SEVEN-RUN NINTH SENDS BIRDS TO FOURTH STRAIGHT LOSS: The

Arkansas Travelers broke an 8-8 tie with seven runs in the top of the 9th inning as the Cardinals dropped the series finale at Hammons Field 15-8 on Sunday afternoon. The loss was Springfield's fourth in a row, and the Cardinals are 5-7 over their last 12 since a season-opening nine-game winning streak. The Cardinals trailed 8-1 and rallied back with a six-run 4th, including back-to-back home runs by **Matt Lloyd** (grand slam) and **Jacob Buchberger**. Springfield tied the game in the 8th on a sacrifice fly by **Noah Mendlinger** before the Travs 9th inning explosion. **Nathan Church** had 3 knocks to



extend his hitting streak to a Springfield season-high 12 games, while **RJ Yeager** added 2 hits in the loss.

DPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander **Justin Wrobleski** makes his fifth start of the season for Tulsa...Last pitched on Tuesday, April 23 against NW Arkansas and did not factor in the decision, allowign 5 ER on 6 H with 4 K in 4.1 IP...The Drillers lost the game 9-5...Got the nod on opening night at NW Arkansas and got the win, allowing a run on 3 H with 6 K in 5.0 IP...Spent the entire 2023 season with High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League going 4-4 with a 2.90 ERA in 25 appearances (23 starts)...Opponents hit .244 against him...Made one start last season against the Peoria Chiefs (High-A, Cardinals) and allowed 2 ER on 7 H in 5.0 IP with 3 K...Made 13 appearances in 2022 between the ACL Dodgers and Low-A Rancho Cucamonga and went 1-3 with a 2.91 ERA after rehabbing from Tommy John surgery...Selected by the Dodgers in the 11th round of the 2021 draft out of Oklahoma State despite having his only season with the Cowboys cut short (9 appearances) due to his elbow injury...Spent his sophomore season in junior college at State College of Florida in 2020 after pitching for Clemson as a freshman in 2019...23 years old

CARDINALS BEGIN 12-GAME ROAD TRIP WITH FIRST VISIT TO TULSA: The Springfield Cardinals hit the road for two straight series beginning with their first of four matchups with the Tulsa Drillers (Double-A, Los Angeles Dodgers). The Cards will host Tulsa later this month before making their final regular season trip to Drillville for a six-game series from July 30-August 4.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

HISTORIC START: With their nine-game winning streak to start the season, the Cardinals set a new franchise record for consecutive victories. Springfield had won eight straight games twice previously: in 2007 from June 9-16 and from September 2-10 last season during a 17-6 run over 23 games to claim the North Division 2nd half crown.

COMEBACK CARDS: Of the Cardinals' 21 games so far this season, they have fallen behind first in 14 of them. Of those 14 games, the Cards have won nine, making them 9-5 when their opponent scores first. Amazingly, despite Springfield's opponent scoring first in 11 of 12 games at Hammons Field, the Cardinals hold an 8-4 record at home this season.

BIRDS BOAST BEST DOUBLE-A OFFENSE: Springfield's lineup sits atop the Double-A level in several offensive categories. Through 21 games the Cardinals lead the three Double-A leagues with a .277 batting average; the Amarillo Sod Poodles are next at .265. The Cards also lead the the entire level in OBP (.367), RBIs (116) and runs scored (126), and are ranked third in OPS(.827) behind the Somerset Patriots and Portland Sea Dogs. Springfield has also been particularly prodcutive hitting situationally, with a league-high 12 sacrifice flies this season, a number that also leads all of Double-A.

The Cardinals have reached double-digit hits in 7 of their 21 games so far, and have 8 or more knocks in 16 games.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cardinals have struck out just 148 times in 21 games, the second-fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. The Cardinals only trail the Spokane Indians (High-A, Colorado Rockies) who have K'd 125 times, although in four less games than Springfield has played (17). The Birds have struck out 11 less times than any other team in the Texas League (Frisco RoughRiders, 159). The Cards are averaging just 7 K's per game.

STAFF LOOKING TO GET BACK ON TRACK: Since the Cardinals' franchise-record nine-game winning streak to start the season, Springfield has struggled to prevent runs the way they did at the outset. Over their last 12 games since April 16, the Cards have a 6.37 ERA, the highest mark in the Texas League. Springfield's opponents are hitting a league-high .279 and the Birds have also allowed 15 HR, also the most in the circuit. The home run ball has not been a friend to the Cardinal staff early: the Birds have allowed 25 HR so far this season, the second-highest total in the league behind the Amarillo Sod Poodles (27).

Over their first nine games, Springfield's staff sported a 2.88 ERA, the 2nd-best mark in the league during that time. The Cardinals are 5-7 since starting the season 9-0.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Cardinals outfielder **Nathan Church** is off to guite the start in his first taste of Double-A. Riding a 12-game hitting streak, the UC Irvine product ranks in the top 5 among qualified hitters in the Texas League in five different categories: batting average (4th; .354), RBIs (t3rd; 17), hits (2nd; 29), total bases (3rd; 42), and runs (t3rd; 17). Church was named Texas League Player of the Week two weeks ago after going 9-for-25 with 2 HR and 8 RBIs to go along with 6 BB in Amarillo from April 16-21. In 92 plate appearances this year, he has struck out just 5 times.

REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD FOR HOME RUNS: With

his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on Tuesday night, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs in Springfield's 20-year franchise history. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 205.

FAMILIAR FACES: Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster. 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards, Bryan Torres (Richmond, 2021) and Matt Lloyd (Chattanooga, 2021-22), have Double-A experience. Slugger Chandler Redmond returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the SprIngfield franchise record in 2023 with 31 longballs.

Cardinals skpper Jose Leger is back for his fourth year as manager in Spring-




