INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Southpaw Michael Plasmeyer spun a gem with 5.0 one-run innings and eight strikeouts to lead the Indianapolis Indians to their first win at Victory Field in 2024 on Thursday night over the Memphis Redbirds, 7-5. The Indians got on the board first in the top of the second inning after Billy McKinney roped a double for the first extra-base hit of the game and was driven in on a Carter Bins single. After Memphis tied the game on Moisés Gómez's sacrifice fly, Indy's offense came alive with a trio of run-scoring doubles throughout the fifth and sixth innings. With two outs in the fifth, Malcom Nuñez extended his own torrid stretch of extra-base hits with a double to plate Liover Peguero. The momentum carried into the sixth, and with the bases loaded Nick Gonzales and Gilberto Celestino went back-to-back with doubles to score four more. Joshua Palacios capped Indy's scoring with an RBI single three batters later. The Redbirds rallied with four runs in the top of the ninth inning. César Prieto launched a three-run home run and with two outs, Luken Baker roped an RBI double to bring Memphis within two. Geronimo Franzua then entered and induced a game-ending fly out on one pitch.

PUNCH 'EM OUT, PLASSMEYER: Southpaw Michael Plasmeyer, the Indians Opening Day starter last Friday at Louisville, made his Victory Field debut last night and fanned eight batters across 5.0 one-run innings to earn his first win of the season. He had struck out six through 3.0 shutout innings of work before giving up a run to begin the fourth inning and has now fanned 14 batters across his first 9.0 innings (two starts). His eight strikeouts last night were his most in an outing since fanning a career-high 11 batters on 8/3/22 vs. Syracuse. The 27-year-old spent most of the '23 season with Lehigh Valley and went 3-4 with a 5.05 ERA (38er/67.2ip) and 74 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts).

STILL STREAKING: Nick Gonzales and Gilberto Celestino have wasted no time getting hot at the plate in 2024, extending their respective hitting streaks to five games last night since Opening Day on 3/29. They each recorded one double, a run scored and two RBI in the Indians 7-5 win as the top two batters in the lineup. Gonzales also logged a single to record his fourth multi-hit game of the young season. Combined, the two have hit .364 (16-for-44) and have either scored or driven in 19 of the Indians 26 runs through the first five games.

LAMB CHOPS: Jake Lamb is leading all Indians hitters with a .467 batting average (7-for-15) while recording two runs, two extra-base hits, two RBI, five walks and just three strikeouts through five games this season. Last night, he reached base safely in four of five plate appearances while leading the team with three hits. Despite going hitless in Tuesday's home opener, he walked twice to extend his on-base streak to all five games of the Indians season. The 33-year-old leads a group of veterans for the Indians after being selected as NL All-Star during his 2017 campaign with Arizona, a season that also saw him named as the NL Player of the Week for the second time of his career on 5/22 and a four-hit performance during the NL Wild Card Game vs. Colorado.

NO STOPPING NUÑEZ: After homering in consecutive games from 3/31-4/2, Malcom Nuñez continued his torrid stretch with a pair of doubles in last night's win against Memphis. On Sunday, he launched a solo shot in the fifth inning to put the Indians on the board for their eventual first win of 2024. Of his six hits through five games this season, four have come for extra-bases. He is currently hitting .300 (6-for-20) with three runs and five RBI. The 23-year-old is known for his power, roping a career-high 23 home runs and career-high tying 16 doubles in 2022 between Double-A Springfield, Altoona and Indianapolis to finish the season ranked sixth among all Double-A leaders with 87 RBI.

TONIGHT: After clinching their first win at Victory Field during the 2024 season, the Indians will look to take a lead in the series vs. Memphis tonight at 7:05 PM ET. The all-time series is now tied 16-16 since Memphis joined the International League in 2021. At Victory Field, the Indians are winning the all-time series 12-8 (.600) after splitting the 2023 series at home, 3-3. Tonight's game is featured as the MiLB.TV Free Game of the Day as Pittsburgh Pirates No. 1 prospect (MLB Pipeline), RHP Paul Skenes (0-0, 0.00) and St. Louis Cardinals No. 14 prospect RHP Michael McGreevy (0-0, 3.60) will face off at Victory Field.

