#14 #29 3B Anderson De Los Santos portunities with runners on the corners, opening the door for Charleston to take the in the fourth as they put runs on the board with RBIs by **Carlos Colmenarez** and **Cooper Kinney.** A story in the game for the Shorebirds was their tough defensive effort by committing a season-high four errors with two of them coming on throws to first on infield hits by speedster **Chandler Simpson.** Delmarva produced their lone run on an RBI fielder's choice by Victor Gonzalez in the seventh, but couldn't get any closer as the RiverDogs won the opener by four.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: It will be a battle of southpaws on Wednesday night as Delmarva will send Deivy Cruz to the mound to face **Kikito Severino** for the Riverdogs. This will be Severino's third start of the season after his first six were in a relief role. Last time out, he tossed a season-best four innings where he allowed just one run on five hits in a 6-5 win over Augusta.

GETTING BACK ON TRACK: The offense for Delmarva looks to return to early season form after a tough start to the month of May. In April, the Shorebirds scored 134 runs while batting .269 with an OPS of .772, all three were tops in the Carolina League. In May, they are currently at the bottom of the league with an average of .201 with a league-most 149 strikeouts (11.4/gate.). In the most recent series versus Down East, The Shorebirds batted .184 in the six games with 65 punch-outs.

PITCHING SUCCESS: Despite the recent offensive struggles, the pitching has thrived for the Shorebirds as of late. Since April 26, the Shorebirds have a team ERA of 3.72 which is fourth best in the Carolina League in that span. **Bradley Brehmer** earned the first victory of the season for a Delmarva starting pitcher on May 12 in a 7-2 win over Down East.

LEADER IN THE CLUBHOUSE: Samuel Basallo has put together an incredibly productive first season in full-sea-son baseball as the 18 year old catcher is the current Carolina League leader in RBIs with 32. Basallo has four game this season with 3 RBIs and a career-best 4 RBI performance against Fredericksburg on April 18.

BRING BACK THE HOMERS: The offense for Delmarva failed to produce a long ball in the first four games in their latest series in Kinston against the Wood Ducks but it came back into play for the final two games as they homered twice in each matchup. Delmarva now faces the Charleston pitching staff that has allowed the most home runs in the league with 28. However, only 9 have occurred at home.

PROCEED WITH CAUTION: The Delmarva catchers have been tough to run on this season for opposing base runners as they are second in the Carolina League by catching 28 would be base stealers and have denied their opposition on 36% of their attempts through the first 32 games of the season.

TURN TWO: The infield defense for the Shorebirds have been great at turning double plays as they lead the league with 31 - Good for third most in Single-A behind Bradenton and San Jose. The Shorebirds defensively have been one of the best units in the Carolina League as they are ranked fourth in fielding percentage.

SERIES WITH THE CHAMPS: The Shorebirds continue their two week road trip as they head to face the defending champions, Chareston RiverDogs. The two played just one series last season that was also at the Joe and the RiverDogs took five of the six games in the series. Delmarva won the finale to avoid the sweep and were out-scored 38-44 in the series.

TODAY'S STARTER: Deivy Cruz toes the rubber for game two of the series against the RiverDogs after earning a win last time out in relief against Down East. Cruz has been lights out in the month of May covering 8 innings in two outings allowing just 1 run on 3 hits with 10 strikeots.

LAST OUTING (5/11 @ DE): Appeared out of the bullpen a dealt 4 innings against the Wood Ducks and finished the game to earn the victory in a 4-2 win over Down East. Allowed just three base runners during his time on the mound while striking out a season-high of six.

vs. CHARLESTON: This will be the first time Cruz will face the Charleston RiverDogs.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: At 18 years old, Deivy Cruz was a bright spot in the in the Orioles organization pitching most of the season in Delmarva. He began in the FCL and made 3 starts that covered 13 innings, striking out 17 with 4 earned run allowed. Was moved up to the Shorebirds on June 21 and would appear in 13 games, 12 starts where he finished with an ERA of 4.02 and a 2-5 record. Opponents hit .224 against Cruz as he struck out 52 with 37 walks during his time in Delmarva. He was very effective in his first two months in a Shorebird uniform as he allowed just 3 earned runs across his first 6 starts that covered 26.1 innings in June & July.



MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019. He is the brother of current Oakland A's Outfielder J.J. Bleday.

Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.
