Tonight's Game: The Brewskis are back in action this evening at First Horizon Park. Nashville begins a six-game series against the Omaha Storm Chasers, affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. Right-hander Vladimir Gutierrez makes his first start of the season and his second appearance. He'll face Omaha's Andrew Hoffman. The first pitch is set for 6:35 p.m. from Hit City.

Vladimir Gutierrez: The 28-year-old makes his second-career appearance in the Brewers organization tonight. The former Major Leaguer with Cincinnati (2021-22) and Miami (2024) worked a pair of scoreless innings in the series at Memphis. He began the season with the Marlins, where he allowed three runs on three hits in 4.0 innings on March 31 vs. Pittsburgh. He was designated for assignment the next day and claimed off waivers by Milwaukee. Gutierrez made his Major League debut with Cincinnati in 2021 and went 9-6 with a 4.74 ERA in 22 games (all starts) in what was his only full season spent with the Reds. He battled several injuries and had "Tommy John" surgery in 2022 and did not fully recover in 2023. Gutierrez was originally signed by the Reds on August 30, 2016 for \$4.75 million.

Andrew Hoffman: The 24-year-old makes his fourth start of the season tonight. Hoffman is 1-1 with a 5.54 ERA (13.0 IP/8 ER), starting the year at the Triple-A level for the first time. He picked up the win on April 10 vs. Gwinnett, working 5.0 one-run innings on April 10. Hoffman allowed seven hits and a walk but struck out five. In his lone road start of 2024, Hoffman allowed five runs (all earned) in 3.0 innings on April 5 at Columbus. He split 2023 between Double-A Northwest Arkansas and Omaha, going 4-6 with a 5.56 ERA in 20 games (19 starts) with the Naturals and 3-3 with a 5.45 ERA in eight games (all starts) with the Storm Chasers. He was acquired by Kansas City along with OF Drew Waters and INF CJ Alexander with Atlanta in exchange for CBA Pick #35 on July 11, 2022. He was originally drafted by Atlanta in the 12th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Illinois.

Making Moves: Infielder Andruw Monasterio and right-hander Corbin Martin have been optioned to Nashville from Milwaukee and are joining the Sounds roster for the first time this season. Also, left-hander Darrell Thompson rejoins the team after spending the weekend on the temporary inactive list for the birth of his son, Kace.

Bullpen Beat: The Sounds bullpen continued to be the best at the Triple-A level after not allowing any runs on Sunday. They have yet to allow a run over the last 19.2 innings, dating back to the sixth inning vs. St. Paul on April 7. Nashville relievers have four wins on the season and boast the best ERA (0.95), WHIP (0.93) and opponent batting average (.140) at the Triple-A level. Enoli Paredes (7.0 IP), Rob Zastryzny (5.2 IP), Harold Chirino (5.0 IP), and Nick Bennett (4.0 IP) and Darrell Thompson (2.0 IP) have yet to allow an earned run in multiple appearances this season. The next best ERA among Triple-A bullpens is Columbus at 2.65 (64.0/21 ER) and the next closest opponent batting average is Syracuse at .202. Overall, Nashville's pitching staff has the lowest WHIP (1.24) and opponent batting average (.203) has the third-lowest team ERA (3.71) in the league.

Hoppy Haase: Eric Haase clubbed his third home run of the six-game series at Memphis on Sunday, a go-ahead three-run shot that gave Nashville an early lead. Only former-Sound now Durham Bull Alex Jackson (4) and Iowa's Matt Mervis (4) had more home runs in last week's International League games. Haase's eight RBI also finished tied for the second most in the league, one behind Drew Waters' (Omaha) nine. In eight games, Haase is batting .267 (8-for-30) with five of his eight hits going for extra bases.

Sunday Best: The Sounds are now 3-0 with a +23-run differential (28-5) after their first three Sunday games of the season. They throttled Toledo 12-0 on March 31 before the 8-1 win over St. Paul in their last contest. The 28 runs are the third-most scored on Sundays in the league, behind Buffalo and Durham's tally of 31. Nashville's 1.67 ERA (27.0 IP/5 ER) on Sunday is the second-lowest ERA, behind Omaha's mark of 1.00.

Brewmaster: Brewer Hicklen hit his second homer of the season, a two-run shot to left on Sunday at Memphis. He leads the Sounds in OPS, total bases, doubles and extra-base hits. Hicklen also ranks among league leaders with six doubles (T-2nd) and nine extra-base hits (T-7th). He was caught stealing for the first time this season in Sunday's win and has six stolen bases, tied for the seventh most in the league.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 690-591 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,282-2,111 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

LAST OUTING: Gutierrez made his Sounds debut on April 11 at Memphis. He tossed a scoreless sixth and seventh innings, facing the minimum despite hitting a batter. Gutierrez struck out one.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Gutierrez's second appearance and first start against Omaha. He faced the Storm Chasers on MLB rehab assignment with Louisville on August 5, 2023 at Louisville Slugger Field. He struck out current Sound Brewer Hicklen in his 2.0 scoreless innings, taking the win in relief.

2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Signed to a minor league deal with Miami on February 22...had contract selected and made Marlins debut on March 31
- Designated for assignment the next day and claimed off waivers by Milwaukee...reported to Nashville on April 9

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Missed all of Major League season on the 60-day injured list with Cincinnati
- Returned to injured list after rehab assignment on August 16 with sore right elbow...had season-ending surgery on September 20 to remove bone spurs from right elbow
- Reinstated from injured list on October 9 and was outrighted to Louisville...elected free agency at end of season

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began season on Cincinnati's Opening Day roster for the first time...was one of nine pitchers on Reds Opening Day roster with less than one year of service time
- Lost each of his first five starts before getting a no-decision in the sixth, a 14-11 win vs. Milwaukee on May 11...was the third Reds pitcher to lose each of first five starts of season (Joey Jay in 1963 and Frank Dwyer in 1899) since the pitcher's mound was moved to its current distance from home plate in 1893
- Made his first eight appearance as a start (1-6, 7.71) and his last two in relief (1.2 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 1 K)
- Made last appearance on June 3 vs. Washington...moved to injured list on June 5 and had "Tommy John" surgery to repair the torn ulnar collateral ligament, ending his season

2021 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began season with Louisville and went 2-0 with a 2.65 ERA in three starts
- Made his Major League debut on May 28 in a start at Wrigley Field
- In his first 16 starts through August 22, went 9-4 with a 3.68 ERA with 11 quality starts
- Had streak of six-consecutive quality starts from July 27-August 22...was the longest by a Reds pitcher since Sonny Gray did it from August 20-September 17, 2019 and the longest by a Reds rookie since Raisel Iglesias had seven-straight from August 1-September 2, 2015
- After August 22, went 0-2 with a 9.43 ERA and did not get through the sixth inning in any of his last six starts

CAREER NOTES:

- In his 8th professional season; first with Milwaukee
- On June 28, 2020, was suspended 80 games after testing positive for Stanozolol, a performance-enhancing substance
- Tied for the International League lead in starts and ranked among league leaders in opponent batting average (6th, .266), WHIP (7th, 1.40) and strikeouts (8th)
- Led Reds minor league pitchers in strikeouts with Double-A Pensacola in 2018
- Signed by Cincinnati scouts Tony Arias, Chris Buckley and Bob Engel to a minor league contract on September 7, 2016
- Defected from the Cuban baseball team while in Puerto Rico playing in the Caribbean Series to pursue a career in MLB in February 2015