SKKKKKENES SIZZLES: Right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes, who is rated by the No. 3 prospect in Minor League Baseball, No. 1 in the Pirates organization and No. 1 among right-handed pitchers (according to MLB Pipeline) made his Triple-A debut at Louisville on 3/30 and punched out five across 3.0 perfect innings. Skenes' fastball topped out at 101.2 mph in his third inning of work, with four of his five strikeouts coming on triple-digit four-seamers. He threw 29 strikes on 46 total pitches. The 21-year-old was selected by the Pirates as the No. 1 overall pick in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft. Following a College World Series championship season at Louisiana State (Baton Rouge) University in which he was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player, Skenes struck out 10 batters over 6.2 innings of professional ball with the FCL Pirates, Single-A Bradenton and Double-A Altoona.

QUICK PITCH: Paul Skenes logged 12 pitches with triple-digit velocities during his Triple-A debut on 3/30 at Louisville, marking the fastest pitches thrown by an Indians pitcher since Statcast data began being tracked in the 2021 season. The fastest pitch thrown in the International League during that time was 102.0 mph by Nashville's Abner Uribe on 6/25/23. In all of Triple-A, the fastest pitch belongs to Reno's Justin Martinez, who hit 102.9 twice during the 2023 season.

THIS DATE IN 1989: The Indians won their season opener over Nashville by a 4-2 score at Bush Stadium, and right-hander Mark Gardner picked up his first of a team-high 12 wins with 5.0 innings of two-run ball. The future 99-game winner in the big leagues also led the American Association with 175 strikeouts that summer. In the postseason, Gardner put the finishing touches on Indy's fourth consecutive American Association title by pitching 8.0 shutout innings in a 5-0, Game 5, series-clinching win on Sept. 6 at Omaha.

TODAY'S STARTER

Paul Skenes: The hard-throwing right-hander Skenes is set to make his Triple-A debut today at Louisville.

Last Outing: Skenes made his Triple-A debut on 3/30 at Louisville and tossed 3.0 perfect innings with five strikeouts. He threw 46 pitches, 29 for strikes, and touched triple digit a dozen times.

Against the Redbirds: Skenes has never faced Memphis.

Triple Digits: Skenes' fastball topped out at 101.2 mph during his Triple-A debut on 3/30 at Louisville, with four of his five strikeouts coming on triple-digit four-seamers. The hardest-thrown fastball in Triple-A since velocity began being tracked in the minors in 2021 was 102.9 mph in 2023.

Prospectus: Enters the 2024 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 1 prospect by both *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline. ... Is rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 3 prospect in baseball and No. 9 by *Baseball America*. ... Is also rated as the No. 1 right-handed pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline. ... Was rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 1 prospect in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft and No. 2 by *Baseball America*. ... Was also rated first in "Best Fastball", "Best Breaking Ball" and "Best Athlete, third in "Best Control" and fifth in "Best Changeup" by *Baseball America* in the Class of 2023.

Geaux Tigers: Went 13-2 with five shutouts, two complete games, 1.69 ERA (23er/122.2ip), SEC-leading 209 strikeouts, 20 walks and a .165 batting average against in 19 starts, leading the LSU Tigers to an NCAA Championship in 2023. ... Was named the College World Series Most Outstanding Player after going 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA and 21 strikeouts in two starts. ... Took home D1Baseball Player of the Year honors and was the SEC Pitcher of the Year. ... Also was the Dick Howser Award (for the national college baseball player of the year) after finishing second in the nation in ERA, third in strikeout-to-walk ratio (10.45) and fifth in hits allowed per 9.0 innings (5.28).
