High-A Wilmington scored a combined 19 runs on the way to a doubleheader sweep over Jersey Shore (PHI) yesterday...1B **JACOB WALSH** drove in six runs, including a grand slam and a two-run double to finish 2-for-4.

FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS: The Rochester Red Wings used a four-run fourth inning to top the Buffalo Bisons, 5-3, on Friday for their third-straight win against their I-90 rival to the west. The win, along with the help of the Columbus Clippers beating the Indianapolis Indians, put the Red Wings in a tie for first place in the International League second-half standings...two Red Wings relievers combined for 5.1 innings of one-run ball while 1B **LIOVER PEGUERO** hit a base-clearing double in the winning effort...the Red Wings look to win four-straight and pick up their 15th series win of the season tonight, sending LHP **JARED SIMPSON** to the mound against Bisons RHP Austin Marozas...

R Rochester is now 19-6 on Friday and Saturday night home games this season.

SEEING (JA)RED: LHP **JARED SIMPSON** will take the ball for the 11th time with the Red Wings tonight (7th GS), having tossed nine consecutive scoreless appearances (including all 6 GS) dating back to 7/26...the southpaw delivered 3.0 scoreless innings on one hit in his previous outing in Omaha on 8/23, while striking out a pair and walking one...he has allowed just five hits across 16.2 innings across the streak, the fewest of any Triple-A pitcher with at least 15.0 innings pitched over that span...he is also the only pitcher in Triple-A, and one of three in Minor League Baseball, to toss at least 15.0 frames without allowing an earned run over that stretch, while ranking third in hits-per-nine (2.70) and 12th in WHIP (0.72)...the Iowa native has yet to allow a run and has surrendered just two hits in 71 innings across four appearances (3 GS) at ESL Ballpark, with a .080 BAA and 0.68 WHIP...

R Among all Nationals Minor League pitchers with at least 50.0 innings pitched this season, Simpson leads in ERA (1.73) and boasts the lowest opponents BABIP (.233), highest ground ball percentage (59.1), and ranks third in K% (29.5).

LI-OVER THE MOON: 1B **LIOVER PEGUERO** reached safely three times Friday, going 2-for-3 with a walk, a stolen base, and a bases-clearing double that erased a 2-1 deficit and put Rochester ahead for good, 4-2...it marked his first multi-hit game as a Red Wing and his 23rd double of the season...over his last three games, Peguero is batting .500 (4-for-8, 1st in IL min. 8 AB) with a 1.636 OPS (2nd, min. 10 PA) and five RBI (T-2nd)...he is now 5-for-9 (.556) with three doubles, one homer and 12 RBI with the bases loaded between Rochester and Lehigh Valley this season...the stolen base was his ninth of the season in nine attempts, fifth-most in the IL among runners that have not been caught...

R he is the second Red Wings first baseman to log a stolen base this season (**YOHANDY MORALES** 3x).

THE CHAMP(LAIN) IS HERE: RHP **CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN** earned his eighth win Friday night after working 4.1 innings in relief, allowing one run on two hits with six strikeouts...the six punchouts moved him to exactly 250 in his Triple-A career...over his last three outings since 8/14, Champlain owns a 1.76 ERA (1st in IL, min. 15.0 IP), a .173 opponent average and 0.91 WHIP (both 2nd)...his eight wins are a Triple-A career high, doubling his previous best, and are tied for fourth-most in the International League...

R Among IL pitchers with at least 100.0 innings this season, Champlain ranks second in ERA (3.76) and WHIP (1.07), while his 1.80 BB/9 and 14.40 pitches per inning both lead the group.

GRAB YOUR YOYO YO-YO: DH **YOHANDY MORALES** put together his second-straight multi-hit performance last night, going 2-for-4 with a pair of singles, a run scored, and his sixth stolen base of the season...since 8/22, Morales is batting .375 (T-6th in IL, min. 20 AB) with nine hits (T-3rd) and seven runs (T-4th)...his 81 runs this season rank second in the International League and sit four shy of his career-high 85 between Harrisburg and Rochester in 2025...in 10 games against Buffalo this season, the Miami product is hitting .389 (14-for-36) with a homer, a .395 OBP and 17 total bases.

[CAY]N'T STOP, WON'T STOP: 3B **CAYDEN WALLACE** tacked on two more RBI and a run scored in his 1-for-4 night at the plate Friday...his RBI-double was part of Rochester's four-run fourth inning, where the Arkansas native would soon find himself crossing home plate as well...his second RBI came in the following inning on a groundout that scored **PHILLIP GLASSER** from third...the two-RBI performance marked the sixth consecutive game the former Razorback has recorded an RBI, giving him a share of the longest active streak in the International League...

