LAST OUTING: McKendry tied a career-high with 10 hits allowed. He went 4.2 innings and allowed seven earned runs but the Sounds still won the game 12-11 in extra innings.

AGAINST OPPONENT: McKendry has faced the Redbirds seven times (four in 2023 and three in 2024). He is 1-1 with a 6.35 ERA (11.1 IP/8 ER) against Memphis this season. His last appearance came on June 2 and he earned the win after tossing 4.0 innings with two earned runs allowed (two solo home runs). Five of his seven outings have came on the road.

2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 0-2 with a 6.60 ERA (19.0 IP/11 ER) through first three starts before being placed on injured list
- Is 0-4 with a 10.07 ERA (19.2 IP/22 ER) as a starter and 1-0 with a 0.96 ERA (18.2 IP/2 ER) as a reliever

- Set career high with 7.1 innings of work on Sept. 6 vs. Memphis (W, 2 H, 1 ER)...also the longest outing by a Sounds pitcher
