Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the fifth-of-18 matchups this season between the teams, and fifth-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Hartford won the 2024 season-series over Reading 10-8. Following this week, the Fightin Phils go to Hartford from July 29-August 3 and Sept. 2-7. Hartford leads the season-series 3-1.

Game 65 Recap

A late push from the Fightin Phils offense wasn't enough as Reading fell 8-5 to Hartford on Friday night, falling down 3-1 in this week's series with the Yard Goats. Mitch Neunborn started and allowed five runs on five hits over 4.1 innings, with a walk and three strikeouts. Neunborn was tagged for a run in the third, two in the fourth and two in the fifth. Reading scored a run in the fourth on an Alex Binelas sac fly and one in the sixth on a Hendry Mendez home run. The Fightin Phils cut it to a 7-5 deficit with three runs in the eighth, but Hartford scored a run off Nelson Alvarez in the ninth to make it 8-5, and sent Reading down quietly in the ninth. Carson DeMartini had two hits, including a triple and Hendry Mendez hit for the cycle in the loss.

Hendry Making History

It is believed that Hendry Mendez hit for the first cycle in R-Phils history on Friday night. Mendez had four hits, three runs and three RBI. He hit a triple in his first at bat, then singled his next time up. Mendez then launched his fifth home run of the season in the sixth inning. Then, Mendez stepped up in the bottom of the eighth a double shy of the cycle, and he lined a 3-1 pitch to right-center field and stopped at second base to complete the historic feat. Dating back to 2005 (as far back as MLB's research tool keeps MiLB stats), no R-Phil has hit a cycle. Records prior to 2005 show no prior cycles were ever hit by an R-Phil, but data is incomplete. But, it is believed that Mendez now holds the distinction of the first cycle in R-Phils history, dating back to 1967.

Binelas Brings the Boom

Alex Binelas stayed red-hot with two home runs on Thursday night. It was the fourth multi-homer game in Binelas' career and the first since June 22, 2023, when he did it with Portland, against Reading, at Hadlock Field. His two home runs marked the fourth multi-homer game hit by a R-Phil this season, and the second in three days, as Caleb Ricketts had two home runs on Tuesday against Hartford.

Hammering Homers

The Fightin Phils have launched 22 home runs since the start of June. That is a mark that is most in the Eastern League, and three ahead of second place Erie and Somerset, who have 19. Reading ranks tied for third in the league in home runs this season with 55.

Trip Trip Triples

Since June 10 (10 games), the Fightin Phils have hit five triples, a mark that is tied for second in the Eastern League over that stretch and trails first-place Erie by one. Since the 10th, Hendry Mendez has hit three triples, a mark tied for first in the Eastern League over that stretch with Binghamton's Jett Williams.

Welcome Back Caleb

After missing two months on the injured list, Caleb Ricketts made his return to the Reading lineup in a big way on Tuesday night. The 25-year old catcher launched two home runs and drove in three runs in the win. His two home runs marked the second two home run game of his career, with the last coming on June 6, 2024, against Harrisburg at FirstEnergy Stadium. It marked the third two home run game of the season for a Reading player, with the other two being Robert Moore on Apr. 15 vs Binghamton and Paul McIntosh on June 7 at Harrisburg.

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller continues to be a threat on the base paths. After two-more stolen bases last Wednesday night, Miller is second in the Eastern League with 24 stolen bases. In the Phillies organization, Miller is tied for second with Carson DeMartini and Justin Crawford at 24 stolen bases, behind Lehigh Valley's Oscar Mercado, who has 27.

Hey Hartford

Hartford enters tonight with a 35-32 record, nine-games back of Northeast Division first half champion Binghamton. The Yard Goats dropped four-of-six against Akron last week, including losing the final three games. After this week, Hartford returns home to face New Hampshire. Hartford's roster features eight of Colorado's top-30 prospects: Cole Carrigg (2), Seam Sullivan (8), Benny Montgomery (13), Kyle Karros (18), Wlinton Herrera (20), Jack Mahoney (24), Dylan Jorge (27) and Connor Staine (30).

Goat on the Bump

Righty, and Rockies' No. 24 prospect Jack Mahoney makes the start tonight for Hartford. Over 11 starts this season, Mahoney is 0-3, with a 6.59 ERA (31 ER, 42.1 IP). Mahoney went three innings last Sunday against Akron, allowing one run on three hits, with two strikeouts, in a no-decision. He split 2024 between Fresno (A) and Spokane (A+), combining to go 6-7, with a 3.90 ERA over 23 appearances and 22 starts. Mahoney began his pro career in 2023, making two appearances (2.0 IP) for the ACL-Rockies (ROK). The 23-year old was a third round pick by Colorado out of South Carolina in 2023. Mahoney pitched for the Gamecocks in 2021 and '23.

King turned in his fifth-straight outing over five innings, as he proves to be a reliable arm in Reading's rotation. He matched a season-high with five strikeouts for the third-straight outing. King was quickly roughed up for three runs in the top of the first inning, but settled in quickly with back-to-back zeroes in the second and third frames. After allowing another tally in the fourth, King finished strong with two-more scoreless innings in the fifth and sixth. After the top of the sixth, the game was tied at four, then Reading scored three in the bottom of the sixth to give King the win before the game was called due to rain in the top of the seventh. King was relieved by Jack Dallas in the top of the seventh inning.

2025 Season:

- After not starting, nor pitching more than 2.0 IP in a game prior to this season, King has started 10-of-12 games this season and has gone over two innings in each outing
- First win of season came on Apr. 13 at Somerset when he pitched in relief (3.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 5 SO)
- Tossed a season and career-high six innings twice in back-to-back starts: May 22 at Portland and May 29 vs Erie
- On May 22 at Portland: 6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 3 SO
- Allowed a season and career-high 11 hits May 29 vs Erie over six innings
- Has allowed a career-high three home runs three times this season: May 2 vs HBG, May 17 vs NH and May 29 vs ERI
- Went five-shutout innings Apr. 24 at Portland
- Issued a career-high three walks June 9 at Harrisburg
- Struck out a season/career-high five batters four times this season, including back-to-back starts on June 3 & 8 at Harrisburg
- Earned second win of season, while matching season-high with six innings and five strikeouts on June 14 vs New Hampshire
- Has gone 5+ innings in his five four starts and six of his last seven starts on the mound
- Over seven away games, has a 3.00 ERA (11 ER, 33.0 IP), which is compared to a 8.10 ERA (21 ER, 23.1 IP) over five home contests; also 11-of-13 home runs have been allowed at home
- Posted a 3.60 ERA (6 ER, 15.0 IP) in four April outings and a 7.11 ERA (20 ER, 25.1 IP) across five May appearances (all starts); has a 3.38 ERA (6 ER, 16.0 IP) over three June starts
- With RISP, opposing hitters slashing .183/.190/.267 (.457 OPS)
- Has allowed the most home runs (13) of any pitcher in the Eastern League, leading second place by four home runs

2024 Season:

- Spent majority of season with Jersey Shore (A+), making 31 appearances out of the bullpen
- On 7-day IL (oblique strain) from June 10 through July 23, which included rehab appearances with Clearwater (A) and FCL-Phillies (ROK)
- Promoted to Reading (AA) on Sept. 11, making one relief appearance prior to end of season
- After compiling a 4.58 ERA (19.2 IP, 10 ER) over first 18 appearances, finished season with 3.48 ERA (20.2 IP, 8 ER) over final 15 outings
- Held LHH to .175/.224/.213 (.437 OPS) slash line, while RHH hit .293 (22-75) against
