LAST TIME OUT: Rocket City jumped on Tennessee starting pitcher Riley Thompson to the tune of seven runs over 4.1 innings as the Trash Pandas topped the Smokies 9-5 Tuesday night to go up 1-0 in the best-ofthree North Division Series. The Trash Pandas struck early with two in the first on a two-run homer by Preston Palmeiro. They added another run in the second on a solo shot by Jordyn Adams before scoring four more in the fifth on a two-run double by Zach Neto, an RBI double from Logan O'Hoppe, and a wild pitch to take a commanding 7-0 lead. The Smokies stormed back with the next four runs to pull to within three before a two-run triple in the ninth by Jeremiah Jackson made the score 9-4. Starter Ky Bush was strong in his first postseason start by tossing five scoreless innings and striking out seven. Rocket City pounded out 13 hits as Neto, Palmeiro, O'Hoppe, Adams, Ryan Aguilar, and Bryce Teodosio each collected two hits.

**FILLING UP ON HOME COOKIN:** Unless the Triple-A Nashville Sounds of the International League sweep their final three home games, the Trash Pandas will finish with the most home wins in MiLB with 49. They wrapped the regular season with a 49-20 record and never lost a home series in 2022.

BULLISH PEN: A huge key to Rocket City's success has been the work of its bullpen. Specifically, the trio of Kolton Ingram, Eric Torres, and Luke Murphy have all been impressive. Ingram posted a 2.02 ERA with eight saves and 53 Ks in his last 44.2 innings of work with only 11 walks and 10 runs allowed. Torres, meanwhile, registered 18 saves and a 2-1 record in his last 38 innings with 13 hits and six ER allowed for a 1.42 ERA to go along with 56 punchouts. Murphy tied for second on the team with seven wins. In fact, in 33 appearances this season he did not allow a run in 27 of them, including no runs at Toyota Field. Over his last 24 appearances, he went 3-0 with a 1.42 ERA over 25.1 innings and 28 strikeouts with four ER. Ingram led the Southern League with 13 holds while Murphy was close behind, ending the season with 12 holds to rank second in the league.

**OBP...RYNO EXPLAINS IT:** After clearing waivers, outfielder Ryan Aguilar was returned to Rocket City on 9/13. This came after a seven-game stint with the Angels as the Yorba Linda, CA native collected three hits, drove in two and scored two runs at the big-league level. Now owning a .271 batting average at Double-A this season after hitting .344 for the month of July, outfielder Ryan Aguilar would have compiled for the best on-base percentage in the Southern League at .415 if he qualified for the category. One reason for the high OBP is because he finished 10th in the league with walks at 66. On 7/2 at Tennessee, Aguilar showed his penchant for getting on base by drawing five walks in five plate appearances. Aguilar would also be second in OPS at .906 if he had enough at-bats to qualify. He is having his best season in slugging at a .491 clip, which would have been tied for second in the league if he had enough at-bats. He was 45-134 (.336) over his final 39 games and is finished first on the team in homers with 15. His work resulted in a season-highlight for the week of 8/16-8/21 when he won the Southern League's Player of the Week Award for going 7-16 against Chattanooga with two homers, six RBI, six runs scored and six walks while only playing in five of the six games.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: Pitching for the Trash Pandas will be RHP Chase Silseth who picked up his fourth consecutive win on 9/15 against Birmiongham when he allowed six shutout innings of two-hit ball with nine strikeouts in a 5-2 win. He has been on a roll of late, going 4-0 with a 1.50 ERA with seven hits allowed on six walks with 36 strikeouts. That includes seven no-hit innings on 9/3 against Biloxi when he started the first ever no-hitter in Rocket City history. He fired 6.2 perfect innings before allowing a man on, taking home his second Southern League Pitcher of the Week award. The Angels #18 prospect according to MLB.com has bounced back-and-forth between AA and the Majors. He last pitched in the Majors on 7/30 for Los Angeles against Texas and allowed five runs on five hits in four innings of a no-decision. In seven games as a Major Leaguer, Silseth went 1-3 with a 6.59 ERA. He won his MLB debut on 5/13 at Oakland when he fired six innings of shutout ball on one hit. He was awarded the Southern League's Pitcher of the Week honors for the week of 4/18-4/24 when he allowed a run on three hits over six frames, walked one and struck out seven in an 8-3 win.

