Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth in a six-game series against the Cedar Rapids Kernels, High-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins, the penultimate affair in the Lugnuts' 12-game, 14-day road trip to the Hawkeye State. The Nuts split a six-game series at Quad Cities to open the road trip, winning the last two games over the weekend, but have lost four in a row to begin this series. Cedar Rapids is 8-2 against the Nuts this year, winning four of six games in Lansing earlier this season.

Last Night: Kernels 8, Lugnuts 5. Jacob Wilson collected three hits and Junior Pérez drove in three runs, but Cedar Rapids broke a 3-3 tie with three runs in the fifth inning, added two insurance runs in the seventh, and defeat the Nuts for the fourth straight game, matching Lansing's longest losing streak of the year. Cedar Rapids has triumphed in nine consecutive home games.

On the Air: Calvin Christoforo calls the action on Bally Live and MiLB TV, with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler delivering an audio-only call via StreamGuys.

On Deck: The Nuts wrap things up with the Kernels tomorrow before returning to Jackson Field for a two-week homestand against the Fort Wayne TinCaps and the Great Lakes Loons, running from August 8-20 at Jackson Field.

One to Remember: Davis Schneider homered in his first at-bat over the Green Monster for the Toronto Blue Jays, finishing with a single and a roundtrip in his Major League debut. On September 5, 2017, an 18-year-old Schneider went 1-for-3 with a single and a run scored for the Lugnuts in the Crosstown Showdown exhibition against Michigan State. Schneider had been flown in to Lansing from the Gulf Coast League; he never ended up playing in a regular season game for the Nuts.

Congratulations! 1B/OF Danny Bautista, Jr., who enters today on an 11-game hitting streak and a 16-game on-base streak, was honored as the Midwest League's Player of the Week for the week of July 25-30, collecting 11 hits in 24 at-bats (.458 avg.) with three doubles, one home run and four RBIs in six games. Bautista, Jr. increased the level of his performance as the week went on, collecting a single in each of the first two games, a single and a double in each of the next three games, and finishing with two singles and a two-run homer on Sunday. His closest competition for the weekly honor was teammate Colby Thomas, who slashed .462/.481/.654 with 12 hits in 26 at-bats, two doubles, one triple, one walk and one stolen base. The two Lugnuts topped all Midwest Leaguers in batting average for the week.

Welcome Aboard: SS Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall selection in the 2023 draft from Grand Canyon University, went 3-for-5 yesterday with two singles and a double, and is now 9-for-21 in six games as a professional, split evenly between the Arizona Complex League and the Midwest League. A three-year All-WAC 1st Team honoree, Wilson was named the Western Athletic Conference's 2023 Defensive Player of the Year while hitting .411 with only five strikeouts in 49 games. His father, Jack, played in the Major Leagues from 2001-2012 and coached him at Thousand Oaks High School and GCU.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: Miguel Rodriguez recorded the save in yesterday's Kernels win, following a familiar pattern: 19 of the last 21 games that the Lugnuts have played have featured a save. By month: 7 saves in 20 games in April (35%), 9 in 27 in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and now four in four games in August.

Turnaround: Outfielder Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .275 (67-for-244). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - 7-for-17, two home runs, two walks, .412/.474/.824, 1.298 OPS. He has reached base 20 times in the last eight games thanks to 14 hits and six walks.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections, though catcher Daniel Susac, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, was placed on the Injured List on Wednesday. A day prior, shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick in 2023, joined the Lugnuts. Wilson's high school teammate, 2021 first-rounder Max Muncy, played for the Nuts earlier this season and is now in Double-A Midland.

Davis Schneider (MLB debut w/ Toronto, Aug. 4) played in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown but zero regular season Lansing games.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2014: 19-year-old Miguel Castro debuted at Fort Wayne, allowing a first-inning home run to Trea Turner en route to allowing five runs on three hits and one walk, striking out five, in four innings. The Nuts lost, 7-1.

2015: In his Lugnuts debut, Clinton Hollon allowed a leadoff single to Wisconsin and then pitched hitless ball the rest of the way, retiring the final 19 batters he faced, as the Nuts beat the Timber Rattlers, 2-1, at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2019: The Lugnuts split two at Bowling Green, losing 3-1 and winning 6-3. In Game 1, Troy Watson tossed a six-inning complete game. In Game 2, Cobi Johnson fired five hitless innings, walking three and striking out seven. The Lugnuts brought that no-hitter and a 3-0 lead to the sixth. With one out, Jonathan Aranda busted up the no-hit bid with a two-run homer. Four batters later, Seaver Whalen broke out of a 3-for-49 slump with a two-out game-tying RBI single. But the Lugnuts countered with three runs in the seventh on a throwing error by lefty Michael Costanzo and a two-run wild pitch by Costanzo, scoring both Otto Lopez from third and Reggie Pruitt from second.

