- Zach Thornton went 6 shutout innings for St. Lucie, helping the Mets to a 8-0 shutout over the Blue Jays on Saturday night at TD Balloark.
- Nolan Perry, Dunedin's starter, matched Thornton's shutout effort for 4.1 innings, without allowing a hit. After Perry struck out the first batter of the fifth, he exited.
- St. Lucie rallied against Felipe Bello, scoring twice on two hits and three walks, including a bases loaded free pass.
- Rehabbing right hander TJ Brock worked a 1-2-3 6th inning for the Jays, while Damiano Palmegiani and Peyton Williams both collected singles in the contest.
- The Mets pulled away in the late stages, scoring six runs in the final three innings.

#### **OUTSTANDING, STANIFER**

Blue Jays starting pitcher Gage Stanifer appears to have turned a corner on his season, allowing just two earned runs in 12 innings in his last three starts. Last week at Bradenton, Stanifer went five full innings for the first time this season, striking out a season-high seven. In his first two starts, Stanifer allowed 8 earned runs in 4.2 frames.

#### COMFORTABLE WHEN IT'S CLOSE

Dunedin has played 18 one-run games this season, splitting them at 9-9. The Jays have won six of their last eight one-run contests. 34 of the Blue Jays 50 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 18-17 record in those games.

#### NIGHT AND DAY DIFFERENCE

The Blue Jays have hit significantly better in day games (.252 in 9 games) than night games (.210 in 41 games). Manuel Beltre is hitting .308 (12-39) in eight day contests. On the other side of the scorebook, Dunedin pitching has struggled during the day, surrendering a 6.30 ERA, compared to a 3.87 mark in night games. Dunedin is 4-4 playing during the day.

#### **RELYING ON RELIEF**

Much of the Blue Jays' success this season has largely hinged on its bullpen, with distinct differences in relief performance in wins and losses. In wins, Jays relievers have pitched to a 3.14 ERA with a 1.22 WHIP. In losses, the bullpen has accumulated a 6.04 ERA with a 1.80 WHIP. The bullpen allowed all eight earned runs in last night's game.

#### REHAB CITY, USA

With Peyton Williams, Damiano Palmegiani and TJ Brock assigned to the D-Jays this week, Dunedin has hosted nine MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. MLB rehabbers Alek Manoah and Erik Swanson both pitched on April 7 against Lakeland.

#### **JAYS JUICE**

After going without a home run in back-to-back games, the Blue Jays are second in the FSL with 38 homers. The team trails Modesto by four homers for the Single-A lead. Dunedin has homered in 15 of their last 19 games. Across that stretch, 10 different players have gone deep. Friday night's loss snapped a streak of seven straight games with a home run.

#### APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY HOMERS

After going 10-12 in April, Dunedin played to a 15-12 record in May, thanks in part to a surge in power. The Blue Jays belted 27 home runs in May - the most in all of Single-A, and six more than the next-closest FSL team (Clearwater, 21). The month was highlighted by two lengthy win streaks - a six-gamer from 5/15 to 5/21, and a five-game stretch from 5/25 to 5/30. The streaks followed a slow start, as the Jays lost 7 of the first 10 games of the month.

#### PALMEGIANI PARTY

Damiano Palmegiani, the Blue Jays No. 14 prospect, joined the Blue Jays last night on a rehab assignment from AAA-Buffalo. Palmegiani played 56 games with Dunedin in 2022, hitting .256 with 11 homers before his promotion to A+ Vancouver. Palmegiani belted 23 homers in 2023 between AA-New Hampshire and AAA-Buffalo.

#### WELCOME BACK, WILLIAMS

First baseman Peyton Williams began a rehab assignment with the D-Jays this week. Williams, a 2022 7th round draft pick, has spent parts of the last two seasons with Dunedin, hitting .274 with 7 homers in 45 games. He was selected as the league's best first baseman according to Baseball America's survey of FSL coaches last season. Williams is the seventh minor or major league rehabber to appear in Dunedin this season.