R Wallace has recorded hits in 17 of his last 19 games since 8/6, while posting five multi-hit games in his last eight outings since 8/20.

- Slated to make his seventh start and 11th appearance with Rochester this season, the southpaw is in search of his 10th consecutive appearance without allowing a run.
- Overall this season, the lefty holds a 1.02 ERA, 0.91 WHIP, and a .117 BAA in 17.2 innings of work with Rochester.
- Transferred to Rochester for his Triple-A debut on 7/19, after spending the entire season with Double-A Harrisburg...logged 33 appearances (3 GS, first of pro career) with a 2.04 ERA (9 ER/39.2 IP), while striking out 48 with a 1.36 WHIP and .182 BAA.
- At the time of his promotion, ranked sixth among all Eastern League pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) in ERA and T-12th in BAA...led all Harrisburg pitchers in appearances.
- Did not allow an earned run through 10 appearances dating from 6/16 to 7/17, and 16 of his last 17 since 5/19...boasts a 0.82 ERA (2 ER/22.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and .137 BAA since 5/19.
- Has appeared in 95 career games (9 GS) with a 3.60 ERA (49 ER/122.2 IP), 154 strikeouts, 99 walks, and a .182 BAA.

Entering his sixth professional season, first with the Nationals organization after signing as a Minor League free agent on 3/31/2026...originally selected by New York-AL in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Southern California...named Texas League Pitcher of the Week with Northwest Arkansas on 5/19/2024 and 7/30/2023...named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week with Quad City on May 7, 2023.

- Ranks second among qualified International League pitchers in ERA (3.76) and WHIP (1.07), third in opponent batting average (.235), T-3rd in innings pitched (115.0), and fourth in winning percentage (.615).
- Over his last two starts, has posted a 1.64 ERA (2 ER/11.0 IP), 0.82 WHIP and seven hits allowed, with six strikeouts and two walks.
- Across four Saturday games this season (3 GS), the 27-year-old is 2-0 with a 2.75 ERA (6 ER/19.2 IP), a 0.56 WHIP, .138 BAA, and a BB/9 of 0.92.
- Recorded his 500th career strikeout on 6/9 vs. Worcester.
- Made his 100th career start in game two of a doubleheader on 4/17 vs. Buffalo.
- Began the 2026 season with Double-A Harrisburg...transferred to Triple-A Rochester on 4/4 before appearing in a game.
- Made 29 appearances (25 GS) with Triple-A Omaha in 2025...went 4-9 with a 7.84 ERA (104 ER/119.1 IP), while compiling 100 strikeouts against 51 walks...ranked second among all Royals Minor League pitchers in games started, fourth in innings pitched, and T-9th in strikeouts.

- Leads the Red Wings with 101 strikeouts this season.
- Optioned to Rochester on 8/4 after his second Major League stint of the season...allowed just one hit in his final four appearances with Washington.
- Since returning to Rochester on 8/4, has allowed one earned run across 13.2 innings in seven appearances, good for a 0.66 ERA and 0.80 WHIP, with 25 strikeouts and four walks.
- Recalled by Washington on 4/24 for his MLB debut the same day at Chicago-AL...allowed two earned on two hits across 2.0 innings of relief, striking out one and walking four.
- Has recorded 101 strikeouts in 65.0 innings with Rochester, an average of 13.98 per nine innings.
- Named Nationals Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2025 with a 6-7 record, 3.28 ERA (49 ER/134.1 IP), 135 strikeouts, and 55 walks across 27 games (26 GS) between High-A Wilmington, Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester, setting career marks in nearly every category.
- Began the 2025 season with High-A Wilmington...transferred to Double-A Harrisburg on 5/23 and Triple-A Rochester on 8/6.
- Matched his career-high three times with 7.0 innings pitched (4/23, 5/17, 6/19)...set a career-high with 10 strikeouts in game one of a doubleheader on 4/12 against Hub City (TEX).

- Opened the season with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...had his contract selected on 5/18...was optioned on 5/22, recalled on 6/30, optioned on 7/2 and recalled on 8/1 before being traded to Washington on 8/3.
- Made his Nationals debut on 8/5 at PHI (0.1 IP, 2 H, ER, BB, SO)...earned his first career hold on 8/7 vs. CIN (1.0 IP, BB, SO).
- Owens the fastest pitch (102.0 mph) by a Nationals pitcher in the Statcast Era (2015-pres.).
- Opponents hit .167 (3-for-18, 2B) in four games out of NYY's bullpen in his first MLB season.
- Made his MLB debut on 5/20 vs. Toronto, tossing 2.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts.
- Recorded 52 strikeouts in 35.2 innings with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, going 7-3 with four saves and a 3.53 ERA in 31 appearances.