Retrospective: Watters made his Midwest League debut at Four Winds Field on August 31, 2022, pitching against rehabber Wade Miley in Lansing debut... had made just one prior appearance in the minors before joining the Lugnuts: August 23 for the Arizona Complex League Athletics vs. the Ariz. Complex League Cubs.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Michigan Wolverine Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Mercer slugger Colby Thomas in the third round).

WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th round) and Ryan Bergert (6th round); pitched against Bergert on May 26 and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

Glory Days: Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels, who played 11 years (2001-2011) in MLB.

Current Ranking: MLB Pipeline ranks Watters the No. 26 prospect in the A's organization and the No. 12 pitching prospect... his grades: Fastball 60, Curve 60, Changeup 45, Control 45, Overall 40... his scouting report: "Watters is a strong presence on the mound at 6-foot-4. His fastball was up to 99 mph during his junior year and touched triple digits in his time as a reliever. He also possesses a plus pitch in his power curve, missing plenty of bats as a true 12-to-6 that sits in the mid-80s. There's also a mid-80s changeup in there, though it's less polished compared to his other two offerings. Command will need to improve for Watters to have a chance to start at the next level. While the stuff was high-octane in college, he usually had little idea of how to locate it. Given his track record as a reliever, there's a strong chance he ends up back in the bullpen, where he can rear back and overpower hitters with two plus pitches."

Personal: Brady's last name is pronounced "bass-o," with 'bass' like the fish rather than the instrument... got married during the 2020-2021 offseason after spending 2020 hiatus planning his wedding in addition to preparing for the 2021 season... made seven appearances for the Lugnuts in 2021 before suffering ACL tear... 687 days between MiLB appearances, June 15, 2021, and May 3, 2023, in returning from Tommy John.

Raising Expectations: An MLB.com article from Athletics MiLB camp by Jonathan Mayo on April 28, 2021, carried a bit of surprising news on a couple of breakout pitchers, specifically, as Mayo wrote, "Brady Basso's role is changing. A lefty who signed for just \$75,000 as a 16th-round pick in the 2019 Draft out of Oklahoma State, Basso pitched almost exclusively in relief in college and threw well in that role in the Rookie-level Arizona League in 2019. Now that he's up to 95-96 mph with his fastball to go along with a curve that flashes plus and a work-in-progress changeup, he's going to get the chance to start." Melissa Lockard, writing for The Athletic on May 2, 2021, included Basso in her Lugnuts preview, writing, "Left-hander Brady Basso (2019, 16th round) opened a lot of eyes this spring with his fastball sitting at 95-97 mph."

Pro Debut: Brady pitched for Athletics Gold in the AZL after signing: 15 G, 1 GS, 1.64 ERA, 25 2/3 IP, 0 HR, 8 BB, 38 K... limited right-handed hitters to .194/.257/.313 in 74 PA, while lefties hit .250/.344/.286 in 32 PA... opposing base stealers were nabbed twice out of three attempts... made first professional start on 8/16/19, tossing three innings with 4 K's.

Draft Day: Basso was selected 494th overall in the 16th round of the 2019 draft from Oklahoma State... scout: Chris Reilly... signed for \$75,000... in the same round, two all-name players were drafted: the Tigers selected Kona Quiggles and the Blue Jays took Jackxarel Lebron... one of eight OSU Cowboys to be drafted in 2019.

College Days: Brady was primarily a reliever at Oklahoma State (12 G, 2 GS as freshman; 18 G, 5 GS as sophomore; 14 G, 0 GS as a junior)... after a rough sophomore season (8.27 ERA), rebounded as a junior (1.64 ERA, 11.0 IP, 6 H, 16 K)... majored in finance in Stillwater with the intention of becoming a financial advisor after his playing career ends.

Let Your Babies Grow Up to be Cowboys: Oklahoma State players in MLB have included Allie Reynolds, Robin Ventura, Jeromy Burnitz, Pete Incaviglia, Mickey Tettleton, Mike Henneman, Doug Dascenzo, Andrew Heaney, Matt Hague and Jordy Mercer... teammate Caeden Trenkle was drafted from Oklahoma State University in the ninth round last season.

Baseball Runs in the Family: Brady's father, Mike, played in the minors for nine seasons in the San Diego Padres system, 1986-1994, rising as high as Triple-A... after retiring as a player, immediately began managing in 1995 at age 30, and managed in the Padres' org. from 1995-2000... joined the Toronto Blue Jays and managed in the Jays system in 2003-2006 and 2009... spent the next decade as an MLB scout before being let go by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2020.

Hometown: Hails from Pearland ("PAIR-land"), Texas, south of Houston... during senior year at Pearland H.S., posted 0.48 ERA, with 101 strikeouts in 57 innings... named All-District in football, averaging 29.9 yards per catch as a receiver with one primary route: go deep... also from Pearland H.S.: Kirk Dressendorfer, Clay Hensley and Robbie Weinhardt; Megan Thee Stallion spent her teen years living in Pearland.
