NOTES AND NUGGETS

JAC ATTACK

Sunday night, it was announced that top Royals prospect **Jac Caglianone** was to be promoted from Double-A Northwest Arkansas to Triple-A Omaha ... "Cags" has gone 5-for-16 with 2 homers and 5 RBI over his first 4 Triple-A games.

✦ Caglianone was selected by the Royals with the 6th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft, announced as a two-way player, though he has yet to pitch professionally.

✦ Caglianone leads Minor League Baseball with 48 RBI, tied 4th with 11 home runs, tied 5th with 95 total bases and 8th in the Minors with 54 hits.

✦ Including Double-A games, Cags enters today's game on a 17-game hitting streak, a stretch where he's batting .348 (24-for-70) with a 1.061 OPS since May 3, tied for the 4th-longest active streak in the Minors ... he's reached base in his last 24 games, going back April 25, with a .351 average (33-for-94) and 1.032 OPS.

✦ Cags is responsible for 4 of Omaha's 6 hardest-hit balls this season, including the hardest-hit ball of the year by a Chasers hitter, a home run on Wednesday at 113.6MPH ... his average exit velo leads Omaha's offense, at 94.8MPH.

BAM BAM CAM

Since joining the Storm Chasers last season, shortstop **Cam Devanney** has been one of the top run-producers in the International League, but this year has been one of Omaha's top hitters overall.

✦ Devanney has homered in the first 4 games of this week's series vs. Salt Lake ... he now leads the Storm Chasers with 11 homers this year, tied 1st in the International League, tied 3rd at the Triple-A level and tied 4th in the Minors.

✦ Going back to the start of the 2024 season, Devanney has driven in 115 runs for Omaha, the most of any International League player in that span, 4th-most of any Triple-A player and 9th-most among all Minor League players.

✦ Outside of being tied for the league lead in homers, he is 3rd in the league in RBI (38) ... he is 1st in the IL in slugging percentage (.652) and 3rd in OPS (1.040).

✦ Devanney's 3 grand slams this year are tied for the most in the Minor Leagues, all coming in the month of May ... he is 4-for-6 when batting with the bases loaded and his 13 total bases and 15 RBI when hitting with the bases loaded both lead the Triple-A level, ranking 2nd and 3rd in the Minors, respectively.

✦ Cam has hits in 24 of his 32 games that he's started this year, with an RBI in 20 of 32 games ... his 8 games with 2+ RBI are the most of any Storm Chasers hitter.

LET'S RAVE

Outfielder **John Rave** has been a consistent presence at the top of the Storm Chasers lineup all season long, contributing in all facets of the game.

✦ Rave leads the Minors in run scored (44) ... he leads the IL in triples (4), is 4th in total bases (87), 4th in steals (17), 6th in hits (50), tied 6th in extra-base hits (19) and 9th in slugging percentage (.512) ... additionally, he is 2nd on Omaha in homers (7).

✦ Rave has served as Omaha's leadoff hitter in 41 of 47 games this year ... he's reached base to begin 17 of 41 games (.415 OBP leading off the 1st inning) ... that includes 11 hits (5 singles, 3 doubles, 3 homers), 5 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch ... his 3 leadoff homers this year are tied for the most in the Minor Leagues, while 23 total bases to lead off games ranks 2nd in the Minors.

✦ Thursday, Rave snapped a career-best 16-game hitting streak, the 3rd-longest streak in the IL this year, hitting .406 (26-for-64) with a 1.214 OPS from May 3 to 21 ... he also scored a run in all 16 games of that hitting streak, with 23 runs scored in the stretch, a career-best and new modern Omaha record.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

✦ Omaha has successfully stolen 75 bases this year, and only been caught 10 times ... 75 steals rank 4th both in the International League and among Triple-A teams.

✦ 75-for-85 in steal attempts is a 88.2% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 94.1%, 32-for-34).

✦ **John Rave** leads the team with 17 steals, ranking 4th in the International League and 5th at the Triple-A level ... **Nick Loftin** is 2nd in Omaha with 12 stolen bases.

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 467 strikeouts this season ... that is 2nd in the league and 3rd at the Triple-A level.

✦ Over 409.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.26 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

✦ With 467 strikeouts through 47 games, an average of 9.94 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,480 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

A well-regarded high school pitching prospect, Champlain honored his Southern California commitment in 2018 and stayed close to home. Three years later, the Yankees selected him in the ninth round of the 2021 Draft and then traded him to the Royals as part of a three-pitcher package for Andrew Benintendi in 2022. Champlain returned to Double-A in '24 and showed he had mastered it with a 3.50 ERA, a 0.92 WHIP and a 34.5% strikeout rate in seven starts. The move to Triple-A was more challenging; Champlain made 28 appearances (27 starts) there for a 5.61 ERA, 15.5% strikeout rate and a 1.56 WHIP while batters hit .283 against him.

