Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, open a six-game series against the Beloit Sky Carp, sending right-hander Jeff Criswell, the Athletics' second-round selection in 2020 and No. 18 prospect, opposed by Beloit right-hander M.D. Johnson, the Marlins' sixth-round pick in 2019. This is the second leg of the Lugnuts' 12-game, 13-day road trip to Great Lakes and Beloit.

Last Series: The Nuts lost four of six games at Dow Diamond in Midland, falling 8-3 in the Sunday finale after the Great Lakes Loons rallied from a 3-1 deficit with three runs in the 7th and four runs in the 8th. In the loss, right-hander Stevie Emanuels tossed 4 1/3 scoreless innings, striking out six.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Sky Carp through Sunday before returning home and doing a lot of laundry. The Nuts' last home game was on May 15; their next home game is on May 31, opening a six-game series with the Minnesota Twins-affiliated Cedar Rapids Kernels at Jackson Field.

How Things Have Changed: The last time that Lansing and Beloit played one another, it was on May 5, 2019, a 7-5 Lugnuts victory in Lansing. On that day, the Nuts were the Single-A affiliate for the Toronto Blue Jays while the Beloit Snappers were the Single-A affiliate for the Oakland Athletics and had current Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze on their staff. The Lugnuts' offense featured SS Otto Lopez, who made his MLB debut last year for Toronto. Beloit's losing pitcher was its starter, Angello Infante, who is now currently pitching out of the Lugnuts' bullpen.

Experience in Beloit: Besides Schulze and Infante, other Lugnuts who suited up for the Beloit Snappers include pitcher Joe DeMers, outfielders Austin Beck (a 2018 Midwest League All-Star) and Lazaro Armenteros, and manager Phil Pohl, who played three games for the Snappers in 2013 and 72 games for the Snappers in 2014.

Fun While It Lasted: The Nuts went without a home run, ending their streak at 12 consecutive games hitting a longball. (The MLB record is 31 games, set by the 2019 New York Yankees.)

May Power: Even with Sunday's homerless effort, the Lugnuts have slugged a league-leading 29 roundtrippers in 19 games in May after hitting only 11 homers in 20 freezing games in April, the second lowest total in the MWL.

As a Team: The Lugnuts' offense ranks 3rd in the MWL in batting average (.244), 3rd in base hits (308), tied for 3rd in total bases (499), tied for 4th in home runs (40), 3rd in OBP (.328), 4th in slugging percentage (.396) and 4th in OPS (.724).

Among the MWL Leaders: 3B Brett Harris ranks 2nd in the Midwest League in OBP (.429), 4th in slugging (.602) and 4th in OPS (1.031). OF Lawrence Butler is tied for 5th in runs scored (23), INF Euribiel Ángeles is 5th with 41 hits, and relievers Angello Infante and Kumar Nambiar are tied for 3rd with 13 appearances. Starter Jeff Criswell owns the only shutout in the league thus far, a seven-inning one-hitter at Lake County.

Southpaw's Success: Reliever Kumar Nambiar tossed two scoreless innings last Friday, giving him one run allowed (May 10 vs. Dayton) over his last 14 1/3 innings, a streak spanning his last seven relief appearances. During that time, Nambiar has struck out 18 while walking just five. Additionally, the Yale product has allowed just one run in 9 1/3 innings this year in road games.

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

Personal: Criswell played the trombone, cello and guitar while growing up "but I didn't have any serious musical talent, that's probably why I took the career path I did"... his father, Brian, was drafted by the A's in the 17th round in 1984 from Western Michigan and pitched in the Midwest League for the Madison Muskies, today's West Michigan Whitecaps, eventually reaching Double-A Huntsville, where he was teammates in 1986 with Mark McGwire... Jeffs mother, Patti, has written books for the American Girl company... Jeff's sister, Natalie, was a record-setting swimmer at Bowling Green State University.

Hail to the Victors: Rated Perfect Game's No. 1 high school right-hander in Michigan in 2017 while at Portage Central, Criswell was drafted by the Tigers in the 35th round in 2017... turned them down and went to Ann Arbor... named All-Big Ten First Team as a sophomore (2.72, 116 K in 106 IP) and was a key contributor in leading the Wolverines on their run to College World Series Runner-Up to national champion Vanderbilt... in all, went 10-4, 2.88, 50 G, 162 1/3 IP, 174 K at Michigan.

