LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their finale to the Richmond Flying Squirrels, 10-6, on Sunday afternoon. Right-handed starter Carlos Tavera only went two-thirds of an inning, walking four in the process and giving up a three-run home run to Richmond's Carter Aldrete. A fourth run scored in the frame on a first-and-third double steal to give the Flying Squirrels a 4-0 lead out of the gates. Richmond would eventually take a 9-1 lead in the fith, capitalizing off eight walks from Baysox pitching. Bowie would charge back late, after scoring a pair of runs on a pair of Richmond errors, Ramon Rodriguez hit a three-run home run in the bottom of the eighth to make it a 9-5 game. The Flying Squirrels tacked on a run off a Shane Matheny double, his third RBI of the game, in the top of the ninth. In the bottom half, Bowie loaded the bases and brought in a run on a walk to Billy Cook, but then recorded three-straight outs to end the game, failing to complete the comeback.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve enter tonight's matchup with a record of 31-30 - third place in the Eastern League Southwest division and two games behind first place Erie in the final week of play in the first half. This is already the third matchup between the Curve and Baysox this season, with Altoona holding the 7-4 edge in the season series, including winning four of five at People's Natural Gas Field in April. The Curve are coming off a series in which they lost five of six on the road against Somerset. Altoona is a tough team to strike out, as the Curve have the fewest strikeouts (503) in Double-A, and fifth-fewest in Minor League Baseball, going against a Baysox staff with the third-most strikeouts (602) in the Eastern League.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Altoona looks to start the series by sending right-hander Aaron Shortridge to the mound. Shortridge has pitched to plenty of contact this season, allowing 56 hits in 54.2 innings. The right-hander has also allowed eight runs across his 11 innings in the month of June (6.55 ERA) and three of his five home runs allowed this season. Shortridge also holds a 7.36 ERA in 22 innings at home this season, walking 14 compared to just 17 strikeouts. Shortridge last pitched this past Thursday in Somerset, where he had his best start of the month - six shutout frames with three hits allowed and three walks, along with six strikeouts. Against the Baysox this season, Shortridge has two starts, allowing two runs across six innings on both ocassions. In four career starts against Bowle, Shortridge is 1-1 with a 7.64 ERA. Originally a fourth round pick of the Pirates back in 2018 out of Cal, Shortridge features a fastball in the low-to-mid-90s, along with a slider and changeup.

THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo sits second at the Double-A level with 21 doubles, while his 34 extra-base hits are tied for the most at the Double-A level and fourth-most in all of Minor League Baseball. The No. 8 Orioles'/ No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, also has an active eight-game hitting streak, along with an active 32-game on-base streak - the second-longest in the Eastern League this season. Mayo took home Eastern League Player of the Week honors this past week, after going 10-for-24 (.417), with two doubles, a triple, three home runs, and 8 RBI. Mayo sits third in the league with a .417 on-base percentage and a .979 OPS, while also ranking fourth with a .562 slugging percentage.

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook is enjoying one of the hottest stretches of his professional career. Cook has hits in 11 of 12 games for just the second time in his minor league career. He's hitting .319 (15-for-47) in that stretch with six doubles and two home runs. Cook has bounced back nicely in 2023, hitting .294 with 18 extra-base hits over the past two months, after hitting just .103 with one extra-base hit in the month of April.

LEADING THE WAY, AWAY FROM HOME

After starting 4-10 away from home this season, the Baysox have won nine of their last 12 road contests - including taking each of the past two road series. The Baysox have had strong pitching outside of Prince George's Stadium more often than not this season, with their 3.42 road ERA as a staff leading all of Double-A. However, lately, its been the bats coming to life. Bowie is averaging 5.75 runs per game during this 12-game stretch away from home, including six performances of seven runs or more. In the 11 road games prior, Bowie averaged just 3.09 runs per game, losing nine of those contests.

DONTA' DAZZLES

Donta' Williams has enjoyed a steallar offensive bounce back over the past month. After hitting just .158 across the first two months of the season, with nearly three times as many strikeouts (45) as hits (18), including a 4-for-51 (.078) stretch in May, Williams has bounced back, hitting .323 in the month of June. Overall, since snapping his 4-for-51 stretch, Williams is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with five doubles and three home runs, while his on-base percentage has also climed 68 points.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-26 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017.
