UNDERWAY: The Wisconsin finally got their season started on Saturday, April 4 with a doubleheader split at home against the Beloit Sky Carp. The Sky Carp won game on 5-4. The Timber Rattlers took game two 8-7. The Rattlers had been rained out on April 2 & 3.

GAME ONE RECAP: Wisconsin had a 4-0 lead without a hit in the opener on Saturday. Beloit starting pitcher Liomar Martinez walked five, three five wild pitches, and committed a balk in the first inning to allow the Rattlers to take a 3-0 lead. Luis Peña stole home on the back end of a double steal in the second. However, Beloit scored three runs in the third and a run in the sixth to tie the game. Cody Caskenette hit a lead-off homer in the seventh for Beloit's go-ahead run. Wisconsin had runners at the corners with one out in the bottom of the seventh but could not score. The Rattlers had four hits in the game – two by Josh Adamczewski and two by Andrew Fischer. The pitchers combined for 23 walks – ten by Beloit hurlers and thirteen by Wisconsin's.

GAME TWO RECAP: Wisconsin hit three home runs in the game and held on for the one-run win. Braylon Payne started the bottom of the first with a homer. Marco Dinges hit a two-run homer in the third for a 3-2 lead. Tayden Hall, who had three hits in the nightcap, gave Wisconsin a 5-4 lead with a two-out, two-run single in the fifth. Then, Eric Bitonti cracked a three-run home run for an 8-4 advantage. The Sky Carp scored three times in the top of the seventh and had they go-ahead runs on base with two outs before Bryan Rivera got the final out for the save.

DID YOU KNOW? Tonight will be the season opener for the River Bandits. Quad Cities had all three of their games at South Bend rained out or canceled due to wet grounds between April 3 and 5. Jesus Azuaje is in his second season as the manager of the River Bandits. Last year, Quad Cities had the best overall record in the West Division at 74-58. However, they missed out on the playoffs by finishing second in the division in both halves.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP YORMAN GALINDEZ: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Galindez as an International Free Agent on 01/15/2022 out of Venezuela.

GOLDEN: Galindez made his professional debut with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League in 2022. He was 3-2 with a 6.45 ERA in thirteen games – four starts. Galindez walked 26 and struck out 50 in 37-2/3 innings during his first two seasons.

TWO LEVELS: Galindez split time between the ACL and Carolina in 2023 while going 3-0 with a 3.88 ERA in fourteen games nine starts.

STOPPED IN HIS TRACKS: Galindez made eleven starts for the Carolina Mudcats in 2024 before an injury halted his season. He had no record with a 2.45 ERA with 64 strikeouts over 40-1/3 innings before the injury on June 13, 2024. Galindez did not pitch in 2025.

LAST START: Galindez went four scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked one and struck out eight for a no decision against Fredericksburg on [June 13, 2024](#).

VS. QUAD CITIES: Galindez has never faced the River Bandits prior to this evening. The only time he has pitched against an affiliate of the Kansas City Royals was on [August 2, 2023](#) as a starting pitcher against the ACL Royals. Galindez had a no decision, allowed one run on three hits with three walks and two strikeouts in four innings.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

LHP DAVID SHIELDS: The Kansas City Royals selected Shields in the second round with the 41st pick of the 2024 draft out of Mt. Lebanon High School in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

NOT FOR THE U: Shields signed with the Royals over a commitment to the University of Miami.

HOW DOES HE RATE? *Baseball America* has Shields as the #3 prospect in the Royals system. MLB Pipeline ranks Shields at #4.

LAST SEASON: Shields made his pro debut with the ACL Royals on May 7. It was his only start in the ACL before a quick promotion to the Columbia Fireflies of the Carolina League. Shields was 3-1 with a 2.01 ERA and 81 strikeouts with fifteen walks over 75-2/3 innings in 18 starts. Shields was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Year. He also went 2-0 with twelve strikeouts in ten innings during to playoff starts for Columbia in 2025.

LAST START: Shields beat Lynchburg on [September 16, 2025](#) in Game Two of the Carolina League Championship Series. He allowed three runs on seven hits with no walks and four strikeouts in five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Shields has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. He earned the win over the Carolina Mudcats on [June 19, 2025](#). Shields allowed two runs on two hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings. Eric Bitonti and José Anderson both had solo homers for Carolina’s runs off Shields.
