series against the Memphis Redbirds (St. Louis Cardinals) at AutoZone Park. It is the 14th of 27 games to be played between the two clubs this season, and the eighth of 15 games to be played in Memphis.

VS. MEMPHIS: Gwinnett is 3-0-3 in six series all-time vs. Memphis since first meeting in 2021. The Stripers are 11-8 (.579) in 19 games all-time at AutoZone Park, including 4-3 (.571) in seven games so far this season.

come-from-behind victory of the season last night, erasing a 5-0 deficit through four innings to beat Memphis 7-6. Travis Demeritte hit a game-winning two-out, two-run double in the eighth. Previously, Gwinnett's largest comeback of the year was three runs, accomplished twice (most recently on 7/4 vs. CLT, trailed 3-0 and won 6-3).

JULY TRENDS: Through 16 games this month, the Stripers are 9-7 with a +1 run differential (outscoring 49-48). Twelve games have been decided by three runs or less (GWN is 7-5), including five one-run games (GWN is 4-1).

- Dominant Arms: Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in July in ERA (3.00), WHIP (1.07), BAA (.208), fewest runs allowed (48), and fewest hits allowed (104).
- Struggling Bats: Gwinnett hitters rank last in Triple-A in July in runs scored (49), homers (7), total bases (167), SLG (.336), and OPS (.648).

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead the International League in strikeouts with 901 in 91 games (9.90 SO/game). That's two more than the second-place team, Worcester (899 SO in 91G). Gwinnett has not led the IL in strikeouts since 2011 (club record 1,223 SO in 143G). Entering play, Kyle Muller (1st, 117), Tucker Davidson (4th, 89), Huascar Ynoa (T-9th, 77), and Bryce Elder (T-16th, 71) all rank among the IL top 20 in strikeouts.

DEMERITTE DELIVERS: Travis Demeritte drove in the tying and winning runs with his eighth-inning double last night, marking just his third multi-RBI game with Gwinnett this year (first since 4/14 vs. NAS, 1-for-5, 1 HR, 2 RBI).

• GWN Career: He has reached base safely in 175 of 208 career games (84.1%) with Gwinnett since 2019, batting .274 (197-for-720, 53 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 131 R, 142 RBI, 17 SB, .904 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons

CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin locked down his team-leading eighth save (T-6th in IL) last night, pitching a perfect ninth (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 SO). He is now riding a 16.2-inning scoreless streak over his last 15 games since 6/5, the fourth-longest scoreless streak in the IL this season. In that span, Tonkin is posting a 0.54 WHIP (6 H, 3 BB), .107 BAA, 14.04 SO/9.0 IP ratio (26 SO), and five saves (5-for-5). Overall, he's 3-0 with a 1.72 ERA (6 ER in 31.1 IP), 0.96 WHIP, and .167 BAA in 30 games.

TONIGHT: The Stripers play game two of a three-game DESHIELDS AMONG LEADERS: Delino DeShields Jr. ranks among the IL top 15 in stolen bases (T-8th, 19) and walks (13th, 44). He has reached base safely in 51 of 63 games (80.6%) with a plate appearance this season, batting .250 (46-for-184, 6 2B, 1 HR, 28 R, 18 RBI, .697 OPS).

OFFENSIVE ODDS & ENDS: Hernan Perez belted a solo home run last night (off RHP Thomas Parsons), his first since 5/28 at Norfolk. Perez is batting .500 (8-for-16, 1 2B, 1 HR, 4 R, 2 RBI, 1 SB, 1.279 OPS) in his last four games. Preston Tucker has tallied an RBI in four straight games, CALL IT A COMEBACK: The Stripers notched their largest batting .375 (6-for-16, 1 2B, 2 R, 6 RBI, .791 OPS) in that span. Ryan Goins is batting .349 (22-for-63, 6 2B, 6 R, 9 RBI, .850 OPS) in 19 games since 6/14.

