**TODAY'S GAME:** The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A, Houston Astros) play their first six-game home series of the year, hosting the defending Carolina League champion Fredericksburg Nationals (Single-A, Washington Nationals). The two squads only faced off just six times last season at Virginia Credit Union Stadium, splitting that series 3-3, but Fayetteville's move to the North Division quadruples their amount of matchups in 2025. In the series conclusion, the Woodpeckers turn to RHP Ramsey David while the Nationals call upon LHP Erik Tolman. The FredNats have won three straight games and lead the current series 3-2.

**ABOUT THE NATIONALS:** The Fredericksburg Nationals, founded in 1984, begin their 42nd year of operation in 2025. Having joined the Carolina League the same year as their foundation, they are the third-longest tenured team in the league only behind the Lynchburg Hillcats (Single-A, Cleveland Guardians) (60 years) and Salem Red Sox (Single-A, Boston Red Sox) (58 years). Billy McMillon takes over as the new manager following Jake Lowery's promotion to manage the Wilmington Blue Rocks (High-A, Washington Nationals), for his first season managing in the Nationals organization. The Nationals won last season's Carolina League championship, their fifth in franchise history and first in Fredericksburg. Before moving to Fredericksburg, they were founded in Prince William County, Va., spending the first 25 seasons of their existence there before moving to Potomac, Md. in 1999. They previously held affiliations with the Pittsburgh Pirates (1984-1986), New York Yankees (1987-1993), Chicago White Sox (1994-1996), St. Louis Cardinals (1997-2002), and Cincinnati Reds (2003-2004) before joining the Nationals organization ahead of their inaugural season in 2005.

**(SOMEWHAT) FAMILIAR FOES:** This past offseason, the Carolina League experienced significant changes that saw the league re-shuffle ahead of the 2025 campaign. In May 2024, the Down East Wood Ducks announced their relocation to Spartanburg, S.C. and re-brand as the Hub City Spartanburgers, and shortly thereafter, in July, the Texas Rangers swapped them with the Hickory Crawdads, sending them to the High-A South Atlantic League while the Crawdads took their place in the Carolina League. Upon their entry to the league, the Crawdads were placed in the South Division, and the Woodpeckers took Down East's spot in the North Division, grouping them with the Nationals, Lynchburg Hillcats (Single-A Cleveland Guardians), Carolina Mudcats (Single-A Milwaukee Brewers), Delmarva Shorebirds (Single-A, Baltimore Orioles), and Salem Red Sox (Single-A, Boston Red Sox).

**ON THE ROAD TO H-TOWN:** The Woodpeckers current roster features three players listed in the top 30 of the Houston Prospect Rankings according to MLB.com. Cole Hertzler is the highest ranked of the trio at No. 27 overall (No. 13 pitcher), Jancel Villarroel is the lone position player in the group at No. 29 overall (No. 2 catcher), and Bryce Mayer rounds out the list at No. 30 overall (No. 15 pitcher).

**THE NEW MAN IN THE DUGOUT:** The Woodpeckers feature a brand new coaching staff from top to bottom in 2025. With former manager Ricky Rivera earning a promotion to Double-A to lead the Corpus Christi Hooks, Carlos Lugo takes over for his first season in full-season baseball. However, Lugo is no stranger to the Houston Astros organization. This season marks his 12th with the club having started as a catching specialist in the Dominican Summer League in 2014. Most recently, he spent four seasons managing in the Florida Complex League, the first of which with Rivera, helping develop some of the Astros' youngest professional players. As he gets his first taste of Single-A, he teams up with three members of his staff from last year in Palm Beach including James Wiseman (Pitching Coach), Kyle Brennan (Hitting Coach), and Alfredo Granier (Development Coach).

**PECKERS AT THE PLATE:** Caden Powell and Jancel Villarroel are Fayetteville's two hottest hitters at the start of the 2025 season. Powell, the team's primary shortstop, is batting .302 with five doubles, one homer, 6 RBI and 5 multi-hit games across his first 13 contests. His 5 doubles are tied for second across the entire Carolina League circuit. He also leads the team with a .860 OPS. Villarroel is slashing .298/.404/.830 with 4 doubles, 6 RBI and 9 walks. His batting average as it stands is a .065 point increase from the .233 mark he finished with over 54 games in 2024.

**LATE LEADS DONT LAST:** The Woodpeckers have had trouble over the first two weeks of the season hanging on to late leads at home. The club has a 3-4 record when leading after seven innings, and has surrendered a late advantage to Fredericksburg on consecutive nights entering Saturday. Fayetteville also lost a pair of game at home on Opening Weekend in which they led during the final three innings.

**THIS DAY IN WOODPECKERS HISTORY:** April 20, 2022 - Three years ago today, the Fayetteville Woodpeckers top the Augusta GreenJackets 3-1 on the road behind a two-run top of the sixth inning. Carlos Calderon tossed 5.0 innings in the start and Ernesto Jaquez strikes out 10 over 4.0 innings from the bullpen.
