#### By the Numbers

The Captains lead the MWL and rank 2<sup>nd</sup> in High-A with 23 home runs this season. Lake County has 3 HR so far this series, most recently a 2-run homer from OF Alfonsin Rosario and a solo homer from OF Jaison Chourio on Wednesday night.

The Captains lead the MWL and rank 2<sup>nd</sup> in High-A with 23 the 7th instance of a franchise winning consecutive MWL titles.

LHP Josh Hartle, tonight's Captains Game 1 starter, pitched 8 combined scoreless innings across 2 starts at Fort Wayne last week The southpaw threw 11 K to just 2 BB in these starts, and was the only Midwest League pitcher with 10+ K last week.

2 Lake County has recorded 12 stolen bases as a team in the first 3 games of this week's series, going 12-for-13 on the basepaths so far. <u>The Captains led MiLB with an 86.8% stolen base percentage last season.</u>

#### **CAPTAINS LOG**

LAST TIME OUT: Lake County had the winning run at the plate in the bottom of the 9th inning, but Great Lakes survived the Captains' late-game rally in a 3-1 Lake County defeat. The Captains went 1-for-11 with runners in scoring position on Thursday night.

TINCHER'S TERRIFIC GAME: C Johnny Tincher went 2-for-3 with a pair of singles, a walk, and a stolen base at the plate, while catching 2 runners stealing defensively. He also helped plate Lake County's only run of the night when he reached on a Loons throwing error in the bottom of the 8th inning.

The 2023 11th-round pick out of Washington is batting .360 with 9 H, 2 2B, and 6 RBI in his first 8 games this year.

TULLOCH'S SCORELESS OUTING: LHP Adam
Tulloch pitched 3 scoreless innings of relief out of the
Captains bullpen, throwing 5 strikeouts. The 2022
15th-round pick out of Arizona State has now
thrown a combined 11 strikeouts over his last two
outings.

DEVERS EXTENDS HIS STREAK: SS Jose Devers extended his hitting streak to 6 games with an infield single in the bottom of the 5<sup>th</sup> inning. The 21-year-old is batting .310 with 9 H, 4 2B, 2 HR, 3 RBI, 3 SB, a .655 SLG, and a .965 OPS.

DEFEND THE 'SHIP: This season, the Captains are ooking to win back-to-back Midwest League Championships. Lake County will look to record the 7th instance of a franchise winning consecutive MWL titles.

#### **TRENDS & NOTABLES**

JOSE'S HOT START: After winning the 2024 Midwest League Championship with Lake County, SS Jose Devers has excelled early to begin the 2025 campaign. The Samana, DR native leads the Midwest League with: 13 XBH, 42 TB, 8 2B (tied), and 5 HR (tied), while also ranking top-10 in: SLG (.592, 2<sup>nd</sup>), OPS (.934, 9<sup>th</sup>), SB (7, T-9<sup>th</sup>). After hitting 7 HR in 102 games with the Captains last year, Devers already has 5 HR in his first 17 games this season.

ADVINCULA'S AT IT AGAIN: After playing a significant part in the Captains' 2024 Midwest League Championship run, OF Jonah Advincula is off to a strong start in 2025. The 2023 8th-round pick out of Washington State is tied for the Midwest League lead with 10 SB. while batting .351 with a .479 OBP and a .965 OPS. He has recorded at least 1 SB in each of his last 4 games.

ALFONSIN'S AWESOME OFFENSE: OF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 25 Cleveland prospect, has become one of the Midwest League's premier hitters to begin his High-A career. The 20-year-old leads the Midwest League with a .635 SLG, and 1.021 OPS, while ranking top-10 in: HR (4, T-3<sup>rd</sup>), AVG (.327, 4<sup>th</sup>), RBI (13, T-9<sup>th</sup>), XBH (8, T-10<sup>th</sup>), and TB (33, T-10<sup>th</sup>). Rosario was the only Single-A player with 15+ HR, 70+ RBI, and 20+ SB last year with Single-A Myrtle Beach (CHC).

JASIAK'S SCORELESS STRETCH: RHP Jack Jasiak is off to an impressive start to begin his High-A career. The 2022 12th-round pick out of South Florida has yet to allow a run in his first 4 appearances for Lake County, spinning 10.1 consecutive scoreless innings during this span. Jasiak is 1 of just 3 MiLB pitchers with 10+ IP, 1-orfewer walks, and 0 R allowed this season.

