LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn took down Hudson Valley behind three home runs to open the series on Tuesday night...2B **Wilfredo Lara**, RF **Jeffrey De Los Santos**, and 1B **Nick Lorusso** all left the ballpark in a 7-1 Brooklyn win...It's the second straight game Brooklyn has hit three home runs, courtesy of six different players...RHP **Jonah Tong** enjoyed one of his best starts at the High-A level, tossing 6.2 innings while striking out eight and surrendering just a single run en route to his first career Brooklyn win...Hudson Valley was limited to just five hits, while committing three errors...The victory marks the Cyclones' third straight win.

MORABITO FUEL: OF **Nick Morabito** had his 10-game South Atlantic League and 21-game overall on-base streak snapped on Tuesday...From April 20 to May 18, the third-year pro hit .437/.545/.493/1.038 with 16 runs scored, four doubles, four RBI, and 19 stolen bases...The 21-year-old is fourth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.493), tied for fifth in stolen bases (23), ninth in batting average (.369), and 11th in wOBA (.464) and wRC+ (183)...Morabito stole three bases last Wednesday and did it again last Saturday...That mark is tied for the most by a Cyclone in the previous 23 years...The McLean, Va. native enters the day tied for ninth in the South Atlantic League in stolen bases (12) despite playing just 11 games.

HOMER HAPPY: The Cyclones homered three times for the second-straight game on Tuesday...2B **Wilfredo Lara** clubbed a two-run shot in the fifth, while RF **Jeffrey De Los Santos** added a two-run blast of his own in the sixth...1B **Nick Lorusso** also unloaded a solo blast in the sixth...On Sunday, the Cyclones received solo home runs from RF **Karell Paz**, DH **Nolan McLean**, and CF **Stanley Consuegra** in the third, fourth, and sixth innings, respectively...It was the first time Brooklyn had blasted three or more home runs in back-to-back games since they clubbed three on September 2 and 3, 2023, at Greenville.

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: RHP **Jonah Tong** earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on Tuesday, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work was the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...In nine appearances (even starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-0 with a 0.95 ERA (4 ER in 38.0 IP)...Tong is third among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.95)...The Markham, Ont. native is also fourth among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (38.3%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.6%) is seventh...Tong's 59 strikeouts are the seventh-most in the minors.

BROOKLYN BOUND: Brooklyn made roster moves ahead of Tuesday's series opener...RHP **Kade Morris** was transferred from Single-A St. Lucie and INF **Mateo Gil** was transferred from Double-A Binghamton...Morris was the Mets' third-round pick last year, departing the Florida State League ranked sixth in innings pitched (34.2) and 10th in ERA (3.63)...Overall, the 21-year-old was 0-3 with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER in 34.2 IP), 11 walks, and 38 strikeouts in seven starts...He is ranked as the Mets' No. 21 prospect per *Baseball America*...Gil returns to the Cyclones after starting the year on Coney Island...In 12 games with Brooklyn, the 23-year-old was 8-for-37 at the plate (.216) with two home runs and five RBI...Gil was 2-for-14 (.143) with a home run in four contests at Double-A.

BINGO! The Cyclones transferred OF **Omar De Los Santos** and TWP **Nolan McLean** to Double-A Binghamton before Tuesday's series opener...De Los Santos departs Brooklyn as the franchise's single-season (37) and all-time (59) stolen base leader...Omar pinch-ran for McLean and stole a base in his Double-A debut on Tuesday...The 24-year-old was second in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion (25) and is second in Minor League Baseball with 26 steals...McLean homered in his final game with the Cyclones on Sunday and accrued a 2-1 record with a 0.82 ERA (2 ER in 22.0 IP) in his final five starts...The 22-year-old went 2-for-4 with an RBI in his Binghamton debut at the plate on Tuesday...The Willow Springs, N.C. native had 12 extra-base hits in 74 plate appearances, 20 fewer than any other player with that total in the circuit.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The 23-year-old is tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in triples (2) and tied for seventh in doubles (9)...Among Mets' minor leaguers, Lorusso is tied for second in doubles (9), tied for third in triples (2) and extra-base hits (15), fifth in RBI (22), tied for eighth in total bases (58), and 10th in slugging (.483).

GET THOSE STEPS IN: The Cyclones' offense worked a season-high 12 walks in Saturday's win over Bowling Green...Brooklyn's previous season-high was 11 on April 21 at Jersey Shore and April 24 vs. Wilmington...Saturday's 12 free passes tied the Cyclones' franchise record...Brooklyn also coaxed 12 team walks on April 7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and on August 11, 2016, vs. Vermont...Individually, INF **William Lugo** has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 31 free passes are the fourth most in the league...Lugo's 20.8% walk rate is also fourth in the league and 12th in all of Minor League Baseball.

