YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 6-1. John Michael Bertrand started and threw seven scoreless innings, allowing two hits, on 80 pitches. Adrian Sugastey gave the Flying Squirrels a 1-0 lead in the first inning with an RBI single. Diego Velasquez singled in a run in the second and Justin Wishkoski added an RBI single in the third for a 3-0 lead. In the fifth, Jairo Pomares launched a three-run homer to right, his team-leading ninth of the season, to open a 6-0 lead. Akron scored its only run on a bases-loaded walk in the ninth. **Dylan Hecht** threw a scoreless eighth inning and struck out two.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game road series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This is Richmond's final trip to Akron this year. The RubberDucks swept a three-game series at The Diamond to open the season from April 4-6 and took five-of-six at Canal Park from April 22-27. The Flying Squirrels host the RubberDucks from August 26-31. The Flying Squirrels have won six consecutive games, their longest winning streak of the season. A win tonight would tie the second-longest win streak in franchise history, evening seven-game win streaks in 2010, 2014, 2022 and 2023. The record is eight straight wins from May 5-13, 2021.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,622 fans per home game, which ranks seventh among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won six consecutive games, moving into a tie for first place in the Southwest Division Second-Half standings. It is their longest winning streak since picking up seven consecutive wins from Sept. 2-9, 2023. It is the 17th time in franchise history the Flying Squirrels have won six-or-more straight games. In the last six games since July 1, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League in batting average (.269), runs (33), walks (32), OBP (.373) and OPS (.776). In that same span, the Richmond pitching staff leads the EL in ERA (1.50). Of Richmond's 52 losses this season, 29 of them have been by two runs or less (19 by one, 10 by two). Their 19 one-run losses are the most in the EL, one ahead of Reading (18).

THE RUBBERDUCKS have lost six straight games after winning their previous five straight. Over the weekend, they dropped all three games at home against the SeaWolves. They swept their three games in Erie to begin last week. The RubberDucks finished the first half in second place in the Southwest Division, two games behind Erie. Akron's roster features three players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including SS Angel Genao (No. 2), C Cooper Ingle (No. 8) and OF Kahlil Watson (No. 22). There are three Akron players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects, including Genao (No. 2), Ingle (No. 8) and Watson (No. 29).

STRONG ARMS: Since June 18, the Flying Squirrels have posted a 2.77 ERA (53 ER/172.0 IP) in 20 games, which is second-best in the Eastern League. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 1.51 ERA (13 ER/77.2 IP) in that stretch. In their last nine road games since June 17, the Flying Squirrels have posted a 1.71 ERA (16 ER/84.0 IP).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Manuel Mercedes** makes his 16th Double-A start and his third against the RubberDucks. He picked up a win last Saturday night against the Baysox on the road, allowing one run over 5.2 innings and tied his career high with eight strikeouts. In his last two road starts, Mercedes is 1-1 with a 2.31 ERA (3 ER/11.2 IP). Mercedes spent all of last season with High-A Eugene, going 4-9 with a 5.28 ERA. He was tied for second in the Northwest League in games started (25) and ranked fifth in innings pitched (116.0). Mercedes spent the prior two seasons with Low-A San Jose. In 2023, he went 3-6 with a 3.64 ERA in 25 outings (21 starts). He signed with the Giants in their 2019 international class. For more on Mercedes, see

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Trenton Denholm makes his ninth Double-A start of the season and his third appearance this year against the Flying Squirrels. He went 2-2 with a 2.22 ERA in five June outings, but allowed five runs over six innings in a loss against the SeaWolves in his last start on Saturday. He pitched against the Flying Squirrels out of the bullpen twice in April, allowing one run over eight combined innings. In three career appearances, including one start, against the Flying Squirrels, Denholm is 2-1 with a 1.93 ERA (3 ER/14.0 IP). Denholm was selected by Cleveland in the 14th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UC Irvine, where he was teammates with former Flying Squirrels **Christian Koss** and **Taylor Rashi**.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey**, **Zach Morgan** and **Onil Perez** have combined to catch 45 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for first among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey leads all Double-A catchers with 32 runners caught stealing. Sugastey has the second-most runners caught stealing by a catcher in a single season in franchise history, trailing **Jackson Williams** (35 - 2013). For his career with Richmond, Sugastey's 45 runners caught stealing for his career is fourth-most in franchise history, four behind **Brandon Martorano** (49).