TUGBOAT CRUISE: After being named a 2024 Midwest League All-Star, LHP Matt Wilkinson continues to fare well for Lake County's pitching staff. The southpaw is tied for the Midwest League lead with 4 GS and T-5<sup>th</sup> with 22 K. Last year, Wilkinson led MiLB with an average of 13.20 K/9 and a 37.6% strikeout percentage across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, while ranking 2<sup>nd</sup> in MiLB with: 174 K, a 1.90 ERA, a .169 opposing AVG, and a 0.91 WHIP.

RAKE COUNTY IS BACK: Lake County has had a strong offensive start so far this year. Through their first 18 games of the season, the Captains lead the MWL and rank 2nd in High-A in HR (23) and SLG (.414). Additionally, the Captains rank top-5 in High-A in: OPS (.770, 4th), and TB (246, T-5th).

WELCOME BACK, OMIRI: On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would return for his 3rd season as Lake County's skipper. He is now the longest-tenured manager in Captains history, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship for Lake County (Ted Kubiak, 2010). With a 152-125 (.549) record at the helm, Santos is 19 victories away from becoming the winningest manager in Captains history.



## **BIO**

**Mokoro** (wears #43) enters her first season as Lake County's Bat Dog, and first season with the Guardians organization. The 1-year-old Chocolate Labrador Retriever is owned and trained by **Victoria Brody**. **Brody** is a professional dog trainer who started Mission Empawthy, LLC, a local dog training company which focuses on specializing in psychiatric service dogs for those whose disabilities aren't always visible. **Mokoro will retrieve bats** and balls for the Captains alongside Brody at all Thursday home games this season!

**Mokoro** is named after a type of dugout canoe found in Botswana. These vessels, which usually carry 1-2 passengers, are commonly used to navigate the Okavango Delta for both transport and game viewing safaris. While mekoro (plural form of "mokoro") used to primarily be made from Jackalberry, Mangosteen, and Sausage trees, they are now mainly made from fiberglass.

**LAST TIME OUT:** LHP **Josh Hartle** (ND) worked 4 scoreless innings in his 2<sup>nd</sup> start of the week at Fort Wayne on Sunday, April 20. The southpaw allowed just 3 hits and 1 walk, while throwing 5 strikeouts in 57 pitches (37 strikes).

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Hartle is rated as a Top 30 Guardians prospect by both *MLB Pipeline* (No. 22) and *Baseball America* (No. 25). *MLB Pipeline on Hartle:* "At his best, Hartle exhibits advanced feel for a plus slider, solid cutter and average fastball and changeup. His heater sat at 89-92 mph and topped out at 94 with less life and command last spring, and he became reluctant to throw it when it got pounded. His low-80s slider and upper-80s cutter weren't as sharp as in the past, and his sinking mid-80s changeup rarely landed in the zone." *Baseball America on Hartle:* "Hartle is an interesting project for Cleveland's savvy pitching development machine. If his velocity bounces back, he has the strike-throwing acumen and polish to move quickly and profile as a back-of-the-rotation starter."

**CAPTAIN OF THE WEEK: Hartle** was named the second 2025 Captain of the Week, presented by Official League on April 21. Across 2 starts on April 15 and April 20 at Fort Wayne, the left-hander allowed just 1 unearned run and throwing 11 K to just 2 BB in 8 combined innings of work. For the week of April 15 through 20, Hartle was the only Midwest League pitcher to throw double-digit strikeouts, and 1 of just 2 to make 2 starts.

**READY TO LEARN GUARDS BALL:** On Dec. 10, 2024, **Hartle** was traded to the Cleveland Guardians from the Pittsburgh Pirates. He was traded to Cleveland along with fellow Captains LHP **Michael Kennedy** and current Guardians RHP **Luis Ortiz** in exchange for INF **Spencer Horwitz**.

**DEMON DEACON:** A 3<sup>rd</sup>-round pick in 2024, **Hartle** was a highly touted prospect coming out of Wake Forest, one of the country's premier Division I baseball programs. *The 2023 Golden Spikes Award Semifinalist enjoyed a stellar career in Winston-Salem, earning First Team All-ACC honors in 2023, and 2024 Preseason First Team All-American honors by D1 Baseball and Perfect Game. In four years as a starter, Hartle racked up 24 wins across 246.2 IP. He also struck out 275 batters in his career, including a 140-strikeout season in 2023 that ranked fifth in the nation and second in program history. Hartle was teammates at Wake Forest with RHPs Chase Burns (currently pitching for Dayton Dragons) and Rhett Lowder, <i>MLB Pipeline*'s top two Cincinnati Reds prospects, and 1B **Nick Kurtz**, *MLB Pipeline*'s No. 1 Athletics prospect.

