FRES-NOTES

MULTI-HOMER MAGIC: Kyle Fossum produced the Grizzlies fourth individual multi-home run game this season, delivering the go-ahead Grand Slam in the fifth before homering again in the 7th and finishing with 5 RBI. Tanner Thach started the trend with a two-homer, seven-RBI performance that included a grand slam on April 14 at Ontario, while Fresno's offense has clubbed 58 home runs overall, ranking among the California League leaders. The franchise record for a three-homer game remains Preston Tucker's performance on June 30, 2016 at Salt Lake.

AIN'T DOWNTOWN GRAND?: The homer trend has included a number of Fresno Grizzlies' grand slams in 2026. Fresno has launched five grand slams this season, including Kyle Fossum's bases-loaded blast on June 6 against Lake Elsinore. Tanner Thach, Ethan Holliday, Roldy Brito, and Jack O'Dowd have also connected for grand slams, helping the Grizzlies turn close games in their favor with crooked numbers this season.

KEEP CLAUSEN THE DOOR: Seth Clausen has emerged as one of the California League's top late-inning arms. The right-hander is 5-for-6 in save opportunities, owns a 1.61 ERA, and has held opponents to a remarkable .122 batting average through 20 appearances. Clausen enters play on a scoreless streak spanning his last nine innings and is tied for second in the league with five saves. He retired all six batters he faced Saturday night by using a flyout, four consecutive groundouts, and then punctuating the game with a strikeout.

KEEP PLAYING THE HITS: The Grizzlies have recorded 111 multi-hit games from their current roster, led by Tanner Thach's club-best 24 multi-hit performances. Thach also owns Fresno's longest hitting streak of the season at 24 games, while Roldy Brito ranks second on the club with 23 multi-hit games. The duo has helped power a Fresno offense that ranks among the California League leaders in average, runs scored, and OPS.
