**Tonight:** It's Marvel Super Hero Night with postgame LAFUCU Fireworks, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers, play the fifth in a six-game series. The Nuts have lost the first four games of the series, tying the franchise record (set twice before) with 10 consecutive losses. This is also just the second time this season that Lansing has lost a home series; the first was a six-game sweep by West Michigan in mid April.

**Last Night: Loons 9, Olive Burgers 4.** No. 9 hitter **Jose Hernandez** slugged a pair of homer runs, including a two-run shot in a pivotal four-run fifth inning, and the Loons prevailed in front of 5,366 on Friday night. Lansing starter **Zane Taylor** was struck by a comebacker to end the 2nd inning and was removed the game due to precautionary reasons after the third inning.

### LUG-NOTES

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 18 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 23 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Nathan Dettmer**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

**Big League Nuts:** 2023 Lugnut **Junior Pérez** made his MLB debut for the Chicago White Sox on June 18, becoming the 206th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the sixth this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**, **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**). There are nine current Lugnuts on the Athletics: Bolte, Jump, **Lawrence Butler**, **Joey Estes**, **Hogan Harris**, **Jack Perkins**, **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Colby Thomas**.

**On the Upward Swing:** Utilityman **Justin Riemer** batted .280 with a .479 OBP for the Lugnuts in April, slumped to a .128 mark in May, and was promoted to Double-A Midland on May 21. Since returning from the RockHounds on June 19, Riemer has collected at least one hit in each of his five starts, plus five walks and one HBP. Last night, the Wright State Raider went 2-for-3 with two singles and two walks, stealing a base and scoring two runs; he's now batting a sizzling .353 (6-for-17) with a .522 OBP in six games with the Nuts since returning.

**Streiking:** Outfielder **Pedro Pineda** enters the day on an 12-game on-base streak dating back to June 6: .333 avg., .385 OBP, 16-for-48, 4 walks, 6 steals.

**All-Star Phase 2:** Two starters are locked in to the 2026 MLB All-Star Game, **Shohei Ohtani** and **Ernie Clement**, as the top overall vote-getters in each league. Among the finalists for votes to determine the remaining starters, 2019 Nut **Alejandro Kirk** opposes the A's **Shea Langeliers** for A.L. starting catcher while 2017 Nut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** opposes the Yankees' Ben Rice for A.L. starting first baseman. Look for Guerrero to make his 6th All-Star Game appearance, second in Lansing history behind only **Carlos Beltrán** (nine All-Star nods).

#### A'round the Org.:

- The A's tripled up the Angels, 9-3, with 2024 Lugnut **Henry Bolte** going 1-for-4 with two runs scored, two RBIs and his 10th steal of the season, improving the 22-year-old's slash line to .317/.401/.413 in his first MLB season.
- 2025 Lugnut **Tommy White** went 3-for-5 with a double, lifting his average to .305, and **Casey Yamauchi** delivered an RBI double in his first Triple-A at-bat in a 13-6 loss to Sacramento.
- 2026 Lugnut **Devin Taylor** drilled a pair of singles and a double for his 27th multi-hit game of the year, helping the Midland RockHounds upend Wichita, 6-4. White is batting .338 with a .940 OPS in 16 Double-A games after hitting .292 with an .861 OPS for the Lugnuts. He has seven hits in his last 13 at-bats.

**Pitcher's Best Friend:** The Lugnuts lead all of High-A in turning double plays, with 78 in 71 games.

**Cooperstown Bound:** An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went on to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

## JUNE 26 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** Ryan Shopshire brought a 4-0 lead over Dayton to the 9th at Cooley Law School Stadium, looking for a CG shutout. After two HBPs and a single loaded the bases with one out, Shopshire struck out Josh Garton, and then gave up a two-out game-tying grand slam to Cameron Satterwhite. In the bottom of the 11th, though, Mike Konstanty walked Chris Hopkins with the bases loaded to force in the winning run, giving the Lugnuts a 5-4 victory.

**2015:** Tim Locastro hit his second inside-the-park home run of the season, a solo shot down the third-base line in the third inning (aided by LF Ross Kivett slipping), and Shane Dawson struck out nine West Michigan Whitecaps in 7 2/3 innings in a 5-1 win on Saturday night at Cooley Law School Stadium. Locastro was also hit by a pitch for the 20th time.

**2024:** In the fastest nine-inning game in franchise history, the Nuts shut out West Michigan 3-0 in one hour and 44 minutes.

**In a Nutshell:** Signed for \$125,000 as the A's 12th-round selection in 2021... pitched for Lugnuts in 2023-24, totaling 9-13 record, 4.93, 49 G, 39 GS, 215 1/3 IP... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13, 2024 and spent two weeks on the Injured List... excelled in 2025 for Midland until suffering Achilles injury, June 1... opened this season in Double-A before returning to Lansing on June 17... posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Monkey Ball*... he is also considered one of the top chess players in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

**Last Time Out:** On June 21, in first appearance in 17 days, allowed three runs in the first inning to West Michigan, then blanked the Whitecaps the next three innings; in total: 4 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 1 BB, 6 K on 72 pitches, 45 strikes, in Lugnuts' 4-1 loss.

**Hometown Hero:** Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

**The Buc Starts Here:** Initially committed to Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... transferred to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.
