Opening Day 2025

YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 7-2. In the top of the third, Victor Bericoto reached on a two-out walk and came around to score on a double by **Jairo Pomares**. The Flying Squirrels stretched the lead to 4-0 in the fourth with an RBI single by **Zach Morgan**, a bunt by **Vaun Brown** and a force-out flied into by Bericoto. **Wil Jensen** threw four innings with six strikeouts and allowed one unearned run, which scored on a balk in the fourth. In the top of the fifth, **Matt Higgins** hit a solo homer for his first Double-A home run. Jase Bowen responded with a solo homer in the fifth to close the score to 5-2. In the top of the eighth, **Jimmy Glowenke** drove a two-run double to open a 7-2 lead. **Trent Harris** threw two scoreless innings to pick up his first Double-A win. **Mat Olsen** and **Cameron Cotter** each pitched a scoreless inning to end the game.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve in the finale of a six-game series and the final game of the 2024 season. The Flying Squirrels dropped four-of-six against the Curve at The Diamond from June 4-9. From July 30-August 4 in their other visit to PNG Field this year, the Flying Squirrels dropped the first four games of the series before winning the last two. The Curve won four-of-six at The Diamond from August 20-25.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** snapped a three-game losing streak on Saturday night. Prior to the streak, the Flying Squirrels had won six-of-seven, including the first five games of last week's series against Akron. In their last 24 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .270 (221-for-820) and averaging 9.2 hits per game (221 total), also the best in the league, and averaging 4.9 runs per game (118 total).

**THE CURVE** are 12-5 in their last 17 games dating back to August 27, including a six-game sweep against the Fisher Cats from August 27-September 1. The Altoona roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including INF Terrmarr Johnson (No. 4), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 7), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 18), OF Jase Bowen (No. 27) and OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes four Altoona players, including Johnson (No. 3), Solometo (No. 7), Barco (No. 8) and Cheng (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Jack Choate makes his eighth Double-A start and his third against the Curve. In the series opener on Tuesday. Choate threw five innings and allowed two runs in a winning decision. He also pitched at The Diamond against the Curve on August 23 and struck out six batters in four innings, allowing two runs. Choate was promoted from High-A Eugene on August 1. With the Emeralds, he went 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). For the season, Choate ranks sixth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (122). Choate was selected in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of NCAA DII Assumption University in Massachusetts. FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Jacob Deese makes his first Double-A start and his fifth appearance. In his most recent outing, Deese threw three scoreless innings on September 6 at Hartford. Deese has spent most of the season with High-A Greens-boro, going 2-4 with a 6.64 ERA in 30 outings. He was selected in the 17th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Flying Squirrels have turned 94 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 21 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on August 16 with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 21 GIDPs this year are tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history, trailing only 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 71 games dating back to June 6, Victor Bericoto is hitting .294 (83-for-282) with seven homers, 17 doubles, 16 walks and 46 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. Dating back to August 24, Bericoto has homered three times in his last 12 games including a grand slam on September 1 at Erie. Last Thursday, he hit the second walk-off hit of his Flying Squirrels career, a 10th-inning single to beat Akron, 7-6. Through Tuesday, Bericoto had an RBI in seven consecutive games, tied for the longest streak by a player in the Eastern League this season and tied for the longest in franchise history, even with a seven-game streak by **Clay Timpner** from April 28-May 10, 2010. He has driven in at least one run in nine-of-his-

**GO, DIEGO, GO!:** Diego Velasquez is batting .377 (23-for-61) in his last 17 games dating back to August 22, including a four-hit game that day against Altoona. He has 16 hits in his last 12 games played with five RBIs. Among Giants full-season minor leaguers, Velasquez ranks fourth in batting average (.288), fourth in OBP (.369), sixth in OPS (.754), 10th in SLG (.385), third in hits (119), tied for seventh in triples (4), 10th in walks (48), ninth in total bases (159) and fifth in stolen bases (21).

HOWELL AT THE MOON: Carter Howell has collected 20 hits in his last 18 games since August 21, batting .270 (20-for-74) with a double, a triple and 11 runs scored. In the Eastern League this season, Howell is ranked first in doubles (30), first in triples (7), fourth in hits (121), fifth in extra-base hits (39) and seventh in total bases (174). His seven triples are tied for fourth-most in a season in franchise history. Last Thursday, he was named the 2024 Flying Squirrels Player of the Year.

PACKING THE HOUSE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels are ninth in average attendance. In 2022 and 2023, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance for the first times in franchise history. This year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history.

**BOULEVARD TO THE BAY:** This season, 13 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and** Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Aviia (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023), Grant McCray (2024) and Sandro Fabian (2021). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-24 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers), Fabian (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. that season's Richmond roster.

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: The have been 64 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, a new franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 34 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 32 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Three of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including 1B **Bryce Eldridge** (No. 1), LHP **Jack Choate** (No. 19) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 22). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Eldridge (No. 1), Velasquez (No. 15) and Choate (No. 19).