SUGEY SHOW: At the plate. **Adrián Sugastey** is batting .342 (14-for-41) with two homers, a double, nine RBIs, six walks and four runs scored over his last 12 games since June 21. He has posted a .938 OPS in that stretch. In his current eight-game hitting streak dating back to June 28, which is the third-longest active streak in the league, he is batting .379 (11-for-29). He has picked up two hits in the-eo-f-his-last-six games. For the season, Sugastey is second on the team with 31 RBIs and second with eight homers, which is a new career high.

TAKING THE JAIRO: Jairo Pomares hit his team-leading ninth homer of the season on Thursday night, a three-run blast in the sixth inning. It gave him the team lead in home runs (9) and RBIs (33) for the season. Pomares is now tied for 14th in franchise history with 21 career homers, including his team-leading 12 home runs in 2024.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?: Vaun Brown is batting .320 (8-for-25) over his last nine games since June 27, raising his season average from .192 to .234. In that stretch, he has two doubles, five walks, three stolen bases and four runs scored. On Sunday afternoon in the finale in Bowie, he went 3-for-3 with a double and a walk, scoring twice.

SAVING THE DAY: Tyler Myrick recorded his sixth save of the season on Wednesday night in Akron. It was the 18th save of his Richmond career, moving him into seventh on the Flying Squirrels career saves list ahead of **Heath Hembree.** He is two saves behind **Cody Hall** for sixth on the all-time list.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Diego Velasquez is ranked fifth in hits (78), sixth in OBP (.374) and tied for fifth in walks (45). Turner Hill is tied for second in triples (5). Seth Lonsway is sixth in innings pitched (79.2), seventh in ERA (3.50) and tied for ninth in strikeouts (74). John Michael Bertrand is first in innings pitched (90.2) and fifth in ERA (3.28). Jack Choate is eighth in strikeouts (77). Joe Whitman is seventh in strikeouts (78). Tyler Myrick is sixth in saves (6).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 233 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features five players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Diego Velasquez (No. 7), Joe Whitman (No. 8), Jack Choate (No. 24) and Sabin Ceballos (No. 29). John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. Adrian Sugastey is ranked as the top defensive catcher. Aeverson Arteaga is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Whitman (No. 7), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1961: The Richmond Virginians beat the Columbus Jets, 3-2, at Parker Field. Frank Carpin allowed three hits and two unearned runs in a complete game. Carpin was an alum of Benedictine College Preparatory in Goochland County before going to Notre Dame. George Risley hit a solo homer in the fifth. Jake Gibbs hit a go-ahead single in the sixth that went through the legs of outfielder Larry Eliot and rolled to the wall, allowing Gibbs to reach third. 1971: The Richmond Virginians beat the Charleston Charlies, 13-4, at Parker Field. Tommie Aaron hit a two-run homer in the XX, his 10th of the year. He finished the game with four hits and five RBIs. Dusty Baker had three hits, scored three runs and drove in one. 1993: The Richmond Braves lost to the Pawtucket Red Sox, 9-0, in front of a sellout crowd of 7.568 at McCoy Stadium. The R-Braves faced rehabbing Roger Clemens, who struck out eight of the 16 batters he faced, including four looking, on 77 pitches. Chipper Jones and Ryan Klesko were the only hitters to put a ball in play in fair territory against him. Klesko hit a deep flyout to center. Jones led off the fourth with a hit off the wall in center for Clemens' only hit surrendered in 3.2 innings. The Richmond coaching staff offered Tony Tarasco \$20 if he hit a homer off Clemens and an extra \$50 if he did it on the first pitch. He struck out. 1999. The Richmond Braves beat the Norfolk Tides, 5-4, at The Diamond. The R-Braves fell behind, 3-0, in the top of the first. Gene Schall hit an RBI single in the bottom of the first and a run scored on a passed ball to pull Richmond within a run. After a Norfolk run in the top of the third, Schall hit a flyball to left that Todd Haney lost in the sun. He reached third for a triple and scored on a throwing error to pull within a run. Howard Battle tied the game with a sacrifice fly in the seventh. In the bottom of the 10th inning, Marty Malloy drove in Mark DeRosa from second with a walk-off single. 2014: The Flying Squirrels beat the
