On June 7, 2002, Sounds pitcher Tony McKnight posted Nashville's second consecutive complete game shutout against New Orleans. Brian Meadows threw one the game prior to McKnight. It's the last time the Sounds have thrown back-to-back complete game shutouts.

## **He Gets On Base:** Jonathan Davis has reached base safely in a team-best 18 consecutive games. During the 18-game streak, Davis is hitting .306 (22-for-72) with 11 runs, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 8 RBI, 13 walks and 6 stolen bases. It's the 4th-longest active streak in the International League.

**Earn It:** Nashville's team ERA sits at 3.61, the best mark in Triple-A Baseball, far ahead of second-best Indianapolis at 3.96.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

**LAST OUTING:** The last time Ethan Small pitched was his Major League debut with Milwaukee on May 30 at Chicago-NL. He went 2.2 innings and allowed two runs on four hits and four walks. Small struck out four batters and threw 38 of his 69 pitches for strikes in Milwaukee's 7-6 win.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Small is facing Norfolk for the second time this season and in his career. In a start on May 6 at First Horizon Park, Small allowed a season-high five runs in his only loss of the season (4.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 2 BB, 6 K). Small threw 53 of his 94 pitches for strikes.
