SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

STARTING OFF HOT: Through 11 games, the Shuckers starting pitching staff has been lights out to the tune of a 3.93 staff ERA, 12.7 strikeouts per nine and a .210 opponent's batting average... The staff enters today with 74 strikeouts, the second-highest total in Double-A... They're one of two teams, along with the Chattanooga Lookouts (CIN), to eclipse 70 strikeouts from the starting staff this year.

THE GAS HOUSE: Through the first two games of this week's series against Rocket City, the Shuckers' pitching staff has recorded 30 strikeouts, the most over a two-game span in 2023... After tying their season-high with 16 strikeouts on Tuesday, the Shuckers struck out 14 Trash Pandas on Wednesday.

MAGICAL NUMBER SEVEN: With a win during Wednesday's game against the Trash Pandas, the Shuckers improved to 3-0 when scoring exactly seven runs in a game... Each of their last two wins have come by a 7-1 score... In 2023, the Shuckers are 4-1 when they score at least six runs.

FIRST INNING RUNS: Wednesday's first inning runs marked the third straight game that the Shuckers have scored in the first inning... Over that span, the Shuckers have tallied four first inning runs, with two coming off solo home runs from **INF Tyler Black**... The Shuckers have scored eight first inning runs this year, second in the Southern League behind the Mississippi Braves (ATL)... In the frame, the Shuckers are slashing .238/.365/.452... The team has also stolen six bases in the first, most in the league.

THE YOUNG AND RESTLESS: Entering today's game, the Shuckers lineup is the youngest in Double-A... Per *Baseball-Reference*, which uses playing time to weight and measure the average age, the average Shuckers hitter is 22.5 years old... For comparison, the oldest lineup in Double-A is the San Antonio Missions (SDP) with an average age of 26.3... The Shuckers roster has six players who enter today at 22 years old or younger... **OF Jackson Chourio** is the youngest player in Double-A at 19 years old.

CLOSING IN ON HISTORY: Shuckers manager **Mike Guerrero** enters today needing 14 more wins to reach 1,400 in his managerial career... Guerrero enters his 24th season in Minor League Baseball in 2023 and his 23rd with the Brewers organization... He was named the 2018 Southern League Manager of the Year after guiding the Shuckers to an 81-59 record... He earned his 1,000th managerial win on July 14, 2016 in his first year with the Shuckers after spending two years on the Milwaukee Brewers coaching staff.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS (1-0, 5.14): RHP Christian Mejias makes his second start of the season, and third appearance, after eight strikeouts against Pensacola on Friday... Mejias's start on Friday marked his first in the Brewers organization, and the righty held the Bule Wahoos scoreless over five innings in a 7-1 Shuckers win... Today's start marks his first road start in Double-A, and his first appearance against Rocket City.