Champlain's average cutting fastball sits 91-94 mph, touching 97 in 2024. He spins the ball well and has improved his upper-70s curveball into a solid weapon. That pitch is different from his low- to mid-80s slider which has good depth and got some chase in '24 in a limited sample. Champlain also shows a cutter, which could be an out pitch eventually because of his natural movement, and his mid-80s changeup is still a work in progress, as it has been for several years. The lack of a pitch against lefties has hindered Champlain as he's faced better hitters. He has some effort in his delivery which affects his command at times, but he showed up to Spring Training over 100 pounds lighter.

Champlain has the look and mentality of a workhorse on the mound and has proven durable in the Minors, throwing 135 and 140 innings the past two seasons respectively. But he'll need to develop a weapon against lefties for him to reach his ceiling, otherwise there's thought he would have more in the tank as a multi-inning reliever with a fastball-curveball combination. He wasn't added to the 40-man when eligible for the Rule 5 Draft, but he'll return to Triple-A, be part of the Royals' depth and could make his debut in '25.

Track Record: Champlain was off to a good start in his return to Double-A in his second full year in the Royals organization since being acquired from the Yankees midway through 2022. In seven starts with Northwest Arkansas, the most noticeable statistic was an impressive 12 strikeouts per nine innings compared to just 1.8 walks. His promotion to Triple-A Omaha proved to be more challenging for Champlain. His strikeout rate decreased to 6.2 per nine innings, his walk rate rose to 4.0 and opponents hit .282 with 17 home runs in 104.1 innings.

Scouting Report: Champlain's four-seam fastball comes to the plate on a downward angle, sits 92-94 mph and touches 97—but he struggled to command it when he got to Triple-A. His 76-80 mph curveball improved enough in 2024 to be graded a plus pitch. At times it looked like one of the better benders in the minor leagues and misses plenty of bats in the zone with 12-to-6 shape and great finish. The slider is a distinct pitch from the curveball, averaging 85 mph with good depth. Champlain rounds out his repertoire with an 85 mph changeup and 86 mph cutter, both still in development. There's not a lot of athleticism in his delivery, making it more difficult to repeat and affecting his command.

The Future: Champlain projects as a big-bodied back-of-the rotation starter, although his stuff would tick up in shorter stints if he moved to the bullpen. He was not added to the 40-man roster when eligible after the 2024 season.

In his second start of the series with the Clippers, allowed a leadoff homer to Lane Thomas on the 3rd pitch of the game ... followed with two scoreless frames, including a 1-2-3 inning in the 2nd ... allowed 4 straight to reach with one out in the 4th inning, with a walk and three hits plating 2 runs ... allowed a solo homer to C.J. Kayfus in the 5th inning ... allowed a one-out single in the 6th and was removed, the bequeathed runner came around to score.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Over his first 3 starts, walked 10 batters and allowed 19 hits over 12.1 innings, for a 2.35 WHIP.
- Over his last 6 starts (Since April 17), has issued exactly 1 walk in each start ... in this stretch, has allowed 32 hits and 6 walks in 27.1 innings, for a 1.39 WHIP.
- Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 6 of 9 starts, including his last 5 starts ... has finished 6.0 innings once, his second outing of the year, April 5 vs. Louisville (CIN), his only losing decision of the year, with 4 runs allowed.

CAREER NOTES

2024

- Made 28 starts between Northwest Arkansas (AA) and Omaha, including 1 postseason start with the Chasers ... opened the season at Double-A and made 7 starts before being promoted to Triple-A on May 20, finishing the year in Omaha.
- Led Storm Chasers pitchers in home runs allowed (17), runs allowed (68), walks allowed (68) and tied for the most hits allowed (117) ... ranked 2nd among Omaha pitchers in regular season starts (20) and innings (104.1).
- Ranked 1st among Royals Minor Leaguers in starts (27) and innings (140.1) ... 120 strikeouts were the 4th-most among Royals farmhands behind **Neaugh Cameron** (149), **Tyson Guerrero** (123) and **Steven Zobac** (123).
- Made 9 quality starts, 3 in Double-A and 6 in Triple-A ... 4 of 9 quality starts came in a 5-start outing between May 9 and June 5, his final 2 with NWA and 2 of his first 3 with Omaha.
- Worked career-best 12.1-inning scoreless streak that spanned his last two starts in Double-A, May 9 vs. Springfield (STL) and May 15 @ Arkansas (SEA), striking out 17 between the two.
- Made the first postseason start of his career on September 25 vs. Columbus (CLE), Game 2 of the International League Championship Series ... allowed 2 solo homers in 5.0 innings.

- Split the season between Quad Cities (A+) and Northwest Arkansas (AA), combined to go 11-8 with a 3.33 ERA (50 ER in 135.1 IP) and 125 strikeouts over 25 starts.
- Opened the year in High-A and made 6 quality starts of his 11 River Bandits starts, added 7 more quality starts of his 14 Naturals starts ... 13 quality starts were the most of any Royals Minor Leaguer, tied for the 3rd-most in the Minors.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