CHASE THE CLINCHER: As Rocket City looks to win the series tonight, they will turn to a hurler who knows something about clinching titles. Right-hander Chase Silseth will toe the rubber in Game 2 tonight. He was the starting pitcher in the first-half North Division clincher on 6/19 when he allowed a run on three hits with seven strikeouts over six innings of a no-decision against Montgomery. The bats woke up and the bullpen held on for a 7-2 win. On 9/15 against Birmingham, Silseth got the win after firing six shutout innings on two hits with nine strikeouts in a 5-2 victory over the Barons that gave the Trash Pandas the second-half title as well.

### WHAT IS A TRASH PANDA?

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunartics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds.

More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far - the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball.

The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).



## NEW MILB RULES FOR 2022

Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 14, 2022

Major League Baseball announced a variety of experimental playing rules that have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee for use during the 2022 Minor League season. Consistent with the preferences of fans, these rules are designed to improve the pace of play, create more action on the field, and reduce player injuries.

Many experimental rules were first tested on a limited basis in 2021. The use of the most promising rules has been expanded to additional levels of play, providing more players and fans with exposure to the rules and allowing the Competition Committee to better evaluate the impact of each on game play. Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2022 Minor League season:



**PITCH TIMER:** On-field timers will be used at all full-season affiliates to enforce regulations designed to create a crisp pace of play, with batters required to be ready to hit and pitchers required to deliver the pitch within allotted periods of time. With runners on base, pitchers will have additional allotted time for each pitch but will risk automatic baserunner advancement if a third pick-off attempt or step-off within the same plate appearance is made without recording an out. These rules were used in tandem in the Low-A West and in the Arizona Fall League in 2021 and led to a significant improvement in pace of play and a reduction in average game time of more than 20 minutes.

**LARGER BASES:** The size of first, second and third base will be increased from 15 inches square to 18 inches square at all full-season affiliates to reduce player injuries. Bigger bases were used in 2021 at the Triple-A level and in the Arizona Fall League, and were associated with a decrease in the severity of base-related injuries. In addition, the reduction in distance between bases led to a modest increase in the rate of successful stolen base attempts.

**DEFENSIVE POSITIONING:** In Double-A, High-A and Low-A, the defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, with at least two infielders completely on either side of second base. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to allow infielders to better showcase their athleticism, to increase batting average on balls in play, and to restore a more traditional set of aesthetics and outcomes on batted balls.