**GATORADE:** Following a dominant senior year in 2021 at Reagan High School (Pfafftown, NC), **Hartle** was awarded Gatorade Player of the Year for the state of North Carolina. In his time at Reagan, he helped lead them to a North Carolina 4A State Championship title. **Due to his high school success, he was rated the No. 25 recruit in the country for the Class of 2021 by Perfect Game.** In North Carolina, he was rated the No. 1 LHP in his class. Before deciding to attend Wake Forest, coming out of high school, **Hartle** was listed as the 34th-best prospect in the 2021 MLB Draft according to *Baseball America*.

STARS AND STRIPES: From 2017-19, Hartle spent time as a member of the USA Baseball National Team Development Program. In 2018, he appeared in all nine games at the WBSC U-15 Baseball World Cup in David, Panama splitting time between 1B, DH, and P. In the Gold Medal Game vs. Panama, Hartle registered 2 RBI at the plate in a 7-1 Team USA win. He finished the tournament second on the team in both RBI (12), and SLG (.400). On the mound, the left-hander logged a 0.90 ERA across a team-leading 10.0 innings pitched, adding 5 strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** LHP **Caden Favors** (ND) did not record a decision back on Saturday, April 19 at Fort Wayne in an eventual 11-3 Captains victory. The southpaw pitched 1 inning, allowing 1 hit, 1 unearned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout in 35 pitches (20 strikes). **Favors**' lone run allowed was courtesy of a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the 1<sup>st</sup> inning.

**DRAFTED BY THE GUARDIANS: Favors** was selected by the Guardians in the 6<sup>th</sup> round of the 2024 MLB Draft, and was the 5<sup>th</sup> of 16 pitchers drafted by Cleveland last year.

PRO DEBUT IN 2024: Nearly a month after being drafted by the Guardians, Favors was assigned to Single-A Lynchburg on Aug. 12, 2024, and spent the rest of the season with the Hillcats. The southpaw made 4 appearances (1 start) for Lynchburg, tallying a 3.09 ERA and 13 strikeouts to just 2 walks in a combined 11.2 innings of work. Favors made 1 start for the Hillcats last year. On Aug. 28 at home versus the Carolina Mudcats (Single-A, MIL), he pitched 2.2 innings, allowing 4 hits, 3 earned runs, and 1 walk, while throwing 4 strikeouts in 53 pitches (32 strikes). He ultimately recorded the loss in a 7-3 defeat.

SUPERIOR SHOCKER: Favors had a remarkable senior season for Wichita State in 2024 as the team's ace, earning 1st Team All-AAC and 2nd Team All-Region honors. In 17 appearances (16 starts), the left-hander went 9-4 with a 3.21 ERA, 107 strikeouts, 20 walks, and 2 complete games in 106.2 innings of work, which ranked 7th in the nation. He also ranked 18th in the nation with a 5.35-to-1 strikeout-to-walk ratio, led the AAC with an average of 1.69 walks per 9 innings, and ranked 2nd in the AAC with 107 strikeouts, while being the only AAC pitcher with multiple complete games in 2024. Favors became the first Shockers pitcher with 100 strikeouts in a season since 2011, and logged the most innings pitched in a season by a Wichita State pitcher since 2010.

JUCO BEGINNINGS: Prior to his 3 seasons at Wichita State, Favors began his college career at Seminole State College (JUCO) in Seminole, Oklahoma. He made 13 appearances (5 starts) for the Trojans, going 2-3 with an 8.62 ERA, 33 strikeouts, and 20 walks in 31.1 innings of work. Some notable MLB players to play for Seminole State are: 3-time All-Star closer, 2003 NL Cy Young Award winner, and 2007 World Series Champion Eric Gagné, 2012 NL Silver Slugger and Gold Glove Award winner Adam LaRoche, 2017 World Series Champion Evan Gattis, and José Tolentino, the father of 2022-23 Captain Milán Tolentino.

HIGH SCHOOL SUCCESS: Favors had a strong high school career at Carl Albert HS (OK). The left-hander helped lead the Titans finish as state runners-up as a junior in 2019, while serving as a varsity captain and earning Class 5A All-Star honors as a senior in 2020. Perfect Game rated Favors as the No. 4 LHP and No. 27 overall recruit in the state of Oklahoma for the Class of 2020.
