THREE MORE: Sounds' manager Rick Sweet is three wins away from passing Buddy Bailey for the third-most managerial wins in Minor League history following Nashville's series opening win over the Bulls on Tuesday night. Sweet owns a career record of 2,415-2,223 and is already the Sounds all-time winningest manager.

PREMIUM PETROL: Left-hander and Brewers no. 12-rated prospect Robert Gasser made his first Triple-A appearance of his rehab assignment last Friday night after undergoing Tommy John Surgery in June 2024. Gasser made four rehab appearances in the lower levels prior to having his assignment transferred to Nashville. He had surrendered two earned runs in his first start for High-A Wisconsin on June 24th, exactly a year after his surgery. They were the only runs allowed through his first six-innings of rehab with just a hit allowed in each of his previous four starts. In his first Triple-A appearance since May 5, 2024, Gasser worked 3.0 scoreless innings with three hits allowed and four strikeouts. Through nine innings of rehab, Gasser has nine strikeouts, two walks, seven hits, and carries a 2.00 ERA without a decision.

TATE THE GREAT: Left-hander Tate Kuehner was incredible in his Triple-A debut on Wednesday against the Durham Bulls. The left-hander allowed a run on six hits, a walk, and four strikeouts over 5.1 frames. It is the first outing of 5.0 or more innings for Kuehner since tossing a quality start with 6.0 innings on July 25 for Double-A Biloxi. The 24-year-old has gone 5.0 or more innings in six of his last eight starts, including a span of reaching that mark five starts in a row from June 28 - July 25. Overall, Kuehner was dominant in Biloxi before his call-up to Nashville, earning a 2.50 ERA and 112 strikeouts over 100.2 innings for the Shuckers.

HOW DAZ YOU DO: After a red-hot month of July, Daz Cameron has seen his numbers dip in the month of August. The Sounds outfielder hit .377 with a .431 on-base percentage in July, and carries a .216 batting average and .293 on-base percentage through 10 games in August. Going into Wednesday night's game, Cameron was two for his last 18 with strikeouts in six of his last seven games. His performance against the Bulls Wednesday might be a sign of a turnaround for the 28-year-old. Cameron blasted a solo homer for his second longball of the month and his 12th in just 39 games at the Triple-A level. He has now recorded hits in back-to-back games, combining to go 2-for-8 with two extra-base hits.

DREW DA MAN: Drew Avans has provided a spark in the lineup for Nashville over the last week. On Wednesday against the Bulls, Avans went 1-for-3 with a double and recorded one of the four hits the Sounds offense collected. Avans extended his hitting streak to six games and is now batting .286 in the month of August. Over his hitting streak, Avans is hitting .320 with two extra-base hits and three RBI. The six-game hitting streak is the longest he has completed in a Sounds uniform this year, passing his two separate five-game hitting streaks.

GREAT WEATHER WE'RE HAVING: Nashville bolstered their bullpen with the addition of right-handed veteran Julian Merryweather on Wednesday. Merryweather recently signed a minor league contract with the Milwaukee Brewers after opting out of his minor league deal with the New York Mets. The 33-year-old made a statement in his first Sounds appearance, striking out the side in a perfect seventh inning. The three strikeouts tied his season-high, which he recorded on July 26 in a perfect inning for Triple-A Syracuse. The bullpen appearance for Merryweather was his first outing since July 31 where he tossed 0.2 scoreless innings against Buffalo.

BETTER AND BETTER: Jeferson Quero has not missed a beat since returning to the Sounds off the injured list on August 7. He continued his recent hot stretch with a 2-for-3 game, adding five RBI and his third home run of the season. Quero's five RBI set a season-high for the catcher and tied the Nashville team-high for a game this year. The last Sounds hitter to drive in five runs was Daz Cameron on July 12, also against the Durham Bulls. The five-RBI performance for Quero also tied his single-game career-high which he has reached two other times. In 2023, Quero earned two games with five RBI for Double-A Biloxi. The 22-year-old has been on the rise as of late through MLB Pipeline rankings, moving to the No. 4 spot for the Milwaukee Brewers and No. 65 out the top 100 prospects.

- Transferred to University of Houston and was a First-Team All-American Athletic Conference as a senior in 2021 (6-6, 2.63 ERA, 85.2 IP, 105 K).
- Father, Jim, was a pitcher drafted by Milwaukee (1984) and San Francisco (1986) but did not sign due to injury.
- Entered 2024 as the no. 6-rated prospect in the MIL system (*Baseball America*)
- Began the 2024 season with Nashville (3 G, 0-1, 5.25 ERA) before having his contract selected on May 10...Made his Major League debut vs. St. Louis...Earned the win and became the first player in franchise history to throw at least 6.0 IP without a run or walk allowed in Major League debut (6.0 IP, 2 H, 4 K).
- Was 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA in five starts for the Brewers in 2024...Team was 5-0 in his starts and he had two quality starts.
- First pitcher in Brewers history to win each of his first two Major League games... since joined by Logan Henderson.
- Placed on the 15-day IL on 6/5/24 with a left flexor strain, later transferred to the 60-day IL on 6/25 after undergoing "Tommy John" surgery.
- Named 2023 International League Pitcher of the Year and Co-Minor League Pitcher of the Year for the Brewers (Carlos Rodriguez) after going 9-1 with a 3.79 ERA in 26 G (25 GS) for Nashville.
- Led Triple-A and was second among Brewers farmhands with 166 strikeouts.
- Brewers Co-Minor League Pitcher of the Month in June 2023 and Minor League Pitcher of the Month in August 2023.
- Traded to Milwaukee from San Diego as part of the Josh Hader deal on August 1, 2022...At the time was the no. 9-rated prospect in the Padres organization.
- Ranked fifth in Minor League Baseball in 2022 with 172 strikeouts in 137.0 IP.
- Made six starts his first professional season in 2021...Went 0-0 with a 1.20 ERA.