#### TRASH TALK

THE SILSETH FILE: RHP Chase Silseth gets the start in the first playoff game in Toyota Field history looking to finish a series win with a stellar regular season behind him. He'll take a four-start winning streak into tonight's game after a dominant start last Thursday against Birmingham, throwing six scoreless innings as Rocket City clinched the second-half title. That came after solid start in Montgomery, giving up two runs over five innings on 9/9. His previous home start was historic, as he retired the first 20 men he faced on 9/3 vs. Biloxi, striking out 10 before catcher's interference ended his bid for perfection. After a walk, he ended his start with 7 no-hit innings. Luke Murphy and Eric Torres followed with hitless innings to complete the first no-hitter in Trash Pandas history in a 9-0 win. Silseth was named Southern League Pitcher of the Week for that performance on the week of 9/4. Earlier, he was optioned to Rocket City on 7/31 and in his return on 8/5, he dominated to earn the victory, striking out nine over 6.1 innings for his first Rocket City victory since 4/28. On 8/28, he set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts to start his current four-game winning streak. In his last MLB game, he didn't factor in the decision on 7/30 vs. Texas, allowing 5 runs on 5 hits over 4 innings. He didn't factor in the decision after striking out 7 on 7/15 at Mississippi. Before the demotion, he took a loss at Baltimore on 7/7, giving up 4 runs in 4 innings after allowing 3 runs over 4.1 innings on 6/28 against the White Sox. He was optioned to Rocket City on 7/11. On 5/13, he became the first member of the 2021 draft class to reach the show with his MLB debut at Oakland, firing six scoreless innings with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts to earn his first MLB win. He followed that by pitching 4.1 innings in both of his next two starts on 5/20 vs. Oakland, suffering the loss while striking out 6 before a no-decision against Toronto on 5/27. In the final game of his first stint for the Angels on 6/3, he got rocked for 4 runs in Philadelphia in 1.2 innings for his second MLB loss. On 6/19, he fired a quality start by allowing a run on 3 hits with 7 strikeouts as Rocket City went on to clinch the first-half title with a 7-2 win over Montgomery. Before his MLB promotion, he was dominant for Rocket City on 5/5 vs. Chattanooga, recording a career-high 10 strikeouts in his third quality start in a row in what proved to be a 3-2 Rocket City walk-off win. He earned his second straight win on 4/28 vs. Birmingham, striking out eight while giving up an unearned run over 6.0 innings. He was named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on 4/24, earned his first pro win at Tennessee with a career-high 6.0 strong innings and 7 strikeouts.

<u>VS. TENNESSEE</u>: Silseth will face the Smokies for the fourth time in his career tonight. He's dominated in the first three starts, winning them all to go 3-0 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER/18.2 IP), allowing just eight hits, walking six, and striking out 27.

#### MORE NOTES

**PRO DEBUT**: Debuted for the ACL Angels on 9/2/21 against the ACL Reds and pitched 2 relief innings before joining Rocket City. In his Double-A debut on 9/7/21 at Birmingham, he allowed one run with three strikeouts over 3 innings, but the Trash Pandas were shut out so Silseth took the loss. He became the first of the Angels' 2021 draftees to reach Double-A. Five days later, Silseth couldn't make it out of the first inning in the finale against the Barons, allowing 5 runs for his second loss.

FIRST AWARDS: On April 24, Silseth was named the second Southern League Pitcher of the Week for the 2022 season after fellow Rocket City starter Brett Kerry won the award in the season's first week. Silseth made one start that week and was sensational, giving up one run on three hits with one walk and seven strikeouts on 4/22 at Tennessee to earn his first professional victory. The award is the first of Silseth's professional career. A week later, he was named Southern League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 2-0 with a 1.35 ERA (3 ER/20.0 IP) and 27 strikeouts over his first four starts of the year.

COLLEGE NOTES: Silseth began the 2021 season in college for the University of Arizona and made 18 appearances, all starts as the team's game-one starter and went 8-1 with a 5.55 ERA and 105 strikeouts to lead the team and rank third in the Pac-12. On April 23 vs. USC, he pitched a season-high 8.0 innings. He was only one of three Pac-12 pitchers to strike out 100+ and the first Wildcat to accomplish the feat since 2016. Prior to joining Arizona in 2021, Silseth pitched for Southern Nevada in 2020 and made five starts, going 3-2 with a 2.10 ERA, one complete game, and 46 strikeouts over 25.2 innings. He attended Tennessee as a freshman in 2019 and went 1-1 with a 4.35 ERA in 18 appearances (two starts). At Tennessee, he was teammates with current Trash Pandas reliever Zach Linginfelter.

**PLAYOFF PERFORMANCE**: Silseth made 3 postseason starts for Arizona and posted a 7.07 ERA to end 2021. He opened the Tucson NCAA Regional against Grand Canyon. He then started Game 1 of the Tucson NCAA Super Regional vs. Ole Miss and gave up 3 runs over 4.2 innings. He ended his NCAA career in the College World Series opener vs. Vanderbilt and outdueled two-time first round pick Kumar Rocker with 6.1 strong innings on 6/19, but Arizona came up short in extra innings.
