The Round Rock Express and Sacramento River Cats (San Francisco Giants) are scheduled for game three of their six-game series on Thursday. First pitch at Sutter Health Park is slated for 8:45 p.m. CT.

E-TRAIN FALL ON WEDNESDAY

The Express fell on Wednesday night by a final score of 5-2. Sacramento took a quick 1-0 lead after two batters. Back-to-back doubles to start the game for LF Wade Meckler and 2B Tyler Fitzgerald gave the River Cats the lead. The Round Rock offense took the lead in the third frame. After a single from DH Omar Narváez and a double from 3B Keyber Rodriguez put runners on second and third base. CF Billy McKinney doubled into left field and it was a 2-1 lead for the E-Train. The River Cats evened the score at two apiece in the fifth inning. Meckler picked up his second double of the night and CF Turner Hill scored. In the sixth inning, Sacramento took the lead for good. A triple for 3B Dayson Croes set up 1B Drew Ellis. He blasted a two-run home run and it was 4-2. In the eighth, SS Osleivis Basabe hit a solo home run to make it a 5-2 game where the score stood final. LHP John Michael Bertrand earned the win after 5.2 innings with two earned runs on two hits, a walk and four strikeouts. RHP Peyton Gray got the loss after 1.0 inning with two hits, an earned run and a strikeout.

TIME TO ROCKER

RHP Kumar Rocker is slated for his first start since August 7. Rocker has spent the last month in Arizona working on his delivery. In 14 starts this year for the Rangers, Rocker owns a 5.74 ERA (41 ER/64.1 IP) and was optioned to the Express on August 1. The 25-year-old was the third overall pick in the 2022 MLB Draft out of Vanderbilt. Thursday will be just his 20th start in the minor leagues.

TACOMA TAKES IT

Round Rock was eliminated from playoff contention after Tacoma beat Oklahoma City last night. The Express can still tie their best finish in a half since this playoff format was introduced in 2023. They need to win all four games to tie their 2023 second half record (45-30).

BILLY BATS

CF Billy McKinney went 2-for-4 with a double and two RBI on Wednesday. He is 4-for-8 with a double, two RBI and three runs scored to start the series. Since he was taken off the Injured List on August 19, McKinney is slashing .278/.337/.444/.781 with four doubles, one triple, three homers, 18 RBI, 14 runs scored, seven walks and 23 strikeouts.

THE E-TRAIN IS RUMBLING

Round Rock has won eight of their last 11 and they are 27-14 in their last 41 games which is the best record in all of Triple-A. They are 4-0-2 in those six series since August 5. Entering August, the E-Train were 4-8-6 in series play for 2025.

C-FREE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Round Rock INF Cody Freeman was named the Texas Rangers Minor League Tom Grieve Player of the Year on Thursday. Freeman slashed .336/.382/.549/.931 with 25 doubles, 19 home runs, 71 RBI, 75 runs scored, 32 walks and 37 strikeouts in 97 games with the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
