SHRIMP COME FROM BEHIND AGAIN, WIN 7-6

The Jumbo Shrimp scored two in the eighth, two in the ninth and two in the 10th to rally by the Redbirds Thursday in a 7-6 victory. After a Jacksonville run in the first, Memphis methodically built a 5-1 lead. The Jumbo Shrimp halved that advantage in the eighth before **Matthew Etzel** hit a game-tying two-run home run in the ninth inning. In the 10th, **Graham Pauley** put Jacksonville ahead with a two-run home run. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen worked 6.0 innings, ceding only two runs, one earned. **Kemp Alderman** matched a career-high with four hits.

APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp lost for the eighth time in 11 games on April 30 at Durham, dropping the club a season-high 6.0 games out of first place in the International League. Jacksonville has rattled off nine wins in the last 12 games, including five in a row, cutting their deficit in the standings to just 2.0 games. Over these last 12 games, the Shrimp have outscored their opponents 87-38 (+49). The club is collectively hitting .285/.360/.458/.818 while holding their opponents to a .223/.333/.374/.707 line. Jacksonville has out-hit their opponents 125-86 over these last 12 games.

'PEN PALS

The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen surrendered 12 runs in 7.0 innings on May 7 in a 16-1 loss to Charlotte. In the six games since, the club's relief pitching has been nothing short of excellent. During this stretch, Jacksonville relievers have combined to yield only five runs, four earned, on 15 hits (4.5 H/9) in 30.1 innings for a 1.19 ERA. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined to strike out 33 (9.8 K/9) against 14 walks (4.2 BB/9) during this six-game stretch.

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry struggled significantly over the 2025 season's first 33 games, going just 13-for-103 (.126/.229/.223/.452) at the plate with 35 strikeouts in 119 plate appearances (29.4 percent). The Queens Creek, Ariz., has been truly excellent since that point. Over his last 121 Triple-A games, Berry is batting .311/.399/.452/.851, cutting his strikeout rate by more than half at 13.9 percent with just 68 over 484 plate appearances. Berry ranks tied for ninth in the IL in OBP (.424, tied for ninth in steals (13) and 11th in average (.322).

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

Jacksonville has yielded the second-fewest runs (182) in Triple-A while posting the level's third-best ERA (4.02). While the club leads all Triple-A staffs in strikeouts (453), the Jumbo Shrimp have also done a phenomenal job at turning batted balls put into play into outs; Jacksonville ranks second in Triple-A by turning 72.7 percent of balls put into play into outs. Only two clubs have recorded a rate of at least 71 percent this season.

ON THE OFFENSIVE

Heading into play on April 22, Jacksonville had scored at least five runs in a contest just three times in 22 affairs, ranking last in Triple-A in runs (68, 3.1 per game) and each slash line category (.186/.296/.282/.578). The Jumbo Shrimp have now plated at least five runs 15 times in the 20 games since. During this stretch, the club ranks tied for third in Triple-A in runs (139, 7.0 per game). They also place in the top 13 in doubles (T-2nd, 45), hits (6th, 203), average (7th, .281), OBP (12th, .361), slugging (12th, .445) and OPS (12th, .806). Jacksonville was hitting just .166 with runners in scoring position over the first 22 games; they are 63-for-212 (.297) in those situations over the last 20 contests.

KEMPIRE STATE OF MIND

Jacksonville outfielder **Kemp Alderman** got off to a slow start to the season. Through his first 11 games, Alderman was just 5-for-35 (.143/.318/.200/.518) with only one triple, one RBI, eight walks, seven runs and 18 strikeouts over 44 plate appearances (40.9 percent strikeout rate). The Decatur, Miss., native has surged since then; Over his last 27 games, Alderman is a scorching 39-for-108 (.361/.410/.602/1.012) with five doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBIs, five walks and 20 runs scored. He ranks tied for tied for 10th in the IL in hits (44), tied for 14th in runs (27) and 21st in average (.308).

SHRIMP BITES

After not having a comeback win of at least four runs all season leading into this series at Memphis, Jacksonville has two such victories in the last three games... Just five of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 14 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Fifteen of the club's previous 17 had been determined by no more than three runs.

ABOUT BRADLEY

-Blalock was high school teammates with fellow future major leaguer Parker Meadows at Grayson High School (Loganville, Ga.). The Boston Red Sox selected Blalock in the 32nd round of the 2019 MLB draft.

-After not playing in a game in 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Blalock wound up missing all of the 2022 season due to Tommy John surgery.

-The Red Sox traded Blalock on August 1, 2023 to Milwaukee for infielder Luis Urias.

-Blalock found Kevin Gausman's split change on the internet and used the grip as a model for himself. He liked the pitch's versatility as an option to both righties and lefties and the fact that it is both a "velocity and movement separator."
