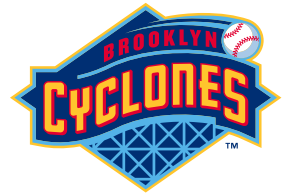

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones took down the BlueClaws yesterday afternoon by a score of 9-8, in 11 innings, to open up the 2023 campaign...The win improved Brooklyn's all time opening day record to 15-7...In the bottom of the 11th with the bases juiced, INF **Chase Estep** drew a four-pitch walk to break an 8-8 tie, and hand the Cyclones their first win of the new season.

FREE BASEBALL!: Friday's Opening Day contest against the BlueClaws spanned 4 and 40 minutes...In 2022, the longest game Brooklyn played was listed at 3 hours and 24 minutes in a 12-inning, 7-6 victory at Wilmington on August 11...The last time a Cyclones game lasted that long was back on June 20, 2016, a 17-inning 10-9 loss to the Tri-City Valley Cats...It was Brooklyn's fourth contest of that 2016 season and lasted 6 hours and 5 minutes...It was the 'Clones longest home game since their season opener vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016...Brooklyn dropped that contest, 3-2, in 20 innings after 5 hours and 39 minutes.

PATIENT PALMER: INF **Jaylen Palmer** drew four walks in yesterday's victory over Jersey Shore...Oddly enough, that is not the first time the Brooklyn native has done just that...Palmer also drew four free passes in a 2021 game with Single-A St. Lucie against Daytona...Palmer is the first Cyclones player to have a four walk game since **Nic Gaddis** did last season, also against Jersey Shore, on July 22.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate comes to Brooklyn to open the 2023 season. The BlueClaws boast two of Philly's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*, including INF **Hao Yu Lee** (No. 6) and RHP **Tommy McCollum Jr.** (29)...Brooklyn dominated the season series vs. Jersey Shore in 2022, winning 22-of-27 meetings...The Cyclones were 10-2 against the BlueClaws at Maimonides Park.

coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)... Holds a career record of 105-92 (.533).

NEW DRAFT CLASS: The New York Mets' 2022 MLB draft class brings six arms and three bats to Coney Island in 2023...RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2nd round), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6th), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (8th), RHP **Paul Gervase** (12th), RHP **Cameron Foster** (14th), and RHP **Jordan Geber** (UDFA) all begin the season on pitching coach **Victor Ramos'** staff...C **Kevin Parada** — the No. 11 overall pick — joins INF **Chase Estep** (9th) and INF **Brad Malm** (UDFA) headlining the offensive firepower.

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramirez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

CANARSIE TO CONEY: INF/OF **Jaylen Palmer**, returns to the Cyclones once again in 2023. The Canarsie, Brooklyn native attended Holy Cross High School in Queens - three miles east from Citi Field in Flushing and 30 miles northeast of Maimonides Park - before being drafted by the Mets in the 22nd round of the 2018 MLB Draft.

2022: Tebrake joined the FCL Mets on August 12 after signing with New York for \$136,425, on August 1...Made 2 appearances (1 start)...Did not allow a run or a walk...Assigned to St. Lucie on August 26...Struck out 6 over 2.2 innings in 2 appearances (1 start)...Placed on St. Lucie's 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on September 8.

FEELING BLUE: Tebrake was selected by the Mets in the 8th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Creighton University...As a senior, the right-hander tallied an 8-2 mark with a 2.71 ERA (28 ER in 93.0 IP) over 17 starts for the Bluejays...Whiffed 115 batters and walked only 33...Twice named the Big East Pitcher of the Year following the 2021 and 2022 seasons.

I'VE GOT THE KEYS: Prior to returning to Creighton for his senior season, Tebrake pitched for the Frederick (Md.) Keys of the MLB Draft League in 2021...In 7 appearances out of the bullpen accumulated a 2-0 record with a miniscule 0.82 ERA (1 ER in 11.0 IP) and 12 strikeouts.
