO LIGHTNING:** Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent...At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 first-round pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP **Ryan Weathers**...Ryan's father, **David**, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.
