Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the second of a six-game series at the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, part of a 24-meeting season series between the two clubs. The Nuts are coming off a home series split vs. Beloit and have won their last three games, including last night.

Last Night: Lugnuts 5, Dragons 4. Connor Burns capped a three-run Dayton 6th inning with a tie-breaking two-run homer, only to see Rodney Green, Jr. answer with a go-ahead three-run double in the 7th inning, lifting the Nuts to a series-opening victory. T.J. Schofield-Sam smashed his fifth home run of the year in the win.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Dragons through Sunday, enjoy a day off on June 9, and then return to Michigan's state capital to welcome in the archrival West Michigan Whitecaps for a six-game series at Jackson Field from June 10 - June 15.

Prospecting: The Nuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Athletics prospects: No. 7 prospect (Tommy White), No. 10 (Joshua Kuroda-Grauer), No. 12 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Ryan Lasko), No. 18 (Rodney Green, Jr.) and No. 28 (Nate Nankil).

Bases Juiced: Rodney Green, Jr.'s three-run double yesterday came in a familiar spot, a Lugnuts bases-loaded threat. Lansing had loaded the bases in six consecutive innings vs. Beloit between May 31-June 1 and has batted 77 times this year with the bases loaded, second-most in the Midwest League to West Michigan.

Coming Up Clutch: The Lugnuts are the best team in the Midwest League with runners in scoring position and two outs, topping the circuit in batting average (.266), at-bats (263) and base hits (70).

Lugnuts on the Leaderboard: T.J. Schofield-Sam is 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.357), 1st in base hits (61), tied for 1st in total bases (92), 2nd in runs scored (37), 4th in OBP (.426), 4th in slugging (.538) and 5th in OPS (.964); **Tommy White** is 2nd in the league in slugging (.570), 2nd in OPS (.970) and 3rd in batting average (.320). **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** is tied for 3rd in doubles (13). **Mark Adamiak** is 1st in saves (9), **Blaze Pontes** is 1st in appearances (19), and **Grant Judkins** is tied for 2nd in innings pitched (52).

O Canada: On the subject of T.J. Schofield-Sam: the Lugnuts' corner infielder has 1) been hit by pitches in three straight games... 2) is batting .398/.471/.659 with 23 runs scored in his last 23 games (35-for-88, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 5 homers, 5 walks, 8 HBPs)... 3) is batting .500/.593/.818 in the 1st inning (11-for-22, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 3 walks, 2 HBPs).

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.261), 2nd in base hits (444), tied for 1st in doubles (101), 3rd in on-base percentage (.360), 3rd in total bases (667) and are the toughest team to strike out (360).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is 1st in the league in holds (26), tied for 1st in complete games (2), 1st in fewest HBPs (17), 1st in fewest balks (3), 2nd in fewest walks (186) and tied for 1st in saves (15).

Less Than Jake: Reliever Jake Christianson has not allowed a run in his last 12 appearances, dating back to April 13, a span of 13 consecutive scoreless innings... which coincidentally matches his uniform number.

Mark it Down: Reliever Mark Adamiak has recorded a save in five of his last six relief appearances and has not issued a walk in his last nine relief appearances, spanning 30 batters.

Streaking: Outfielder Nate Nankil has reached base in 22 consecutive games dating back to May 7, batting .278/.376/.375 with 20 hits, 10 walks and two HBPs over that stretch.

Zeroes in Class-AA: A step up the organizational ladder, the Double-A Midland RockHounds have tossed three straight shutouts and have not allowed a run in their last 29 innings. Yesterday, Colby Halter scored on an Euribiel Angeles RBI single in the seventh inning, and James Gonzalez combined with Micah Dallas, Will Johnston and Gustavo Rodriguez on a three-hit shutout in a 1-0 win over San Antonio. All six players are former Lugnuts. 2019 Lug Jose Espada tossed a scoreless inning for the Padres-affiliated Missions in the loss.

Welcome to the Show: Five former Lugnuts have made a name for themselves in the Majors this season, from first-time manager Clayton McCullough (2008-2009) with the Marlins to players Max Muncy (March 27), Gunnar Hoglund (May 2), Denzel Clarke (May 23) and Jack Winkler (May 31), increasing the overall total to 197 Nuts who've worked their way from Lansing to MLB.

2011: Drew Hutchison's last three innings entering this start were scoreless. On this day, he began a stretch of four consecutive starts with six shutout innings (24 IP, 3 BB, 35 K), allowing two hits and striking out nine Burlington Bees in a 6-0 Lugnuts home win.

2017: No one had found a way to score against West Michigan ace closer Jason Foley – until the Lugnuts scored three in the top of the ninth inning, including a tie-breaking Rodrigo Orozco squeeze (in Orozco's Lugnuts debut, no less!), to beat the Whitecaps, 8-6. It was the fireballing Foley's first blown save of the year. The game had seen the Nuts score five runs in the top of the first inning to knock out Eudis Idrogo, followed by four Whitecaps runs in the home half against Lansing starter Denis Diaz.

2019: The Lugnuts homered in each of the first four innings, including two Hagen Danner home runs, and Josh Winckowski fired six shutout innings in an 8-0 win at first place Great Lakes (who had entered the game averaging 5.7 runs per contest). Jake Brodt belted a two-run homer in the first inning and Griffin Conine blasted off in the third, swatting a Robinson Ortiz curve ball off the Dow Diamond video board.



Starting Out: Corey Avant's first start of the season came due to unusual circumstances: April 25 vs. Fort Wayne, the start time was pushed back an hour due to worry of inclement weather; Avant pitched two innings, allowing one run, before yielding to the scheduled starter, Gage Jump, who struck out 13 batters in 6 2/3 dominant scoreless innings in a 3-1 Lugnuts win... on May 8 at West Michigan, Avant tossed two innings, allowing two runs, as the opener for Steven Echavarria, who followed with 4 2/3 scoreless innings in a 4-2 Lugs victory... Avant started the first game of this series and blanked the Cubs for the first two innings and one out into the third before allowing two straight singles and departing; both runners scored against Jake Garland... the Nuts went on to win, 7-6, in ten innings.

High School: Avant attended Sun Valley H.S., the Spartans, whose fight song is the Michigan State University fight song, Victory for MSU... the school's colors are maroon and gold, a la Central Michigan University... Sun Valley also produced NFL QB Sam Howell... Avant graduated Class of 2020.

College: Onward to Wingate University (named for Washington Manly Wingate, the fourth president at Wake Forest), the Bulldogs, colors: navy and gold... Avant majored in Math Business... redshirted the 2021 season, in which Wingate went 39-13, earned the No. 1 seed, and won the Division II National Championship in Cary, North Carolina, at the USA Baseball National Training Complex... in 2022, the Bulldogs set a program record for wins, going 48-10 with a 29-3 home record (first in the nation in both wins and winning percentage), but lost in the Southeast Regionals; redshirt freshman Avant went 3-1 with a 3-41 ERA in 26 relief appearances / 29 IP: 1 HR, 15 BB, 51 K... followed up in 2023 as a redshirt sophomore, striking out 57 batters in 39 innings (5.31, 23 G, 2 GS, 27 BB), as the Bulldogs finished 32-18, 18-6 in conference, but were eliminated in the SAC Tourney... excelled off the field with a 4.00 GPA, named two-time Academic All-America and served as Commencement Marshal at 2023 graduation