> FERGUSON FIRING ZEROES: 28-year-old Tyler Ferguson has posted a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 3.0 IP) over three hitless appearances (2 BB, 5 SO) since joining Gwinnett for his Triple-A debut on 7/12. He has not allowed a run to his own line over his last 11 outings (11.2 IP, 0 H, 1 HB, 4 BB, 19 SO) since 6/16 with Double-A Mississippi.

> THE ELDER STROLLS: Bryce Elder turned in his second scoreless start of the year on 7/15 vs. Durham, working 7.0 innings (6 H, 0 BB, 5 SO) in a no-decision. Over three starts in July, he's 2-0 with a 1.74 ERA (4 ER in 20.2 IP). 1.02 WHIP 219 BAA and two quality starts.

• IL Leaderboard: Elder leads in GO/AO ratio (2.27) and ranks among the top 20 in WHIP (6th, 1.19), BAA (7th, .237), innings (T-15th, 79.0), and strikeouts (T-16th, 71).

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller notched his team-leading ninth quality start of the season on 7/14 vs. Durham, working 6.0 innings (7 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 BB, 7 SO) in a no-decision (GWN lost 5-3). Over his last eight starts since 6/2, Muller is 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA (13 ER in 52.0 IP), 0.88 WHIP, .202 BAA, 10.56 SO/9.0 IP (61 SO), and seven quality starts.

• IL Leaderboard: Muller leads in strikeouts (117, 7th in MiLB) and ranks among the top 10 in WHIP (2nd, 1.08), innings (T-2nd, 94.1), CG (T-2nd, 1), ERA (3rd, 2.96), BAA (3rd, .223), and GO/AO ratio (8th, 1.28).

ALL-STAR PRESENCE: Led by former Gwinnett manager Brian Snitker (2014-16), the National League roster for the 2022 MLB All-Star Game on 7/19 included seven Gwinnett alums: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. (2017-18, 2022), DH William Contreras (2021-22), C Travis d'Arnaud (2021), 1B Freddie Freeman (2010, 2013, 2015, 2017), P Max Fried (2017-18), 3B Austin Riley (2018-19), and SS Dansby Swanson (2017). The America League - void of any former Gwinnett players - won 3-2 at Dodger Stadium.

TUI AT THE FUTURES GAME: On 7/17, Stripers manager Matt Tuiasosopo served as the third base coach for the National League in the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles. He was the first Gwinnett coach ever to participate in a Futures Game. The NL, led by former MLB manager Mike Sciocia, lost 6-4 to the American League (OAK's Shea Langeliers was MVP).

PROSPECTING: Gwinnett's active roster features six listed on the MLB.com Atlanta Braves Top 30 Prospects list: LHP Kyle Muller (1), RHP Bryce Elder (2), INF Braden Shewmake (3), LHP Tucker Davidson (5), RHP Freddy Tarnok (6), and RHP Victor Vodnik (10). None are currently ranked on the MLB.com Top 100 Prospects list.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... On 7/16, he served third base coach for the NL Team for the 2022 SiriusXM MLB All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium ... Began his career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year.

TONIGHT'S START: Freddy Tarnok makes his second start with Gwinnett and 17th overall start of the season in game two of a three-game series at Memphis.

- Strong Stretch: In his last five starts between Double-A and Triple-A, is 2-0 with a 1.67 ERA (5 ER in 27.0 IP), 0.81 WHIP, .167 BAA, and 11.67 SO/9.0 IP ratio (35 SO).
- Road Debut: Pitches on the road for the first time in his Triple-A career tonight ... In eight road starts with Double-A Mississippi, was 2-1 with a 3.52 ERA and .246 BAA.

PROSPECTING: Tarnok is ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 6 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the fourth-highest ranked pitching prospect on Gwinnett's active roster, behind LHP Kyle Muller (1), RHP Bryce Elder (2), and LHP Tucker Davidson (5).

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Promoted to Gwinnett for his Triple-A debut on 7/8 ... 7/13 vs. DUR: Tossed 6.0 IP for the victory (2 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 4 SO in 2-1 win), becoming the first Gwinnett pitcher to record a quality start in his Triple-A debut since Jeremy Walker (9/2/18 vs. Charlotte).
