NASTY NESTOR: LHP Nestor Cortes was assigned to Nashville to begin a rehab assignment on Wednesday and will make his first appearance since April 3rd after landing on the 60-day IL with a left elbow flexor strain on April 21. Cortes was dealt from the Yankees to the Brewers on December 13, 2024, in the trade that sent Devin Williams to the Yankees in exchange for Cortes and INF Caleb Durbin who made his Major League debut earlier this season after beginning the season with Nashville. Following a rough Brewers debut against his former Yankees (2.0 IP, 6 H, 8 ER, 5 HR, 2 K, 5 BB) Cortes bounced back with six scoreless innings with a hit allowed on April 3 vs. Cincinnati.

SUMMER SOUNDS: Nashville ended June 14-10 and had a 4.07 ERA as a team (4th in the IL) and posted an IL-best five shutouts in 24 games. The six triples hit by Nashville hitters were tied for the fourth-most in the IL. The 16 home runs hit by the Sounds were the fewest among all 30 Triple-A clubs. **Bobby Dalbec** ended the month of June top 10 in the IL in a handful of offensive categories including: doubles (4th, 9), XBH (5th, 15), RBI (6th, 20), SLG (8th, .638), OPS (8th, 1.055), and TB (8th, 51). Despite playing in 13 games, **Drew Avans** finished tied for second in the IL with nine stolen bases. Pitching wise, **Logan Henderson** was fourth in the IL with his 2.66 ERA among qualified pitchers. **Tobias Myers** finished eighth in strikeouts (30) and was third in IP (29.0). **Craig Yoho** was tied for fifth in saves (3).

BACK IN BLACK: Tyler Black posted his first multi-hit game with the Sounds in 12 games. His last came on June 7 while rehabbing in the Arizona Complex League. Through 12 games, Black is hitting .114 (5-for-44) with a pair of extra-base hits. He stole his third base of the year since joining the club.

HENDY MAN: The five earned allowed by Logan Henderson matches his season-high in 2025. He also allowed five earned in his first start of the season against Jacksonville on March 29th. After allowing six home runs through his first 13 games of the season, Henderson has allowed five over his last three starts. Prior to surrendering two home runs against Iowa on June 19th, Henderson had allowed multiple home runs in an outing just twice in 57 career games but has now allowed 2+ home runs in two of his last three starts.

WRONG FOUR: The current four-game losing streak is tied for the longest losing streak of the season for Nashville. The Sounds also dropped four straight (3/29-4/2) after earning a win on Opening Night of the season. Since then, the Sounds have dropped three-straight games just twice (5/29-31 & 6/10-12).

BOBBY EIGHT: With a walk in the bottom of the ninth inning, Bobby Dalbec extended his on-base streak to eight games, already adding to what is a season-long. Dalbec has seven hits during the stretch including four doubles and a home run.

PERKS OF THE JOB: Blake Perkins continued his Major League rehab with the Sounds and collected his first two hits with Nashville in three games played. He began the game with his first home run since July 7, 2024, against the Los Angeles Dodgers. His leadoff home run was just the third of the season for Nashville and first since Daz Cameron hit one on April 25th. Perkins entered the day 0-for-5 with a pair of walks in his first two appearances with Nashville in Jacksonville. He drew multiple walks in each of the last two games and also stole two bases for the Sounds on Sunday.

BIRTHDAY DOUBLES: Bobby Dalbec celebrated his birthday on Sunday with his sixth three-hit performance in 39 games for Nashville. He now has two more three hit games than Anthony Seigler (4) for the team lead in 2025. He is one of seven International League players with three doubles in a game this year and it was his first career game with three doubles. He's the first Nashville player with three doubles in a game since David Dahl did it on August 21, 2021, at Memphis. Since 2005, Sunday was the 19th three-double game by a Nashville player.