The Run to Omaha: A look at how important Jeff was to the Wolverines in their 2019 path to the College World Series National Championship:

NCAA Regional: Struck out nine in 7 2/3 innings in a 10-4 comeback victory over Cincinnati. Michigan went on to eliminate No. 22 Creighton to advance.

NCAA Super Regional: Facing No. 1 UCLA, relieved Karl Kauffman with the potential tying and game-winning runs aboard in the bottom of the ninth and dispatched Jake Pries with a pop-up and Jack Stronach with a strikeout to secure a thrilling 3-2 win. Started the very next day and allowed one earned run in 5 1/3 innings, departing with a 3-2 lead, only to see the Bruins win 5-4 in 12 innings. Michigan went on to eliminate UCLA in Game 3, advancing.

College World Series: Pitched the final two innings scorelessly, earning the save, in a 5-3 CWS-opening win over No. 8 Texas Tech, striking out Brian Klein with the tying runs aboard to end the game. Earned another save in a rematch with Texas Tech six days later, firing the final three innings scorelessly with six strikeouts to complete a 15-3 romp, sending the Wolverines into the CWS Finals against No. 2 Vanderbilt. Secured the final two outs in Game 1 against the Commodores, a 7-4 UM win. Worked the final five innings in relief, striking out seven, in Michigan's Game 3 series-clinching 8-2 loss to Vandy.

National Pride: Following the 2019 college baseball season, Jeff was invited to pitch for the Team USA Collegiate National Team... recorded yet another crucial save, firing the final three innings against Taiwan in Game 2 of their three-game series... limited opposing batters to a .120 average, best of all pitchers on the team.

Prospecting: Criswell is currently Keith Law's No. 12 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 7 A's pitching prospect and No. 18 overall prospect, and Fangraphs' No. 15 A's prospect... MLB Pipeline's grades: Fastball 60, Curve 50, Silder 55, Change 55, Control 45, writing about him, "Criswell's success as both a starter and reliever at the University of Michigan led to him landing a \$1 million signing bonus from the A's as a second-round pick in the 2020 Draft. After injuries limited him to just 12 innings pitched at High-A in what would have been his first full season with the organization, he did manage to end his year on a high note by returning in time to play in the Arizona Fall League and ranking among the league's top strikeout leaders.... He's been described as Bassitt-ish in reference to Chris Bassitt for similarities in their athletic builds."

2021 Pro Debut: Began 2021 as the highest ranked prospect on the Lugnuts' Opening Day roster: Keith Law's No. 5 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 3 A's pitching prospect and No. 14 overall prospect, and Baseball America's No. 14 A's prospect. Wrote Law, "Criswell was mostly a two-pitch guy up to 95 mph at Michigan, but was showing four pitches and hitting 97 mph in instructs, with a cleaner delivery than the violent one he'd had before the shutdown. Criswell's slider was a swing-and-misp pitch in college and it's gotten sharper now, while his changeup, which he barely used in school, was flashing plus in instructs too." ... started the fifth game of the Lugnuts season, May 8 vs. Lake County, and tossed two easy scoreless innings, but then spent May 12-August 27 on the Injured List, limiting season... made six appearances, three starts, for the Arizona Fall League champion Mesa Solar Sox: 2-1, 6.75 ERA, 22 2/3 IP, 26 H, 17 R/ER, 5 HR, 12 BB, 32 K, 3 HBP, 1 balk, 1.68 WHIP... 12.7 K/9 IP.

- Debuted as Lugnuts starter in the third game of the year, April 10 vs. Lake County... gave up two third-inning runs, but that was all in 4 2/3 innings in a no-decision... departed with the Nuts leading, 3-2... Lansing went on to win, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep.
- April 16 at West Michigan; gave up 1st-inning (two-run) and 3rd-inning (solo) home runs to West Michigan's Jake Holton in suffering his first professional defeat.
- Midwest League Pitcher of the Week: started Game 2 of a double header April 30 at Lake County, taking a no-hitter into the 7th inning before allowing a Petey Halpin single; finished with a one-hit shutout in 8-0 Lugnuts win: 68 pitches, 1 H, 1 BB, 6 K.