RUNNING WILD AND FREE: Brooklyn swiped a season-high seven bases in last Saturday's triumph at Bowling Green...LF **Omar De Los Santos** and RF **Nick Morabito** each stole three bases, while CF **Stanley Consuegra** added a single swipe...The Cyclones' previous season-best was four on three occasions, most recently on May 8 at Rome...Brooklyn fell one stolen bag shy of matching the franchise record of eight set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...DH **Walter Rasquin** and RF **José Miguel Medina**

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns home to play a six-game series against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades possess four of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (18), INF **Jared Serna** (19), and OF **Jace Avina** (28)...The Cyclones went 14-10 against Hudson Valley in 2023, including a 6-6 record at Maimonides Park and a 8-4 mark at Heritage Financial Park in Wappingers Falls...Since 2001, Brooklyn is 141-144 all-time (.495) against Hudson Valley in 285 matchups.

each stole three bases in that affair, while 2B **Edgardo Fermín** and CF **Quinn Brodey** snatched the other two...The seven steals were the most in a game for the Cyclones since they also stole seven bases on August 15, 2018, vs. Vermont...During last week's series against Bowling Green, the Cyclones stole 18 bases to the Hot Rods' 15.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.68...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.82 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.50)...That ERA is also third at the High-A level and sixth among full-season MiLB squads...Cleveland's Double-A Akron holds the best mark in the minors (2.27), while Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (2.33) possesses the best ERA at the level.

ORELLANA'S OVERWHELMING START: RHP **Douglas Orellana** set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome and continued his impressive start to 2024 on Friday night...Orellana is tied for ninth among South Atlantic League pitchers with 41 strikeouts...Additionally, among arms with 29.0+ innings of work, Orellana is second in the league in ERA (1.23), third in opposing OPS (.475), fifth in batting average against (.165), and sixth in WHIP (0.99)...Orellana's 1.23 ERA (4 ER in 29.1IP) is the 10th-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 29.0+ innings of work...The 22-year-old whiffed 10 in his start against the Emperors, the second double-digit strikeout game of his career...The Caracas, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP **Robert Colina** punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter play on Wednesday with a 13-6 record at Maimonides Park, but a 8-13 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn holds the sixth-best home ERA (2.25) in Minor League Baseball...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (1.97) has the lowest mark in MiLB...Additionally, the Cyclones are fifth in opposing OPS (.570) and sixth in batting average against (.198) in home games...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.70...They also maintain a .685 opposing OPS and a .245 batting average against on the road.

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 71 extra-base hits, 31 home runs, and 103 RBI...The 23-year-old is also three hits away (161) from matching OF **Alex Ramirez's** (164) franchise record for base knocks...He is also four doubles (34) from matching Ramirez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has record a mark of 1,003-847 (.542) in 1,850 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 205-216 (.487) in 421 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 52 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.62 ERA (24 ER in 82.1IP) and 4 saves, walking just 21 and striking out 72.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Morris took a no-decision in his final start with Single-A St. Lucie last Wednesday at Palm Beach...Did not allow a run on five hit over a career-high 7.0 innings...Did not issue a walk and struck out six...Tossed a wild pitch...Offered a career-high 91 pitches and 59 strikes (64.84%)...Relieved by LHP **Zach Thornton** to start the bottom of the eighth with St. Lucie leading 1-0...Palm Beach scored two runs in the bottom of the ninth on a DH **Chase Adkinson** home run to defeat the Mets, 2-1.

PROSPECT RADAR: Morris is considered the New York Mets' No. 21 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America*...He is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster per the publication.

2024: Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 20...Made seven appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League...Posted an 0-3 record with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER in 34.2 IP), 11 walks, and 38 strikeouts...Struck out a career-high nine over five innings in a loss at Bradenton on May 9...Tallied a career-best 7.0-shutout innings of work in his final start on May 15 at Palm Beach...Punched out 27 (28.13 K%) and walked five (5.21 BB%) in his final 22.0 innings in the circuit.

KADE YOU DIG IT: At the time of his departure, Morris ranked among the Florida State League leaders in several categories...The 21-year-old ranked sixth in the circuit in innings pitched (34.2) and ninth in ERA (3.63)...Morris also was seventh in strikeouts-per-nine innings (9.87) and ninth in walk rate (7.4%).

2023: Signed with the Mets as a third-round selection on July 15 for \$666,500...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 17...Made one start on August 17 at the FCL Marlins...Allowed one unearned run on one hit in 1.0 inning...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 6...Made one start on September 7 vs. Daytona...Permitted one run on one hit over 2.1 innings...Walked two and struck out three...Returned to the FCL on September 8.
